A breakdown of transport delayed the return of the Prison Section
Officer.

It is regretted that no helpful information can be
given at present.

(i) The Reformatory at AVIGLIANO has been requisitioned by
British Army. The juveniles are temporarily accommodated at the
local Orphanage where accommodation is strained to the uttermost.

(ii) The Reformatory at CATANZARO is badly damaged by bombs,
and is uninhabitable. The juveniles are housed temporarily in
part of local Deaf and Dumb School.

It is not yet known if any other such institution
is functioning, but the matter will receive immediate attention.
