1. With reference to the attached correspondence (16120/227/G-1) concerning above subject, I have not had sufficient opportunity to observe personally the manner of performance of Col. Howard to render an independent judgment on his application.

2. However, in view of Col. Howard's own statements as to the effect of his health upon his efficiency, and the comments made by his Regional Commissioner as to his qualifications, I have no hesitation in recommending that he be permitted to relinquish his commission or to follow such other procedure to bring about his separation from the service as British military regulations may provide.
