1. Upon completion of the arrangement of our new quarters and offices in Pesaro, many officers and En/CHs were sent on temporary duty to Rome to collect and study data pertinent to our new Region.

2. Lt. Col. R.T. Millhouse, Regional Public Safety Officer, left Pesaro on such temporary duty on the 3rd of October. On or about the 7th of October, he entered the 42th British General Hospital near Rome for medical examination and treatment. Capt. A.R. Grosse, of this Division, is still in the Hospital in Naples from latest reports available at this HQ; and Capt. T.M. Glasspool, is still on temporary duty with the patriots in Florence. Major Karl W. Fischer, Deputy Regional Public Safety Officer, is carrying on the affairs of the office during the absence of Col. Millhouse.

3. On 13th October, Major Fischer attended a conference in Florence of Public Safety Officers of the Northern Regions, and of the two Armies, with CC.RA General Teddei, and Commanding Officers of the CC.RA legions of the Milano Division. Points discussed at this meeting included placement of Spearhead Groups, equipment, bedding and clothing, rations, transportation, provisions for pay and operational expenses, medical inspection and recruitment, and morale of CC.RA. The meeting was called by the Public Safety Sub-Commission, ACC; and presided over by Major Wilson of that Sub-Commission.

4. During the month, this Division received supplies of the following from HQ - ACC:-- Petrol Coupons, Proclamations 1 (Revised), 2, 3, and 4; General Orders 2, 27, 29 and 33; and, Notices 1, 2 and 3, for distribution to the Provinces.

1. The first week of September was utilized in collecting data for use in the new Region and in the reproduction of Public Safety Directives for all Provincial Commissioners; Provincial Public Safety Officers and Provincial Police Officers. Said Directives were distributed to the Officers Concerned.

2. Inventory was taken of all Public Safety Forms and Supplies on Hand; and new supplies of General Orders, Notices, Civilian passes and IOL were requested of R.C.A.M.C. Section and Industry and Commerce Sub-Commission. Copies of these requests were forwarded to Capt. Cobb, Region XII Liaison Officer with HQ ACC, requesting his attention in securing same as quickly as possible.

3. At the end of August, Major Karl W. Fischer, Deputy Regional Public Safety Officer, was the only officer remaining in the Division due to the illnesses of Lt. Col. Millhouse, the Regional Public Safety Officer, and of Capt. Crosbie; Civil Police Supervisor. Capt. T.W. Glasspool has been on temporary duty with the Patriots at Florence. However, on the 14th of September, Lt. Col. Millhouse returned to duty and Capt. S. Bean reported to the Division for duty on the following day.

1. On 31 July, Region IV Provinces under control of this Headquarters were turned over to control of Headquarters of Rome Region which then became known as Region IV and this Headquarters then became known as Region "Z". Subsequently Region "Z" became Region XII.

The first few days of August were spent in transferring and turning over to the new Region IV Headquarters the files and supplies of this Headquarters. This was completed on 5 August and on 7 August, Region "Z" Headquarters were moved from Rome to Orinociano and established in buildings there.

3. The balance of the month has been spent in collecting data relative to territory of Region XII and obtaining of necessary supplies and installing a file system, for operation in Region XII.

AS OF 1 August, there were four officers assigned to this Division Headquarters: Major General Wilmshurst (R), Regional Public Safety Officer, Major Robert Fischer (A) Capt. A.R. Crosbie, (B), and Capt. F.W. Glasspool (B). Capt. Crosbie was taken ill during the month of July and taken to the British General Hospital at Naples where he still is.

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On 20 August, Lt. Col. R.F. Willhouse, Regional Public Safety Officer, became ill and was admitted to the ^{101st} Chianciano Hospital. On 29 August, he was taken to the British General Hospital at Siena for examination and by it transferred to the British General Hospital at Naples. Results of the examination have not yet been received at this Headquarters.

66. On 27 August, Capt. T. I. Glazovskii (E), 45th Division Headquarters was sent on temporary loan to AZG 5 Army to act as Liaison Officer with Italian Patriots, which experience should be of future value to this Headquarters in dealing with similar problems in territory of Region XII.

1. On 31 July, Region IV Provinces under control of this Headquarters were turned over to control of Headquarters of Rome Region which then became known as Region IV and this Headquarters then became known as Region "Z". Subsequently Region "Z" became Region XII.

2. The first few days of August were spent in transferring and turning over to the new Region IV Headquarters the files and supplies of this Headquarters. This was completed on 5 August and on 7 August, Region "Z" Headquarters were moved from Rome to Chianciano and established in buildings there.

3. The balance of the month has been spent in collecting data relative to territory of Region XII and obtaining of necessary supplies and installing a file system, for operation in Region XII.

4. As of 1 August, there were four officers assigned to this Division Headquarters: ~~Adm. Col. R.D. Willhouse~~ (B), Regional Public Safety Officer, Major ~~Adm. W. Fischer~~ (A), Capt. A.R. Crossie, (B), and Capt. T.W. Glasspool (B). Capt. Crossie was taken ill during the month of July and taken to the British General Hospital at Naples where he still is.

5. On 20 August, Lt. Col. R.T. Willhouse, Regional Public Safety Officer, became ill and was admitted to the ~~British~~ Chianciano Hospital. On 29 August, he was taken to the British General Hospital at Siena for examination and by it transferred to the British General Hospital at Naples. Results of the examination have not yet been received at this Headquarters.

6. On 27 August, Capt. T.W. Glasspool (B), ~~Adm.~~ Division Headquarters was sent on temporary loan to AG 5 Army to act as Liaison Officer with Italian Patriots, which experience should be of future value to this Headquarters in ~~handling similar~~ problems in territory of Region XII.

7. Major Karl W. Fischer, Deputy Regional ~~Adm.~~ Safety Officer, is in charge of the Public Safety Division Headquarters of the Region during the absence of Lt. Col. Willhouse.
