attention (Questori of Sicily

It appears that the requisitioning of automobiles, motorcycles, horses, bicycles, etc. to be used by the Police Agencies to adequately cope with present necessities is proceeding slowly and that the Offices and the Commands of the Arm of CC.RR. encounter some difficulties which conflict with the urgency that is necessary under the present serious conditions of public security.

There is no doubt that all private interests must give way before the greater interests of public security. Therefore, it must be the object of all Prefects to intervene with the maximum of energy to overcome such a state of affairs.

In order to achieve better results it is suggested that the Questori be charged with requisitioning the necessary means of transport by supplying them with blank blocks of requisition forms.

The Questori, under their personal responsibility, will make vigorous use of the powers conferred upon them and every 10 days will make detailed report of the decrees issued and the results achieved.

SUBJECT: Military Motorcycles for Civilian Police Use.

TO : Lt. Colonel Charles Poletti, RCOA Region 1.

1. With our allotment of jeeps for Region being cut from 41 to 19, and with civilian cars so undependable, we are faced with a situation which may become serious at any moment.

2. Colonel Snook informs me that dependable transportation must be on hand for police use.

3. We have at Region Garage 20 military motorcycles 12 of which are in first class condition. But we are, according to my instructions, forbidden to put civilians on them. If an exception could be made with respect to Colonel Snook's police, I could immediately turn over to him A-1, fast transportation. Is it possible to do this.

2. See AMGOT/4047/L wherein on 7 Oct., C.L.O. made answer to question "Can vehicles be requisitioned by AMGOT for the purpose of turning over to civilian governmental agencies, such as the Carabinieri for use?".

C. L. O's reply:

"In so far as a civilian governmental agency is being utilized as an agency of the Military Government, such as the Carabinieri at the present time, it would be proper to requisition vehicles to be used by the Carabinieri in the discharge of their duties to the Allied Military Government. But under the Royal Decree of 18th August, 1940, No. 1741, Chapter VII, Art. 34, civil agencies, through the Prefect, have broad powers of requisitioning. It would seem far preferable to have such agencies requisition what they need, as there is no reason why the Allied Forces should pay for their supplies".

3. It is suggested that the above would be the most proper way to obtain necessary transport facilities for the Carabinieri.
