1. The bearers' of this letter -
Pte. SCHNEIDER, Kurt, and

have reported to my office on disembarkation with a
Movement Order to "AMGOT, Italy".
2. From the standpoint of the British Army with whom
they are stated to be serving - the position is highly
irregular, as they have no AB 64 nor means of identifi-
cation, except the Movement Order, signed in pencil.
3. They have been thoroughly vetted by the Field
Security, Taranto, who have issued them with a
temporary pass for 3 days.
4. I regret bothering you with this matter, but would
you please arrange for these men to report to AMG, 15
Army Group, where they can be fully documented and
detailed for duty. It is stated that AMGOT know all
about them, and 15 Army Group will therefore, presumably,
have some knowledge of them.
5. This confirms conversation between Lt. Bernard and
Capt. Hawkin.

1. With reference to your inquiry AMG/455/49, dated 21 January, 1944, the following data are submitted.

2. Major Clinkscales was educated at Kemper Military Academy and at the University of Oklahoma. He has had successful business experience in Oklahoma. He served with the United States Army in France in the last war. In this war he has performed important work as Director of Military Training in the Army Air Force Officer Candidate School, and received ratings of Superior and Excellent. He has successfully completed a general course in the School of Military Government.

3. It is noted that there is little police experience in Major Clinkscales background, but at the same time it is also noted that he has excellent military training and that the shortage of trained Senior Police Officers in this Region has kept two other of our S.C.A.P.O. positions vacant to date.
