AFHQ has requested Public Safety to prepare 1200 Finance Guards for service on the frontiers of Northern Italy. AFHQ has directed that the responsibility for clothing and equipping the 1200 Finance Guards rests on Allied Commission.

The Commanding General has applied to the Italian Ministry of Industry, Labour and Commerce for the equipment set out in 7B. The Ministry's reply is given in 7C. So far no satisfaction has been received.

The Commanding General is not prepared to send his men into the mountain passes without proper clothing and equipment. Since these men are likely to be called on very shortly, your assistance in procuring the articles listed in 7B is sought.

" the RGF personnel of the Battaglione Speciale assigned to this Section (83 KM's) need the immediate attention of their HQ. Staff in MILAN and of MAG Lombardia Region.

These RGF arrived in this area on 4 June 1945 and were immediately posted along the Frontier at 15 different posts, all at high altitude and in very rugged terrain.

The clothing and equipment of these men are inadequate for the service expected of them. Some were sent here with makeshift uniforms; part Italian and part British. The shoes may of them wear are even beyond salvage.

The food ration allowance for the RGF is so low that already 2 men have been sent to the Hospital suffering from malnutrition. It should be noted that whereas rations for mountain troops have always been above those of the regular troops, the present food allowances to the RGF are notably smaller than those given ordinary Italian soldiers.

It is not possible to expect these men to petrol their mountain sector while they lack warm clothing, decent shoes, and sufficient food.

Furthermore, if their present condition continues there is the possibility that their malcontentment will degenerate into indifference towards their service and eventual cooperation with the elements they are there to repress.

Warm clothing, suitable footwear, and a sufficient diet are the imperative needs of the RGF assigned to Frontier Control. Should these be not forthcoming, it will be necessary

 2. It is regretted that black uniforms are unsuitable for use by Guardia Finanza on Frontier control. The 600 dyed uniforms referred to were for personnel of the Austrian border. These men have not been called forward, and AFHQ has indicated that these men may not be required.
 3. Accordingly it has been decided to return to you at Naples the 600 dyed uniforms issued in May. It is hoped that if and when the 600 CG.FT are required, proper CG.FT uniforms will be available through Guardia Finanza channels.
 4. Your assistance in this matter is appreciated.

SUBJECT : Dyeing of Clothing for the Frontier Guards

TO : Public Safety Sub-Commission
Lt.Col.Wilson

1. Reference telephone conversation of Lt.Col. Wilson with Mr.White of this Sub-Commission of 2 June and telephone conversation of Lt.Col.Ackermann of A.F.H.Q. with Mr.White of the same date.

2. Lt.Col.Ackermann of 3-4 Section (A) of A.F.H.Q. informed Mr.White that no change has been made in the ruling requiring all clothing ex military stocks allocated by Commerce Sub-Commission to be dyed prior to issue with the exception of clothing to be issued to partisans which will be marked with a yellow "V".

3. Therefore, unless Public Safety Sub-Commission takes up this question with A.F.H.Q. with a view to a modification of this ruling, the Frontier Guards will have to wear dyed garments ex military stocks.

4. In regards the question of the 500 dyed uniforms already allocated to your office and which have proved to be of relatively poor quality, this Sub-Commission hereby authorizes your office to exchange these garments for items of better quality. This exchange will be done in conjunction with the Commerce Division, A.M.C. Naples Commune, and assurance can be given that no difficulties will ensue. This exchange is authorized because it is realized by this Sub-Commission that the Frontier Guards are a military organization and entitled to the best possible garments especially for future use in the winter.

Subject : GG.FF. for frontier control.

To : A.C. P.S. S/C.

In view of agreements reached, yesterday morning, the 27th instant, the GG.FF. soldiers, who were concentrated in Rome, have left for Milan.

Instructions have been issued to the effect that the men, who came from Messina and from Palermo be sent back to their respective Legions. At Naples remain the 200 men of the Naples Legion.

In order to concentrate again the 600 men of the Naples, Messina and Palermo Legions, a 4 or 5 days notice will be necessary.

It is pointed out that the 7 days dry rations and the blankets for the 600 men of the Naples, Messina and Palermo Legions are in Rome. Therefore, when these men will be moved to the North, they should stop half day in Rome, in order to receive their rations and blankets.

In continuation of letter n.240 R.O. dated 11th April, 1945.

The GG.FF. Major LUCCI Renato, who went from Ancona to Bologna immediately after the liberation of the latter, in order to reorganise the Commands and the units of the Corps, has found the Legion Command in full efficiency and the whole personnel favourably considered by the population thanks to the intelligent and efficacious activity carried out by the Commandant Lt.Col. POZZI Giovanni and his officers, as well as the patriotic activity displayed by the Finance Guards during the Nazi-Fascist occupation.

The Allied Authorities, the patriotic organisations and the leaders of the local National Liberation Committee have agreed upon this matter.

Therefore the Allied Provincial Public Safety Commandant has confirmed Lt. Col. POZZI in his functions, reason for which Major LUCCI has made no variations to the present state of matters.

As nevertheless it appears necessary that the Bologna Legion Command be taken over by the proper Commandant for the re-organisation of the units of the adjacent Provinces all dependent from the a/m Legion, the Sub-Commission is requested kindly to solicit the issue of the "pass" to Col. ACAMPORA Giovanni, according to the request made with letter n.312 R.O. of 27th April, 1945.

Subject : Situation of the GG.FF. units distributed in Northern Italy.

To : H.E. the Minister of Finance
To : Colonel J. CHAPMAN - Director P.S. S/C
To : Director of the A.C. Finance S/C.

From Officers of the Force who reached Rome coming from Northern Italy the following information has been received regarding the situation of the Commands and units of the Force distributed in Northern Italy:

- a) To the greater part the Finance Guard gave instances of loyalty to its traditions and has observed patriotic attitude: has co-operated in the clandestine movement of liberation; has not performed tasks of a political character; its activity has always had the approval of the population and has been fully recognised by the National Liberation Committee for Northern Italy, so that the Force has been allowed to make part of the "Corps of Volunteers for Freedom";
- b) the General Headquarters of the Force, organised at Brescia by the Fascist Authorities has been dissolved. At Brescia there remained an office for the settlement of the records. Instead at Milan a "Temporary GG.FF. General Headquarters "Northern Italy" has been constituted, commanded by Colonel MALGERI Alfredo;
- c) General Cerrato, former Commandant of the Force on account of the Fascist Republic, and further 6 superior officers attached to his Command, are at the present time "Held" at Venice;
- d) On the whole the GG.FF. personnel has shown a praiseworthy attitude. Nevertheless the temporary Gen.Hq. has sent on ordinary leave 9 Officers, 12 NCOs and 3 GG.FF., pending investigations in regard to their activity. The temporary Gen.Hq. has issued instructions for the re-employment of the personnel, who arbitrarily left their units after the events of 8th September 1943;
- e) the units of the Force have everywhere taken up again their normal service duties. Furthermore it is pointed out that:

- instructions have been issued for the reconstruction of the units and Commands to be assigned to the service along the frontier borders suspended by the Germans after the 8th of September 1943;
- the nuclei of the economic police have been dissolved;
- f) the ships of the Force have been to the greater part sunk by Germans;
- g) many officers have obtained promotions to the superior rank; the Gen.Hq. of the Fascist Republic has also organised courses for officer and neo Cadets, making arrangements, at the time, for the relative promotions;
- h) it appears that, in Northern Italy, there is a fair availability of clothing and barracks material.

As soon as possible, more exact and complete information will be furnished in regard to the situation of the Commands and units of the Force distributed in the North.
