The food rations fixed with telegram nr. 11300/C IIR
dated 21st 11.1944 forwarded by the Ministry of Agricoltura and
Foreste, are not sufficient for the soldiers on duty in the
high mountains (about 2000 meters).

It is necessary to proceed to an increase of the
quantity of said rations, increase which has always been adopted
in regard of the Alps troops.

Even considering the actual food shortage in Italy,
our opinion is that it could be possible to add 50 gr. to the
present rations of cheese, pasta and rice, 10 gr. to the fat
rations and 50 gr. of jam.

We beg your Commission to kindly fulfil said request.

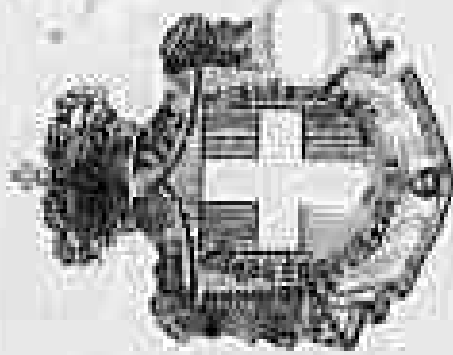

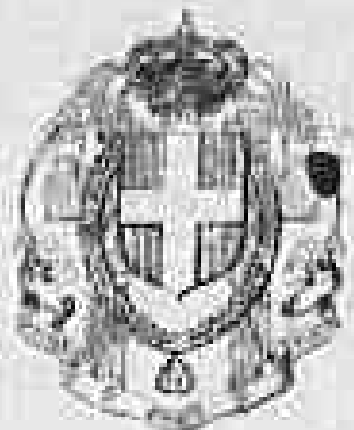

SUBJECT: Food for Guardia di Finanza

TO : HQ A.C. APO 394 (Attn. Director P.S. Sub-Comm.)

1. Attention is called to the conditions under which the Guardia di Finanza are working in the higher altitudes. Food is short and it is a continual source of worry to the Guardia Commanders to supply the men with food.

2. Whilst we know the men cannot be supplied at present from Italian Army sources they are in fact doing work of a police nature and their comrades in the CC.RR. in the plains are drawing Military rations, I ask if it is at all possible to get permission to draw rations for 600 men engaged on border control and high altitude work in this Region. Food is unobtainable except at a price beyond the means of the Guardia. It is useless to increase the ration on paper if no ration exists and that is what is being done here.

3. Your cooperation will be much appreciated by all concerned.

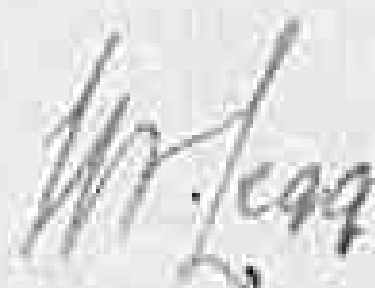
SUBJECT: Rations for Public Security Agents, Guardia Finanze, etc.

TO : High Commissioner for Food, Rome

1. It is reported to us that Guardia Finanze in Bari and district are receiving 113 grams Preserved Meat above the ration laid down in AOC/43-1/Food dated 18 October 1944.

2. Will you please make it perfectly clear to all concerned that Cheese and Preserved Fish (for which the above is being issued) are not included in the ration, but that where, on availability, cheese or preserved fish is issued, a corresponding reduction is to be made in the issue of preserved meat.

3. Bari authorities should be specially instructed to reduce the quantity of meat being issued to the Guardia Finanze and to other Public Security Agents, to the approved ration of 100 grams.

As it known, this Legion in order to implement the food rations, is obliged daily to supply the dependent soldiers, whose number is roughly 2000 men, with half a litre of wine per person.

In the past the supply has been entrusted to whole-salers on the market, who did not comply with their tasks in a satisfactory manner.

Recently following authorisation given by the Allied Command, a quantity of wine, about 450 hectolitres, has been provisionally assigned by the SEPRAL. The keeping of the wine is difficult in these barracks due to inadequate equipment.

Therefore this Legion has applied to the Vi.Di.La.Gi. Firm, which office is in Rome, via di Villa Torlonia 10, and which production establishment is in Puglie.

This firm has engaged itself to supply any quantity whatsoever of good wine at more convenient prices putting at our disposal all equipped stores, which it possesses in Rome.

As in such a manner the problem of the daily wine-supply to the dependent soldiers is satisfactorily resolved, we beg the Subcommittee kindly to assign to the a/m Firm every month n/4 railway waggons for the transport of wine from Puglie, as shown by the attached form.

The Agrarian Trust of Lecce, has authorised this exportation.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PREPARATION OF BID - FORM TSC 3.

System is designed to provide positive control of transportation by rail of civil freight traffic both AC and Ordinary leading of and compliance with their instructions and accurate preparation of Form TSC 3 will materially help all in the best possible transportation.

1. Civilian Freight Traffic. Civilian (i.e. all non military) traffic falls into two broad categories.

Traffic. Comprises commodities which AC considers essential to meet vital needs and over which AC exercises a control, such as wheat, flour, sugar, olive oil and other basic foodstuffs or supplies. Salt, fuel, fertiliser, seeds, and essential by Italian Government under AC auspices are included in this category.

2. Ordinary Italian Civilian Freight Traffic. Comprises all freight movements required by civilians, not coming under sub-para 1. Such movements must be limited to capacity available after requirements of sub-para (a) above, have been fully met.

Emergency of Extreme Urgency. Regular working of bidding system is essential. However, it is appreciated that emergencies may arise requiring special movement arrangements. In such cases, form TSC 3 will be prepared, clearly marked "Emergency Request", and emergency clearly specified. Officers and consignors preparing form TSC 3 are responsible for determining that there is

Wagon labels. Attention is directed to the fact that wagons must bear official AC WAGON LABELS, completed in accordance with the instructions provided, upon acceptance of bid, for each authorised wagon. Labels will be supplied by AC in accordance with the instructions provided. Regional and Provincial Supply Officers, who will endorse them with details of commodity, serial number of bid, date of issue, and authorised, stamp and sign them before issuing to consignor. The number of the railway wagon will be entered in the stationmaster at time of loading. On any cancellation of movement AC official wagon labels must be returned to the stationmaster.

Please find hereafter a relation from the Commander of the Club of the Livorno R. Guardia di Finanza.

"As soon as I got to Livorno I applied to the Allied Command so as to obtain food for the troops of the Livorno Club, by their Sussistenza, as the Carabinieri had obtained before."

"Notwithstanding my repeated demands and prayers, it was impossible to obtain anything, also because of the circular, dated 24th July 1944, issued by A.C.C. Subcommission, of which they showed me a copy."

"I then applied to various Comunal food offices (the S.F.P.R.A.L. is not yet functioning for the entire province) to obtain the rations foreseen by the above mentioned circular, but all these institutions can at present only provide 350 grms of bread and 90 grms of flour, instead of 100 grms of pasta."

"Occasionally they can distribute sugar and stewed meat, but they are short of anything else, even oil."

"Troops of all brigades find themselves, therefore, in very hard food conditions, for, lacking entirely of fats, they cannot prepare any kind of soup."

"I notify what above to that Command, so as to obtain by the competent Authorities, permission of getting our supplies from the Italian Military Sussistenza, which I know exists at Cecina and Piombino."

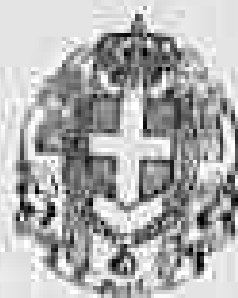

My dear Mr Prime Minister,

Following your letter dated 9 August under reference N 2124/X-9, I have investigated the question of rationing the Guardia Finanza and have to inform you that it is quite impossible to continue to ration this force from Military sources. The necessity for this change to civilian sources was conveyed to the Commanding General GG.FF in good time prior to the effective date.

You are no doubt aware that the military rations imported and distributed to the Armed Forces are intended exclusively for the Italian Armed Forces carrying out active operations against the enemy. The Reali Carabinieri are included in this distribution in view of the fact that they are an integral part of the Royal Army.

The Guardia Finanza have hitherto been included in this ration ceiling for the very reason that you state in para 2 of your letter, but the time has now arrived at which it is impossible to continue.

The position being that, as you are aware, the ceiling of the Armed Forces is fixed by the Allied Governments, the liberation of more territory has necessitated an increase in Reali Carabinieri, the decision has therefore to be made as to whether we keep the Armed Forces at the maximum within the ceiling or reduce these and include the GG.FF.

I feel sure that you will agree, that there can only be one decision, that the Italian Armed fighting forces must be as large as possible consistent with policy laid down. It has been arranged for the GG.FF to be on the highest civilian ration scale i.e. that for heavy workers.

1. The decision which shifted the ration of the Guardia di Finanza from the Army scale to the special civilian ration for public safety personnel was based upon necessity.

2. Allied Military Authorities had prescribed that the total number of rations which could be withdrawn from military sources by the Carabinieri or similar organizations should not exceed 55,000. The strength of the Carabinieri and the Guardia di Finanza, both of whom were drawing rations from military sources, exceeded 55,000. Reduction of the number drawing rations thereupon became necessary. A reduction in the strength of both the CC.RR and GG.FF so that in the aggregate they would not exceed 55,000 is, I am sure you will agree, not even to be considered. A pro rata distribution of military rations between the two organizations would be administratively extremely difficult and would undoubtedly be provocative of dissention within each of the two organizations. An additional fact which prompted the decision was that the military rations are intended for the Italian Army. The Guardia di Finanza, while part of the Armed Forces of the State, is not an integral part of the Italian Army, as is the Carabinieri. The CC.RR as a matter of right are entitled to the military ration.

3. The splendid work done by the Guardia di Finanza is fully appreciated. I regret that they no longer share the military ration. Nevertheless, in view of the situation with which we were confronted, no other solution could be made.

Dear Captain Stone,

The Allied Control Commission has given order that the food ration to be given to the men of the R. Guardia di Finanza should be, from the 1st of this month, usual to that of the men of the P.S. and for the Firemen, is considerably inferior to that which they got till July 31st last, and to that which is still given to the R. Army, including the Carabinieri Reali.

The disparity of treatment which the aforesaid disposition has created between the Reali Carabinieri and the Regia Guardia di Finanza, which fulfils the same functions in collaboration with the Allied Forces, could have an unfavourable influence on the service of the men of the R. Guardia di Finanza.

Therefore, I wish to draw your attention on this question, requesting you to examine whether it would be possible to go on giving the men of the R. Guardia di Finanza the same food rations which was granted to them till now.

1. Reference Minute 1-j. of Vice Presidents conference 14 Aug 44 asking Administrative Section to draft a reply to a letter from the Prime Minister on the subject of rations for the Guardia di Finanza.

2. The Minister of Finance asked R.C. & M.G. Section, reference O.559, 7 of Aug 44, a copy of which is attached, to restore the preferential ration scale enjoyed by the Guardia di Finanza up to 31 Jul 44. Later R.C. & M.G. Section passed this letter direct to Food Sub-Commission with a request that the necessary information be given so that R.C. & M.G. Section could reply.

3. Economic Section was advised of the position today and suggests to you that one answer only should be given by ACC to the request for a higher scale of rations for the Guardia di Finanza. Insofar as you have been requested to draft a reply for signature by the Acting Chief Commissioner, you may wish to incorporate the advice of the Economic Section in your proposed reply.

4. When the Guardia di Finanza ceased to draw rations on the Italian army scale they were placed on the highest civilian ration scale in force which is authorized also for Public Security agents and firemen, etc. The overall supply situation will not permit army scale rations to be issued to the Guardia di Finanza from civilian supplies and it is regretted that the Prime Minister's request cannot be approved by the Economic Section.

5. May a copy of your reply for signature of the Acting Chief Commissioner be forwarded to this Section, as well as to the R.C. & M.G. Section, who may then take what action they think necessary ~~and~~ to reply to the Minister of Finance.

The Command of the R.Guardia di Finanza of Liberated Italy has informed me that by disposition of your Commission No. 222/143/C.A. of 23 July it has been provided that beginning on the 1st. the food rations issued to military personnel of the R.Guardia di Finanza be similar to those agreed upon for the agents of the P.S. Vigili del Fuoco, Guardie Forestali and Guardie Carcerarie, namely greatly inferior to those issued up to 31 July, equal in every respect to the food quantities established for the R.Army, including the R.Carabinieri.

Now it is to be taken into consideration in this matter that the R.Guardia di Finanza, who have been incorporated into the Armed Forces of the State, in addition to their specific organizational tasks, are called upon to carry on under the orders of the Allied Command an activity fully similar to that fulfilled by the R.Carabinieri, and that is, services of public order, counter espionage or other military matters. -

Therefore, the above mentioned order which reduces sharply the food ration, by creating a disparity in treatment between the R.Carabinieri and military personnel of the R.Guardia di Finanza, can but reflect negatively for obvious reasons of material and moral character, on the efficiency of the military personnel, of the Guardia di Finanza, creating illhumour and hard feelings. -

I, therefore, ask your Commission to kindly reconsider benevolently the above mentioned disposition and permit that to the R.Guardia di Finanza be restored the food treatment enjoyed up to July 31st.

I would appreciate a reply.

The Alimentation Officer will then issue an authority to purchase food in bulk according to the certified number of CG.FF in the mess. All details as to the method of drawing rations, periodical certificates of strength, etc. will be arranged locally by the appropriate Alimentation Officer.

to be in the neighbourhood of 30,000 officers and men, but this figure may have to be revised in the light of future conditions.

5. As the matter is urgent it is requested that the arrangements to issue the new scale of rations to the Finance Guards be put into effect at the earliest possible date.

1. HQ. A.A.I. in their 1605/50/3/1 (G) S. D. I dated 3 April (App; "A" of which is attached for reference) recommended to C.O.S. at WASHINGTON that the total numbers of CCRR and GGFF to be "effectively employed" by the Allies should be 60000, of which "37000 employed at present and remainder only required after a further advance by the Allies". This figures has NOT been approved yet.

2. As regards maintenance of the above numbers of CCRR and GGFF :-

(a) Rations - are issuable either on "Basic" or Combat Scale, according to circumstances. It is probable that a new small scale will be authorized for all effective Italian Army troops (including CCRR and GGFF) in lieu of the separate combat and Basic scales.

1. I am directed to inform you that the ration strength of the Italian Army as defined below, shall be limited to three hundred and forty one thousand one hundred and seventy all ranks. This figure of 341,170 EXCLUDES : -

(a) CARABINIERI and GUARDIA DI FINANZA in civil employ (as opposed to Italian Army in formation) whose ration strength on MAINLAND, SICILY and SARDINIA will be decided from time to time by discussion with HQ ALLIED COMMISSION.

(b) ITALIAN ARMY required for anti Aircraft Artillery and any Co Artillery in SICILY and SARDINIA. Also ITALIAN ARMY required in CORSICA. Categories are under review by Allied Force Headquarters who will announce in due course.

2. For your information I am to say that a proposal has been made by AFHQ to extend the authorized ration colling to include Security Police (Polizia Sicurezza) and fire brigade (Reparti Pompieri). If this is approved it will be necessary for the Minister of Interior to furnish data, for inclusion in periodical strength states, the authorized totals entitled to ration: as agreed from time to time with Public Security Sub Commission, ACC. Further information will follow in due course.
