12. Transport for prisoners and witnesses attending trials at a distance.

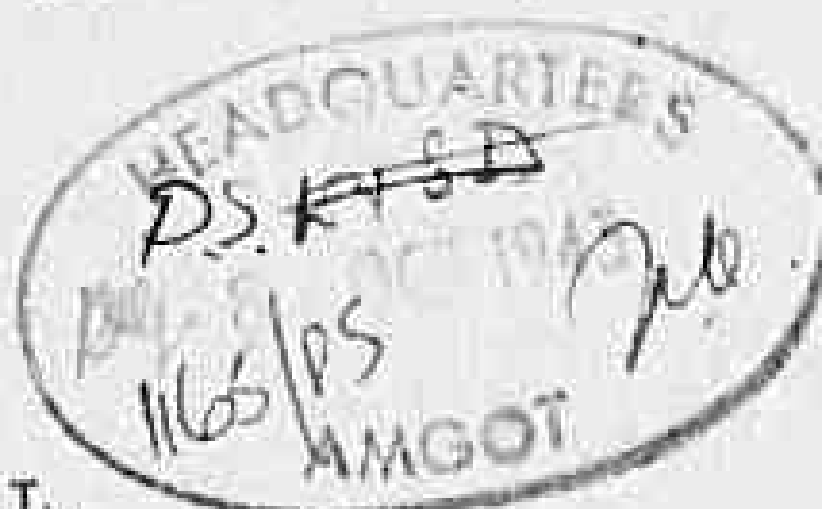
The SCAPO Palermo pointed out the difficulty in securing transport when prisoners and witnesses have to be conveyed to attend trials taking place at a considerable distance from where the offences were committed, e.g. to Palermo from country districts. Major Lothian, Deputy Supt. of Prisons, said that his Section would probably be able to assist in transporting the prisoners to Palermo, but not the witnesses. The C.P.S. said that the shortage of transport was general and he could only suggest that CAPOs must make such arrangements as are possible.
