I have to report that no prison is operating at AUGUSTA but that there is a large Civil Prison taken over by the British Navy. It was used by the Italian Navy prior to Allied invasion.

In my estimation, it would house perhaps 500. It would require considerable renovation after 3 years in Naval and Military occupation, but would be of great value to the Prisons Section if restored to its legitimate use and condition.

REPORT ON SYRACUSE PRISON:

State of Prison and Discipline.

Discipline apparently satisfactory. Many rooms neglected. Food store, Kitchen, Prisoners' Food reception store dirty and untidy.

Directions given accordingly.

Sanitation and Welfare.

Insufficient bedding and beds. A large number are being repaired by one man. Bedding in unsatisfactory state.

Kitchen is not well kept.

Food store is not satisfactory.

Staff.

Director does not appear to be a strong character. He may be overworked. He has no deputy. I do not consider the Capo Guadia a good type and he clearly does not inspect the prison in a thorough manner.

Shops.

Very small. Shoe Shop. Could only employ 2.
Carpenters Shop. Could only employ 2.
Tools uncared for, lying about.

Although the director states that shop work was carried on formerly, it is clear that little could be done, and I have instructed him to earmark two rooms to be used as workshops when it is possible to start prison industries.

Laundry.

This has not been in use for three months. It is dirty and neglected. I have given instructions that it be taken into use forthwith.

All laundry work has lately been done by women prisoners.

School.

Room to be provided. Priest will control.

Library.

There is a good library of 500 books.

Generally speaking, this prison requires attention. I am persuaded that a stronger director is needed, unless the present director can raise the standard. I recommend that he be given an opportunity but not extensive in time.

Insufficient bedding and beds. A large number are being repaired by one man. Bedding in unsatisfactory state.

Kitchen is not well kept.

Food store is not satisfactory.
