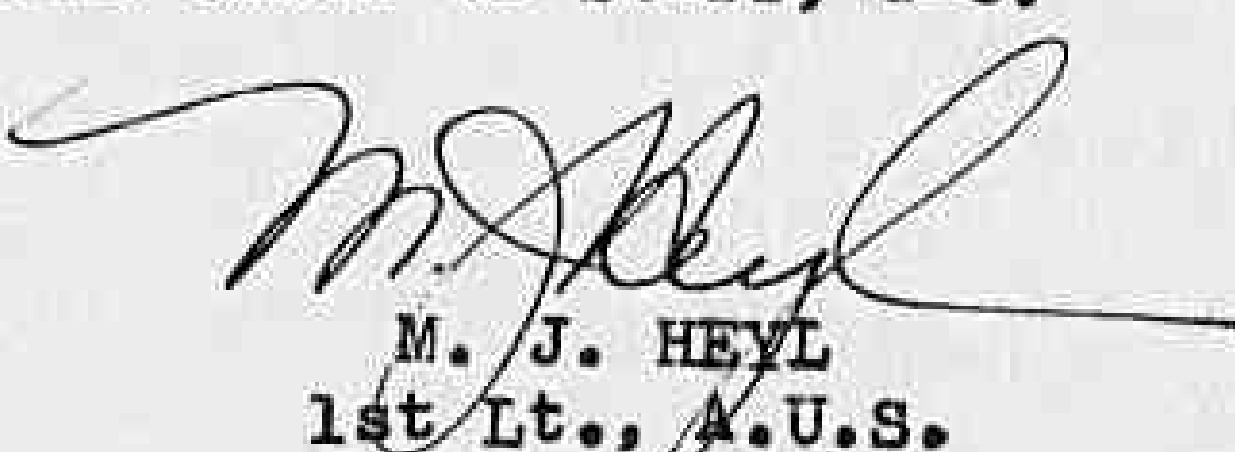

Reference our LPR/3/6-11 (IT).

1. As the present procedure for approving entry permits involves a delay of three or four months before an answer could be given to an application and results in a lot of unnecessary correspondence, a conference was held at this Office on 27 Sep to consider a revised procedure. This conference was attended by Comm. Ratena, Ministry of Interior, and Mr. Acquaviva, Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Major Simmons, G-2 AFHQ, and Lt. Carl E. Fehr, Licensing and Registration, Public Safety S/C, AC.

2. It was agreed:

- a) As to the repatriation of individual Italians into Italy. As no Italian Government agency has a right, under Italian law, to object to the entry of an Italian citizen into Italy, G-2 should issue entry permits without referring the names for approval to the Italian Government.
- b) As to the entry of other nationals into Italy, as disapprovals by the Italian Government are less than 1% that for the time being G-2 would make its own decisions and forward a list of persons to whom a permit has been granted to this H- for submission to the Italian Government.

3. It is requested that the new procedure should be put in effect immediately.

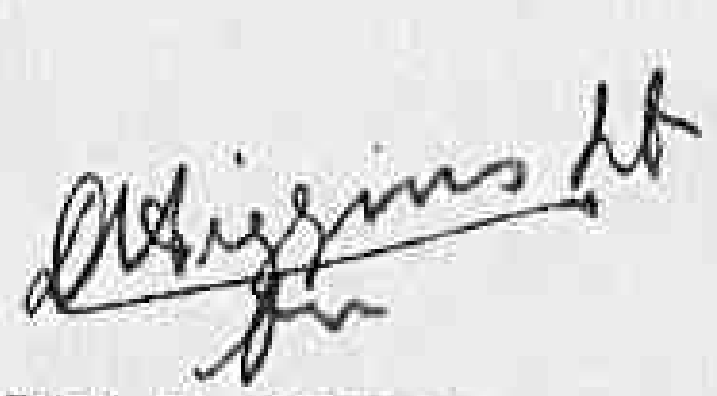

4. It is therefore requested that the whole matter be taken up with the Italian Government on the lines of our letter even reference dated 28 August.

With reference to your request for information with regard to travel into and out of Italy.

1. Military travel authorizations are no longer required for travel out of Italy, and their issue has ceased.
2. Civilians will only be permitted to leave Italy if they are in possession of current passports and visas covering entry into the countries of destination and transit.
3. Civilians will not be permitted to travel by transportation controlled by the Allies unless in possession of military travel orders.
4. Allied systems of control are still in operation for the control of travel into Italy.
5. In the case of travel from Switzerland and France to Italy, application should be made to any U.S. or British Consular Agency in Switzerland or a Travel Permit Office in France for Allied Force Permits.
