With reference to para 2, I have to report that local Carabinieri are already controlling crowds at railway stations. Some 300 members of the CC.RR have been formed into a special Railway Section, under the command of Major C. Fera, CC.RR., and these guard all strategic and vulnerable points, provide guards for passenger trains to prevent travelling without tickets, and provide guards for goods traffic when not so guarded by the military.

10 Dec 1944. From Suez Canal to Aden. The first leg of the trip was uneventful. We had been delayed at Suez by bad weather and were unable to leave until the 10th. The second leg was also uneventful, except for a short stop at Port Sudan where we took on supplies. The third leg, from Aden to Bombay, was the most difficult. We had to pass through the narrow channel between the island of Ceylon and the mainland of India. The channel is only about 10 miles wide and there are many rocks and shoals along the bottom. We had to go very slowly and carefully, constantly looking out for danger. Finally, after several hours of slow progress, we reached the safety of the harbor at Bombay.
