SUBJECT: MONTHLY REPORT -- AUGUST 1944.

Activities of Regional Security Officer.

TO : Regional Commissioner.

I. GENERAL

1. During the month under review, this Regional Security Section has continued its responsibility for the internal security of these headquarters, and the investigations and recording of civilian personnel applying for employment with Region 3.

2. A total of 144 reports on various subjects was translated by this section during this period.

3. The usual close cooperation between the security sections and this R.S.O. has been maintained.

4. Additional appeals from various individuals removed from office on security grounds have been passed on to the Comitato di Epurazione for its final decision.

5. The information obtained from Civil Censorship reports has been recorded and forwarded to the various sections for necessary action.

6. An additional Black List of individuals who are considered unsuitable for employment with the Allied Forces or with the Italian Government under Allied control, has been submitted to each Section Chief.

II. SPECIFIC1. P.N.E. Meetings

These meetings, held weekly, were attended by this R.E.O.

2. A. P. E.

Major WATTS attended meetings of the Naples Local Board on 7 August, 14 August and 21 August 1944.

The newspaper situation was discussed and found to be critical, not only in Naples, but in Italy generally. The stock in Naples is insufficient but 30 tons had been notified as despatched from Rome, with a promise of more to follow.

The following applications to publish journals and periodicals were recommended:-

APPROVED

STOA - Scientific and political monthly. Circulation 500, 12 pages. Recommended by Rector of University and Regional Education Officer.

IL GIORNO - Increase in paper allotment requested from 14 to 22 quintals monthly to bring circulation up from 20,000 to 30,000 - 4 pages. Recommended by Board in view of increase already granted to "L'Azione" and "Il Lavoro d'Italia".

BOLLETTINO SOCIETA' ITALIANA BIOLOGIA SPERIMENTALE -

Monthly of 1,200. Official reports of Biological Society. Approved and recommended by A.C.C. Educational Sub-Commission.

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REJECTED

The following applications were rejected subject to confirmation of the Central Board:-

LA DONNA IDEALE - Women's monthly magazine. Circulation 20,000. Not needed. NOI DONNE already authorized.

ARCHIVIO STORICO PER LE PROVINCE NAPOLETANE - Annual of historical interest in Naples area, recommended by University and Education Officer. Circulation, 600 - 500 pages. Requested by Board to apply again later.

PRIMAVERA - Literary fortnightly. Circulation 20,000. Not considered necessary.

ROSA NOSTRA - Humorous, twice weekly. Circulation 500. Not approved by Education Sub-Commission. Unessential.

LE QUATTRO GIORNATE - Patriotic weekly. Circulation 10,000. Already publishing illegally. Unessential. Warning issued to cease publishing.

IUS GENTIUM - Monthly, 1,000. International law. Not recommended strongly by Education Sub-Commission. Not considered essential at this time.

IL FERROVIARIO - Fortnightly, 10,000. Organ of trade union. "La Tribune dei Ferrovieri" already authorized. Considered this apparently rival organization will have to wait until paper situation improves.

LA TOGA - Fortnightly - 3,500. Legal review. Not considered essential. "La Giustizia" already authorized.

URI - Weekly - 20,000. Economic review. Not considered necessary.

COMUNAL - Fortnightly, 500. Organ for municipal workers. Not necessary.

LO SPORTIVO - Weekly, 10,000. Sporting news. Similar application already rejected for "Lo Sport", a more serious and strongly recommended paper.

RADIO ONDE - Weekly, 1,000. Radio programmes and news. Not considered necessary in view of limited radio.

PROGRESSO - Fortnightly, 15,000. Political and social review for young people. Has no recommendations and editor is unknown.

IL PATIO - Fortnightly, 10,000. Literary review. Not considered necessary.

L'INFORMATORE ECONOMICO - Weekly, 15,000. Economic and commercial. Not recommended by Commerce Sub-Commission in view of limited business.

LOGGIONE - Monthly, 5,000. "Guide to the Black Market". Not considered necessary as a periodical. Author recommended to take his information to the competent authorities.

ORGANIZZARE - Monthly, 5,000. Business reorganization. Not considered essential to have a periodical of this type.

DOMANI - Artistic and literary fortnightly of 18 pages. Circulation 2,000 to 5,000. Unessential.

IL DOMANI SPORTIVO - Weekly of 2 pages. Circulation 3,000. Sporting activities. Similar applications for LO SPORT and LO SPORTIVO had already been rejected because of comparative absence of sport and lack of paper.

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PER TE - Evangelical weekly paper of 4 pages. Circulation 5,000. Not justifiable at the moment.

EUROPA - Cultural and political paper to develop friendship between United Nations and Italy. Circulation, 15,000. Weekly, 4 pages, Unessential.

TRAGUARDO - Cultural fortnightly of 2 pages. Circulation, 2,000. Not essential.

CINQUARIETA - Asked for by show people. Weekly of 2 pages. Circulation, 5,000. Appears to be more an advertising agency than a magazine.

SUBJECT: MONTHLY REPORT -- JUNE 1944.

Activities of Regional Security Officer.

TO : Regional Commissioner,
Regional Public Safety Officer.

I. General.

1. Following the transfer of Major A. E. HEATH, I.C., to Rome Region as from 22 June 1944, and in accordance with instructions from the Regional Commissioner, the under-mentioned officer assumed the responsibility of carrying out the duties of Regional Security Officer.
2. Close cooperation has been maintained between F.S.S., C.I.C., O.S.S. (X-2 Branch), etc., and the exchange of information continued.
3. The usual investigations of civilian personnel applying for employment with A.C.C. (Regional HQ and Naples Province) has been carried out and records kept.

II. Specific.

1. The under-mentioned officer attended the Weekly Conference at P.W.B. on 24 June 1944 and the following were the chief topics discussed:-

1. Conduct of troops:-
 - a. Noticeable change in attitude of population in Southern Italy following withdrawal of troops, especially in BARI? Last effort of Fascist elements to cause trouble.

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- b. Civilian reactions to bad behaviour () women?
- c. Military reactions? Feeling of exasperation at high prices.
- d. Relations between military and civilians: prostitution and V.D., assaults.
- e. General economic situation. Food. Improvement in Italy. Prices.
- f. Italian army. Reactions of Italians and own troops.

2. A report on the ALBERGO dei POVERI (a civilian hospital and home for the poor) was submitted to the Regional Commissioner on 27 June 1944, with a recommendation that Alfonso ALIPERTA, Gastano DE BLASIO and Domenico SALDI be removed from office. Ref:- G-2/157

Arrest of Cesare ROSSETI, former Chief Secretary to the Ministry of the Interior, a position which was given to him by Mussolini for his attachment and fidelity to Mussolini and to the Fascist Party generally. He was closely mixed up in the Fascist plot in 1924 against the Socialists in which MATTEOTTI was assassinated.

Activities of Regional Security Officer.

Regional Public Safety Officer.

I. General.

1. Investigations of civilian employees and individual cases, including political appointments reached a total of more than 300 during May 1944.

2. Liaison with Security and Intelligence Departments was maintained during the period under review and was most satisfactory.

3. Internal Security, Region 3, HQ, - marked improvement and an increase in cooperation between Sections and this R.S.O.

MONTHLY REPORT.
SUBJECT: Activities of Security Officer,
Public Safety, - APRIL 1944.
TO: Regional Commissioner.
Regional Public Safety Officer.

I. General.

1. A total of 261 investigations, including civilian employees, were made during the period under revision.
2. Cooperation with security and intelligence departments was particularly satisfactory. Daily liaison with C.I.C. and P.S.S. was continued and an exchange of information arranged between this office and P.W.B.

II. Specific.

1. During the first week in April, a thorough investigation of the employees and the local Chamber of Commerce (Provincial Economic Council of Naples) was completed by a Special Investigator, Engineer JANSEL and Cpl. GREGOR, of this office. Schede Personali were carefully gone into and a report submitted to the Regional Economics & Supply Officer who duly recorded his recognition.
2. Meetings held at P.W.B. were attended and matters of mutual interest to these Headquarters and that branch of the Allied Forces were discussed. These included a request for a candidate as Commissario for the Societa' Elettricità Meridionale. Definite recommendation is expected during the first week in May. Representatives of A.C.C. Headquarters, G-2 P.B.S., and various intelligence departments also attended.

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3. Investigations and/all personal interview took place during the period under review. A total of 47 political nominations were investigated during the period under review. A list of names and a brief account of the nominations is attached hereto. Full particulars are available on file.

4. Cpl. GRECCO of this office assisted the public Prosecutor (Lt. CAMN, Legal Division) in investigating various witnesses appearing in the Manifattura cotoniere Meridionale case (PISCITELLI, TAGLIAVINI, etc.) and contributed largely to the preparation of the case. He also assisted in the arrest of the accused and conducted investigations in the homes and offices of those on trial. He took down a number of statements and examined a number of documents subsequently produced in Court.

5. This Security Officer also conducted specific inquiries into several breaches of security directly connected with Region 3 and prepared reports of outstanding interest on:-

Regulations regarding security in general and at these Headquarters in particular are not being observed by the majority of Allied Officers. An inspection during the night of April 26-27 disclosed a

considerable number of breaches of security and the attention of all Officers concerned was drawn to their individual responsibility.
