SUBJECT: " ZANZUR" Barracks of the FF.GG. of Naples-Derequisition.

Attached herewith is copy of letter addressed on 3 August 1945 by this Command to the M.S. Engineer's Office-APHQ-Caserta to obtain the derequisition of " ZANZUR" Barracks in Naples pertaining to the GG.FF., in view of the precarious housing conditions of the GG.FF. Corps in Naples.

As said office has no more been working since some time, and as the requisition files of that city have been selected at the " Real Estate Officer Section P.B.S. of Naples" we beg your Sub-Commission kindly to intervene with said office to obtain, in the service interest, that " ZANZUR " Barracks should be restored to the GG.FF. Corps of Naples.

In the enclosed letter the reasons that make this request urgent are stated: besides the School Authorities are claiming the buildings, at present used as barracks for the Corps Units to be returned; so that the situation of that Command of Legion is getting more and more precarious.

For due information it is communicated that on August 18 ult. the ZANZUR barracks were occupied by the u/m Offices.

1. 296 TL. SIGNAL INSTALLATION Co. NAPLES- 250 men under the orders of Cpt William I. Marvin;
 2. CIVILIAN PERSONNEL OF THE S.E.T. (Telephonic Services Company) for the works of the Italian lines
 3. about 800 German Prisoners working in the Harbour of Naples.
- Also Mj.P.P. LUCKMAN - Zone Public Safety Officer- Naples - was directly asked to get an interest in the matter.

We trust the intervention of your Sub-Commission will help in solving as soon as possible the serious problem concerning the uneasy situation of the GG.FF. of Naples.

SUBJECT : Derequisition of ZANZUR Barrack belonging to the
GG.FF. of Naples.

VERY URGENT

The Command of the GG.FF. Legion of NAPLES had repeatedly pointed out the uneasy housing condition of the GG.FF. Units in that city owing to the requisition, by the Allied Military Authorities, of the ZANZUR Barrack pertaining to the Finance Guards.

As it is known both the Command and the Units of Naples Corps are at present scattered all over the city and compelled to recur to every kind of expedients for housing the soldiers, many of whom, owing to the lack of room, are obliged to lodge at civilians' homes.

Such situation prejudices even the discipline and efficiency of the services among which those effected on account of the U.N.R.R.A., E.N.D.S.I., CONSORZI AGRARI - surveyance of food stores - as well as those effected in the interest of the Allied Military Authorities, have a remarkable importance.

Serious consequences of economical character derive from the lack of an immediate surveyance of the U.N.R.R.A goods situated in the dock, or of an escorting service for E.N.D.S.I. motor-vehicles. Such inconvenience depends on the fact that the Unit Commanders cannot dispose of the personnel altogether and ready owing to the lack of suitable barracks.

This Command has already pointed out such inconveniences to the Presidency of the Council of Ministers for an intervention

with the Allied Authorities. The residence, by note 42303/13073/1/21/19.14 dated August 18-1945, of which a copy is attached herewith, acknowledged the question to be very serious and charged this General Command to present directly the request to the Competent Allied Offices.

Considering such uneasy situation of the GG.FF. of Naples, made still more critical these days as the school building "ASILO al SOCCORSO" used as barrack threatens to fall down and supposing the requisition of the Zanzur Barrack to be no longer necessary as it was, we beg your M.S. Engineer's Office of the AFHQ to apply urgently to the military Authorities that occupy at present the a/m barracks, to obtain the building to be restored as soon as possible to the GG.FF. of Naples.

I had the opportunity to remark that some Administrations are in the habit of getting directly in touch with the Allied Commission to deal, on a political ground, with questions that have not yet been technically concluded with the competent Allied Sub-Commissions and, moreover, that they frequently apply to the personal intervention of the Prime Minister sending drafts of letters for the Chief of the Allied Commission.

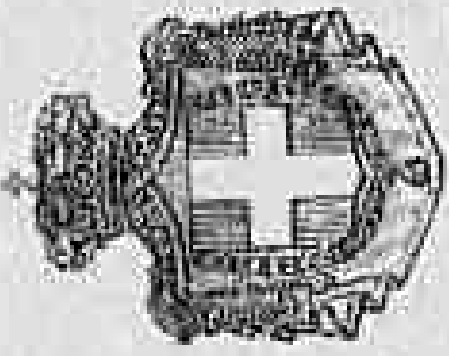
No use illustrating the inconveniences of such procedure. On one side it alters, in fact, the normal course of the proceedings causing inconveniences that make their development more complicated and slower; on the other side it lessens the Government authority whose intervention loses the political meaning that must absolutely be reserved to it.

So I beg you to take care that all the questions pending with the Allied Authorities should always first be dealt with the competent Sub-Commissions to whom the political side of said questions will naturally be shown and only when this procedure is completely settled, they should apply to the political intervention of the Government with the Allied Commission.

When Your Excellences deem it necessary to obtain letters signed by the Prime Minister to be sent to the Allied Commission Chief, it will be advisable to send a copy of these letters to the President of Cabinet in order to render the selection of the answers possible and have these transmitted to the competent Ministries.

2. No reply has been given up to date as no meeting of the Electricity Control Board took place until yesterday, 5 February 1945.
3. The Board thanks you for the list of the Police Stations submitted, but regrets that the electricity shortage has become still more acute since this question was first brought up.
4. No further commitments can be accepted unless a further allocation is made to Rome by the Central Electricity Board.

1. Reference attached translation of letter received from the Comandante of No. 10 Legion, Finance Guards, Naples.

2. Paragraph 2 - The Finance Guards are a military unit similar to the Carabinieri and in many instances are called upon to perform similar duties but they, unlike the Carabinieri, are dependent upon SEPRAL, a civilian organisation, for their rations which SEPRAL are not always able to supply in full. This causes a certain amount of discontent amongst the Finance Guards and in the interests of efficiency it is suggested that they draw their rations from the same source as the Carabinieri.

3. Paragraph 3 - The subject of accommodation is being dealt with; at the moment a reply is awaited from G.5 AFHQ in response to your AC/14012/2/PS dated 20 Dec 44.

4. Paragraph 4 - The clothing question is a serious one and instances have occurred, and are still occurring, where Finance Guards going on duty (having no overcoat of their own) have had to borrow the overcoat of the Guard going off duty. Their appearance is shabby and their morale low in consequence.

5. Paragraph 5 - Repeated requests from many sources are being addressed to the Finance Guards to take a firmer line of action in the prevention of "black-market" racketeering, their response in view of the circumstances is praiseworthy, judged by Italian standards, and there is every reason to believe that if their food and clothing problems are

Reference your verbal request we communicate the following:-

1) SITUATION OF SHIPS.

You can verify it from the enclosed list. To increase the service in the Castellammare di Stabia port, one of the two motor boats actually at disposition of the Office of the Port Counter Intelligence Officer, P.B.S., APO 782, could be used, if the said Office gave authority.

2) VICTUALLING.

According to dispositions given by the competent Allied Authorities from the 1 November 1944 the R.Finance Guards have a free food ration, on the same ration scale as the soldiers. The foodstuffs are bought with coupons issued by the SEPRAL and by free traders. Of the foodstuffs which constitute the ration: coffee, pepper and preserved tomatoes are not distributed, because the SEPRAL cannot supply them and it is impossible to find them on the market. In general, having in mind the actual contingencies, the food ration is sufficient and the militaries like it.

As the food ration is not supplied by the Military Victualling Warehouse, the Allied HQ. gave dispositions to the R.Finance Guards personnel that in case of sickness they must not be sent to military hospitals which withdraw military rations, but in civil hospitals on civilian rations.

Considering that the food ration for R.Finance Guards differs slightly from the one established for soldiers (Royal Carabinieri included), it would be advisable to issue the military ration to the R.Finance Guards, and consequently they could be supplied by the Military Victualling Depot.

3) ACCOMMODATION.

Of the foodstuffs which constitute the ration: coffee, pepper and preserved tomatoes are not distributed, because the SEPRAL cannot supply them and it is impossible to find them on the market. In general, having in mind the actual contingencies, the food ration is sufficient and the militaries like it.

3) ACCOMMODATION.

Before the war, the R.Finance Guards had at their disposition the following barracks, which answered for space, decorum and commodities to the requirements of service:

In the said barracks it was possible to billet 1500 men and there were comfortably settled all the Headquarters and offices of our Command.

Following the bombardments the a/m. barracks, except the "Zanzur" became uninhabitable.

For the above reasons all the HQ. and units of Naples were quartered in the "Zanzur" barracks in Via Guglielmo Marconi although it was even in part damaged from the air raid of the 4 Aug. 1943.

After the liberation, the "Zanzur" barracks was occupied by the Allied troops and the HQ. and the units of the R.Finance Guards were obliged to find accommodation in some schools which are inadequate for space, for unsafe conditions and hygienetal sanitary conditions. Many bachelor Finance Guards are obliged to live

with private families, some even out of Naples, making it very expensive and damaging the service and discipline.

Furthermore, another serious circumstance arises, not being able to urgently gather in a short time and put at disposition of the P.S. Authorities, many Finance Guards for public order necessities.

I add that only for accommodation difficulties recently it has not been possible to put at disposition of the Naples Port Allied authorities 150 soldiers depending from this HQ. for merchandise

escort. To avoid the a/m circumstances, it is necessary the de-requisitioning of the "Zanzur" barracks, that according to our information it is occupied by Units of the HQ. 296 Signal Installation CO and by coloured troops HQ 524 P.T.B.N.

The billeting situation has been pointed out to your office with letter n. 46669/2 C. dated 13 Oct 1944.

4) CLOTHING.

The Legion Warehouse is completely unprovided with clothing. Many Finance Guards included those arrived to this Legion from Liberated Territories and from P.O.F. Camps are completely lacking of clothes. Therefore, they serve in worn out civilian clothes. Many others have uniforms in bad conditions and consequently not decorous. It happens sometimes that some of them before starting their duty hours must change their uniforms with others.

I beg you to request to the competent authorities the supply of the following clothing:-

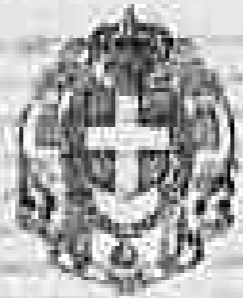

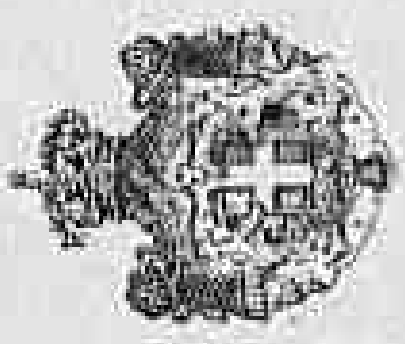

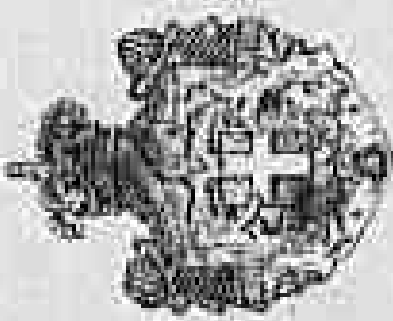

1. Strenuous efforts are being made by this office to re-employ 150 officers and men of the 10th Territorial Legion of the R. Guardia di Finanza on their normal duties in the Port of Naples.
2. Contacts with the U.S. Army Port authority has resulted in agreement to use these men on truck guard duties for the time being, thus supplementing the Italian Army guards in the task of ensuring protection to loads leaving the Port.
3. The above scheme is, however, held in suspense by reason of lack of accommodation for the 150 members of this Corps, many of whom are to be called into Naples from Benevento and Avellino for this service.
4. In pre war times the Caserma Zambur, accommodating 1000 men in the vicinity of the Port was the central H.Q. of this Corps, but it is now requisitioned and occupied by the US Army, Port Battalion.
5. Information has been received that a large building formerly occupied by a Fascist organisation and called the Gruppo Luporini, at Piazza Torretta, Bagnoli, Naples, which is also requisitioned by the Peninsula Base Section, Real Estate Office, has been vacant for the past three weeks and is being held vacant at the disposition of AFHQ (Operations).
6. In view of the acute shortage of suitable premises in Naples it is respectfully suggested that the Public Safety Sub Commission AC HQ be requested to intercede with AFHQ in an effort to release the latter premises and enable the Guardia di

The Council of Ministries has proposed for the appropriation 20 million Lire for its repair.

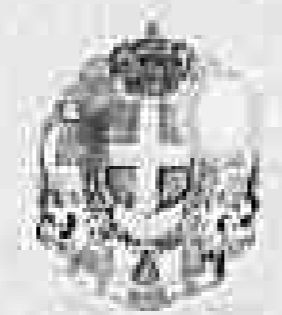

The Regia Guardia di Finanza, since the arrival of the Anglo-Americans have assumed their duties enthusiastically which have been entrusted to them.

To cope with the present exigencies of the service and the future, if Rome and other places are occupied, and to enroll 4000 Guards (Finanzieri) and 300 non/coms., the barracks problem is quite evident especially when you consider that the recruited youths are converted into soldiers right in the barracks where they learn little by little the principles of order, police, and discipline, which are the bases for the training of a soldier.

The same can be said about the training of the Non/Com. (300) who cannot have the assurance of success and proficiency if the trainees cannot be assembled in a school building.

At the present time, all the main barracks of the R. Guardia di Finanza, have been occupied by the Allied Authorities while the CCRP. Barracks have not been requisitioned.

CCRP. Legion in Naples have remained in possession of their barracks while R. Guardia di Finanza Legion had to vacate, and its branches, who perform identical and superior service for the Allies than the Arma, have been placed in unsuitable building.
