On Thursday 18th May 1944 at this headquarters a conference was held by the Regional Legal Officer and attended by Public Safety Personnel, Region II and the Officers of the Legal Division.

The object of the conference was to explain to the Public Safety Officers that owing to lack of personnel in the Legal Division it had become an urgent necessity for the Provincial Public Safety officer to maintain the case registers and watch the progress of process through from its inception viz, arrest by Military Police Agencies &/or Italian Police Agencies to the Court of Procedure.

The method was explained, and it has been agreed that the work will in future be supervised by the Provincial Police Officer assisted by the existing Italian civilian staffs who now perform the work.

Major Franklin and Capt. German Legal Officer ²⁰⁰⁴ the Field have undertaken to instruct on procedure.

The problem was one of necessity which required an immediate solution, and anticipating your approval I agreed to the suggestions.

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The problem was one of necessity which required an immediate solution, and anticipating your approval I agreed to the suggestions.

The existing Public Safety Personnel in Region II is slender and being cognisant of the need for Public Safety Officers elsewhere, cannot feel justified in requesting further assistance, but it is my duty to inform you that future depletion of staff will make it impossible for Public Safety Officers to cope with their duties in an efficient manner.

I respectfully draw attention to the fact that situated in this Region are the Ports of Bari, Brindisi and Taranto, which are vital to L.of C. and I submit that it is vitally necessary for a Police Officer to constantly be in touch with the Military and Italian Police Agencies in the prosecution of the vast numbers of offenders against Allied Interests in these Provinces.

The Province of Matera and Potenza have a similar collection program the enforcement of which is under the supervision of the Provincial Police Officer

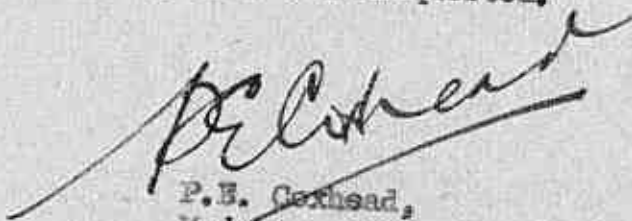
