Subject: Attitude towards Italians.

To : All S.C.A.Os and Heads of Divisions.

1. A.F.M.Q. has issued telegraphic instructions for the guidance of all ranks in their relations with Italians. The following is a paraphrase thereof:

Since the defeat and unconditional surrender of Italy, the King of Italy has offered to help us drive the Germans out of his country. This offer has been accepted but it does not mean that Italy becomes one of the Allied nations. In view of Italy's readiness to co-operate and to give every assistance in meeting operational requirements she has been accorded the status of co-belligerent.

Allied troops must be absolutely correct in their conduct. (All demands must be made through Italian military or civil officials.) All dealings with Italians must be conducted with firmness but without being rude. The aim will be to obtain what is necessary for our operations through friendly co-operation.

Cases of non-cooperation will be reported to the (Allied Military Mission through) higher formations. Should there be any active resistance or hostile acts against our forces those will be dealt with as though committed by the enemy.

The C.in.C. relies on the common sense of all ranks of the Allied Forces.

2. The above instructions are primarily for the guidance of operational troops. The portions dealing with relationships with Italian officials (enclosed in brackets) are not applicable to AMGOT procedure which will continue as at present until otherwise directed.

The Italian Red Cross in Sicily is now being reorganized. It is being financed on an island-wide basis as it serves the whole island, and will be supervised by the Public Health Division at Headquarters. No further grants should be made by the Provinces to this organization.

The new president is, Giovanni Sorce, M.D., and he has been given authority to direct the work of the organization. All inquiries concerning services should be addressed to him at Via Piazza Santa Oliva, Circolo ufficiale, Palermo. Until the Post Offices open communications can be addressed to the Italian Red Cross in care of this office.

Information concerning our AMGOT relations to the organization should be addressed to the attention of the Public Health Division (Public Welfare Section).
