SUBJECT: Alleged Violation of Freezing of Tanning Materials

TO : Regional Commissioner, Region VII  
(Attention: Economic & Supply Division)

1. Information has been received from Prof. Raffaele Scammarra, Special Commissioner of Judge, that the freezing order issued by him on behalf of this HQ and the Italian Government and approved by Lt. V. W. House of this Sub-Commission, to the S.A. Tannini di Calabria, Cosenza (No. 2160/44 dated 2 June 1944, copies to Region VII and Supply Officer, Cosenza) has been violated.
2. The alleged violation consists in the reported arrival of a truck-load (approx. 90 quintals) of tanning extract at Salofra (Avellino) consigned to the following tanners:-

Giuliano Luigi  
Ferrara Felice  
Del Vecchio & Ormelli.

3. No release has been issued to the above tanners since the date of freezing (June 2) nor has the Special Commissioner any particulars of a previous release referring to the particulars in para. 2. It is understood in my case that a prior freezing order issued by AGO Cosenza was in force.

4. Will you please cause urgent investigations to be made into these alleged circumstances and if violation of the freezing order has been committed, initiate legal action against the S.A. Tannini di Calabria.

5. The tanning materials referred to in para. 2 are being frozen immediately.
6. It is pointed out that complete control of the tanning industry and consequent strict compliance with the a/q order is a fundamental condition of the Regulation of the Leather Industry and the suppression of the Black Market.
7. This HQ takes an exceptionally grave view of any contravention of orders issued by AGO or on its behalf, and requests therefore that action taken should be immediate and energetic.
