All records intact & will be kept under personal supervision of Chief Warden (Cabo Guardin). Prisoners received from all parts of country. Normally, only men sentenced to 2 year imprisonment or less but now 10 men men sentenced to 10 longer terms. Capabilities - 50 persons. Now hold 43 persons. (List attached)

2 Storey building. Clean & apparently efficiently maintained. All prisoners kept on full rations in cell. Receiving 6 to 8 persons. Large "hospital" room. Doctor & priest visit daily. No ill health.

Prison routine. Revuelto Tam. Cleaning cells. 1 hour exercise 11.30 am. only meal of day. (Now small loaf of macaroni & olive oil, small loaf of bread.) No labor performed by prisoners.

Fuel & food rationing: Enough macaroni & olive oil for 10 days. (65 lbs of macaroni & 22 kilos of olive oil) Bread purchased daily by Chief Warden for personal security for future paymaster. No fuel.

C. W. director to make the very necessary contacts to obtain wood locally & has done so.

Release of pool of civilian prisoners under discussion by Pretoria (Judge) of Mexico & C A O.

The other letter from Ernesto SIDOTI contains information re alleged Leticia attack & sentence of certain residents of Leticia. Sebastian MAMMA, mentioned in the letter, has an office in the Transcriber & conducts confidential inquiries on behalf of the Padilla & Company ready to do "dirty work". I am understanding to relay further information re MAMMA.
