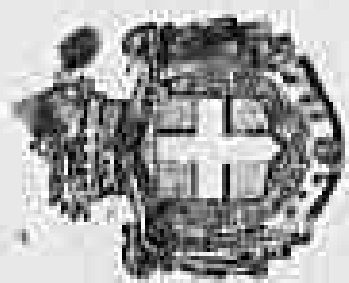

He completed his studies for the priesthood in 1942 and has been endeavouring since that time to travel to Smyrna, Turkey, in order to take up the position of Secretary to the Archbishop of that city. He has already obtained the proper permission for entry into Turkey.

Father Joseph Inglesis, a Greek subject, born at Istanbul June 27th, 1919, is the holder of the Greek passport No. 901, issued at Istanbul August 23rd, 1938. He completed his studies for the priesthood in 1942 and has been unable since that time to return to Istanbul, in which Archdiocese his priestly services are urgently required. Father Gatt expects to obtain an entry-permit for Turkey from the proper authorities at Cairo.

In recommending the requests of Father Gatt and of Father Inglesis to the good offices of His Britannic Majesty's Minister to the Holy See with a view toward effecting the early accomplishment of their long deferred return to Turkey, the Secretariat of State of His Holiness takes the occasion to renew the expression of its most distinguished esteem.

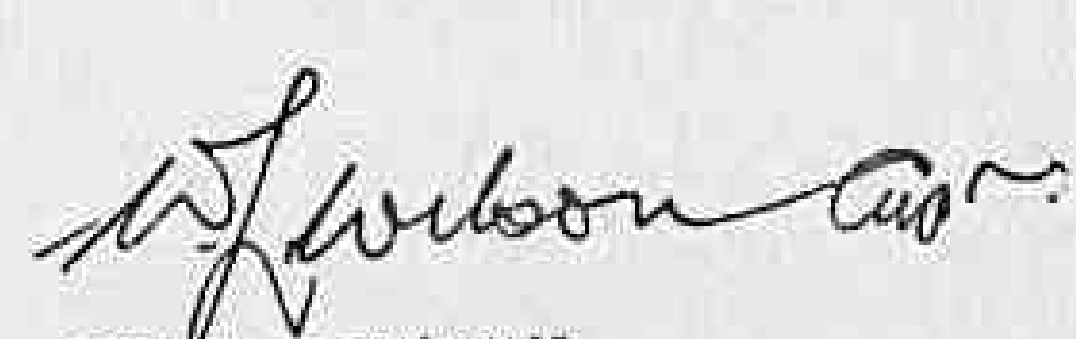

1. Reference is made to your G-5: 300.4-4 of 12 March 1945.
2. Further discussion of this matter with Public Safety Sub-Commission has disclosed that it is not possible to channel requests for M.T.A. and travel orders through two channels only. It is proposed to use three channels as follows:
 - a) Displaced Persons and Repatriation Sub-Commission - all requests for repatriation or evacuation.
 - b) Liaison Division - Diplomats and Officials of the Italian Government, United Nations, Neutrals, International Red Cross, American Relief for Italy, and Knights of Malta.
 - c) Public Safety Sub-Commission - all other requests for M.T.A.
3. It is hoped that this arrangement will be satisfactory to you, and that requests which are forwarded to you through other channels will not be accepted. In this connection, it has come to our notice that requests for civilians to travel have in the past been put forward by other headquarters, e.g. Home Area Allied Command. It is hoped that orders can be issued to put a stop to this practice, as it is not approved.
4. Requests for travel orders will be forwarded together with application for M.T.A. in all cases, except when M.T.A. will obviously not be granted, in which case the application for M.T.A. will be forwarded for information only with no request for travel orders.
5. It is confirmed that in cases where M.T.A. is required applications will be forwarded direct to G-2 (CI), but it is suggested that this procedure should be extended to include cases where A.E.P. permits are required. This suggestion is made because AG Personnel have recently referred to redback such a request to this Headquarters, and have directed that applications for A.E.P. permits should be made to G-2 (CI).
