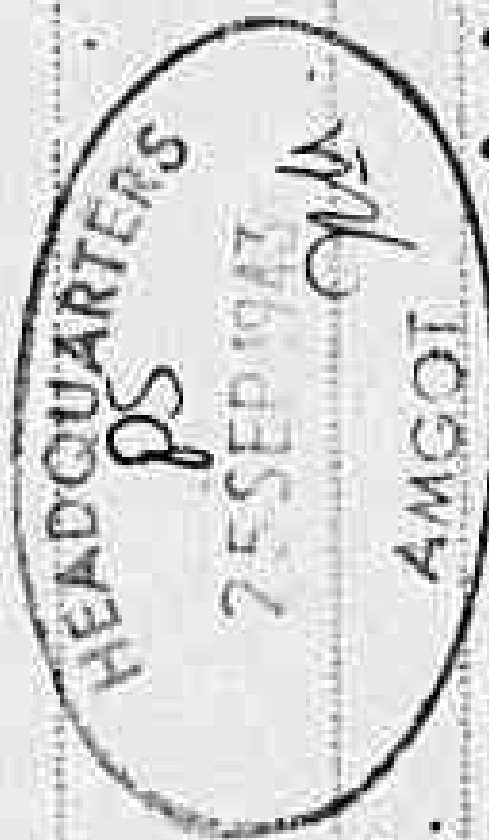

In the first and second rooms which are used for the prisoners, can hold six beds in each room and 13 beds in the third room. The fourth room used for the women prisoners can hold six beds. This means that 25 men and 6 women can be kept in the local prison.

The above said rooms ~~are not habitable~~ are habitable, only the ¹⁵ wash of all the rooms need to be whitewashed.

Furnishing:

I notify you that the prisoners are in need of sheets while the bed covers that ~~the prisoners~~ we have are in bad condition, I also inform you that we are in need of towels for the prisoners use. Filling is need for the mattresses.

In order to have cleanliness I beg you to send us some soap, and disinfecting. Also to supply us with petroleum for lights on account of lack of electric power at present time.

The courtyard used for the prisoners recreation is in very good condition, is very airy.
