1. At my suggestion I had an informal meeting with Signor PAUL at U.I.M.E. at 1900 hours 10 November. After exchanging greetings I explained that being responsible to S.A.C. for law and order and security of Allied Troops and their communications in this area I was naturally interested in his visit since when known it might well have repercussions. Signor PAUL informed me that he had just come from a meeting with leading members of the action party at which he had touched on the Venezia Giulia problem in general terms. He explained that the Italian Govts wish and aim was to secure the interests of Italian nationals by agreement, and to do all possible to help in finding a solution which would enable the facilities of the Port of TRIESTE to be accessible to all user nations. He went on to emphasise the moderation and restraint shown by the Italian Government up to date. I agreed that they had shown restraint and expressed the wish that the restraint would continue, adding that in my view it was particularly important at the present juncture that in their own interests the Italians should refrain from any provocative action. He fully agreed and repeated his previous remarks about Italian moderation adding that none of the reconciliatory advances made so far by his Government had elicited any response at all from the Yugoslavs. Signor PAUL then explained that he was attending a general meeting of the action party that evening but that he did not intend to make a formal speech then and in any case would

not be touching on the frontier problem. He appeared to appreciate the interest I had shown in his visit.

2. At this stage I asked Signor PARRI what his own views were on the solution of the problem of Venezia Giulia. He replied that he shared the views already expressed by Signor M. GASPERI. He obviously hoped for a frontier on the WILSON LINE. Though he admitted it might be modified slightly in places to the advantage of Jugoslavia by negotiation with that country. He was most emphatic in the view that no Italian Govt could remain in power if it was prepared to accept a treaty that did not provide for the predominantly Italian city of TRIESTE and west coast of ISTRIA being within the political frontiers of Italy.

3. The discussion then turned to the question of the frontier between Italy and Austria and Signor PARRI said that while Italy had no ethnical claims on the TAVOLICO area he felt very strongly that for economic reasons the southern TYROL must remain in Italy. He added that Italy had however no wish to evict or Italianise the TYROLESE.

4. Signor PARRI then raised the question of the present position of the Italian population in western ISTRIA and enquired whether it would not be possible for Allied troops to intervene to protect them in the case of incidents such as that recently reported at CAPO D'ISTRIA. I explained that I could not take action east of the MORGAN LINE, he then asked if I would point out to any Jugoslav commanders with whom I came in contact how damaging such incidents were to an agreed solution and future

relations between the 2 countries. I agreed to take any opportunities that arose to make that point. Signor PARMI expressed that hope that it ~~XANNA~~ might be possible for Allied warships to visit ports on the west ISANIAN coast which he considered would have a reassuring effect. I replied that I would discuss the matter with GEN MORGAN during his forthcoming visit. This ended the discussion and we parted on the friendliest terms.

1. Ref your FX 51447 of 2nd November. Provincial Commissioner UDINE now reports that he was informed at 1800 hrs today by Prefect and Sinitco that Italian Prime Minister is arriving UDINE at 1630 hours tomorrow 3rd Nov when he will meet province officials and address them on subject of VENEZIA GIULIA which they say he will treat in conciliatory manner.

2. In view of your FX 51447 last para presumably this report is not correct but request urgent confirmation. 13 CORPS actions 2 are stated in sig 0.104 and 0.107 of 1st Nov. Apart from these it is pointed out that if Prime Minister speaks in UDINE tomorrow Prov Commissioner will have had less than 24 hours firm notice of arrival which is not considered sufficient to make necessary arrangements. We have no information as to what Signora PARRI will say and consider if speech on VENEZIA GIULIA

For ALCOM. Please inform 13 COMS direct as requested in his OIO4. If 13 COMS is unwilling to agree, speech decision here is that speech must be postponed until matter fully considered. You must appreciate that your warning was not given in sufficient time to ensure proper co-ordination.

Reference AFHQ signal FX 51267 of 1st November.

1. Statement by Italian Prime Minister on Italo-Yugoslav relations in firm tones, however measured, addressed to frontier population from UDINE, is likely to provoke Yugoslav counter measures. In prevailing conditions these may well disturb present easy (?) calm and leap to series of demonstrations if nothing more. We wish to avoid this and therefore consider undesirable that Prime Minister should raise VENEZIA GIULIA problem in frontier area.

2. We do not object to visit as such providing that it is confined to urging firm action in armoring and food control generally. But in view of difficulty of keeping within these limits if Prime Minister comes to UDINE and real danger that he may be manoeuvred into dealing with the VENEZIA GIULIA problem once here we would rather he did not come.

3. Conclusions. Would prefer visit did not take place. If it absolutely necessary consider that Prime Minister should not address frontier population on Yugoslav relations from UDINE at present time. Such a course is likely to disturb political situation here and prejudice internal security.

Request urgently more details of what line Italian Prime Minister intends to take when addressing frontier population on Italo-Yugoslav relations as this is most likely to provoke some sort of counter measures by Yugoslavs. Such counter measures might well be more firm and less measured than those of Signor PARMI and liable to disturb present delicately poised tranquility here. We are especially anxious to avoid doing this during present critical shortage of key military govt officers and before new police force is firmly established.
