The permit was refused them for being 16 years of age. Could something be done to change this rule, as the people of Italy, especially Sicily, are used to start working at a very early age and there must be thousands now employed who are minors. If this policy of taking minors away from their jobs were to continue, there would be much needless suffering and destitution.

Another reason why this rule should be abolished is that young girls of this age roaming the streets penniless and destitute, some of them having mothers and younger sisters and brothers to support, would be ready prey for houses of prostitution.
