- f. Halts: 10 minutes halt at 10 minutes to every second hour.

Vehicles will not close up at halts, and will pull well into the side of the road.

Road sentries will be posted at each halt.

- g. Speed and Density: 15 MPH

- h. Dispersal:

- (i) AIR ATTACK - Vehicles will halt at the nearest cover, maintaining density as far as practicable.
- (ii) ROME - Guides will meet convoy at outskirts of city, and dispersal orders will be issued by Convoy Commander.

4. ADMINISTRATION.

- a. Personnel - Dress: American - Full Field Kit and wool OD.
British - FSMO. Slacks will be worn.
Steel helmets on packs.
- b. Vehicles: Gassed and oiled to capacity. Each vehicle will carry full reserve of gasoline and oil equivalent to tank capacity.
All vehicles will be numbered serially with numbers on tailboard, i.e., A1 or B1, etc.
In each convoy, leading vehicle will carry a blue flag, and rear vehicle a green flag.

c. Rations: Haversack rations (one day) will be carried by all personnel.

Seven (7) days rations will be carried in bulk.
Hot meal will be available on arrival.

d. Hygiene:

- (i) Water - Water bottles will be filled.

Under no circumstances will water be used for drinking or cooking from lakes, streams or pools unless it has been chlorinated, and then only on orders of Convoy Commanders.

- (iii) Itabrine will be issued with rations.

MOVE OF MAIN AND REAR HEADQUARTERS TO NEW LOCATION

This Headquarters, Main and Rear, will move in the near future to HOME. The move of each group, as undernoted, will be completed within twenty-four (24) hours. The method of the move will be as follows:

1. Reconnaissance Party.

This party will leave 2359 hrs.. 10 June 1944, under command of Major B. L. DRAGE, RMSC, to whom separate orders have already been issued, and who will report on arrival at HOME to the Deputy Executive Commissioner (Colonel FISKE).

2. Advance Party.

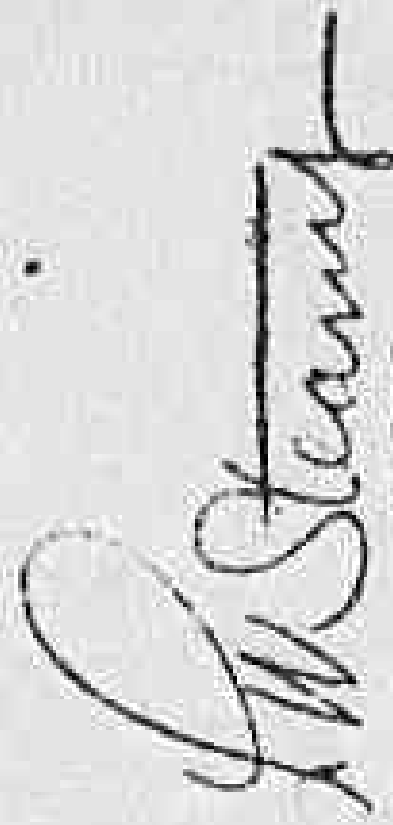

1. Reference is made to Warning Order of today's date.
2. PERSONAL BAGGAGE - a. Baggage of officers who will move to SALERNO on 26 January 1944:

(1) Officers will pack as much baggage as will not be needed the night of 25 January, and prepare it for shipment, marking it clearly with name and rank. By 0900, 25 January, every officer will report to the Billeting Office, Headquarters Commandant's Section, the location and description of such baggage. This will be assembled during the day by the Headquarters Commandant's Section at a central point.

(2) On the morning of 26 January, the Headquarters Commandant will spot vehicles in front of, or near, each billet between 0700 and 0730 to pick up the remaining baggage. It is the responsibility of each officer to notify the Billeting Office, (Extension 39), before 1300, 25 January, where he wants this vehicle spotted. This baggage also should be clearly marked with the officer's name and rank. This baggage will then be carried to a central point.

(3) Baggage not ready by 0730 will have to be carried by the officer himself.

- b. Officers moving to SALERNO on 27 January 1944:

(1) Same rules as the above, except that each item will take place 24 hours later.

3. OFFICE EQUIPMENT - a. No T/E equipment, namely, typewriters, stapling machines, field desks, and the like will be taken to SALERNO.

b. No office equipment, such as desks, tables, chairs, bookcases, filing cabinets, and the like will be taken to SALERNO.

c. Before 1300, 26 January, the Administrative Directorate and AG will phone the Office Section (Extension 39), Headquarters Commandant's Office, stating the number and size of boxes desired for transport of equipment for each sub-section. Empty boxes will be delivered promptly as called for.

d. Before 1530, 26 January, all boxes will be packed.

e. Between 1530 and 1630, carpenters will come to each section to close the boxes. Boxes that are not ready by 1530, 26 January, cannot be taken. Painters will come at the same time and will paint on the boxes the identification of the section, and number the boxes.

GENERAL

1. On 14 Dec. 1943, at 0730 hours HEADQUARTERS ALLIED MILITARY GOVERNMENT will be moved from present station to new stations, "W", and "S".

1. All officers BN/GR's designated to change station and named in par. 2 and 3, S.O. No. 34, or any amendment thereto will move overlaid by motor vehicle convoy, which will depart from convoy assembly point at Officers' Mess on Via Stadio 11 December 1943, at 0730 hours.

2. Lt. Col. E.R. CIPRES is designated as CONVOY COMMANDER. He will immediately prepare convoy march orders, (containing details from G-4 branch) and will designate subordinate command, police, supply and security officers. All officers other than those designated as convoy officers will be considered as passengers and will not issue orders or take part in the operation thereof, except under emergency conditions.

2. Lt. Col. R.R. CRIGGS is designated as CONVOY OVERSEER. He will immediately prepare convey march order, (containing details from C-4 Branch) and will designate sub-conveyors, police, supply and security officers. All officers other than those designated as convey officers will be considered as passengers and will not issue orders or take part in the operation thereof, except under emergency conditions.

3. All personnel designated by par. 2 and 3, S.O. No. 31 will be considered alerted immediately on publication of this order and shall prepare baggage: (a) Baggage shall be clearly marked with paint, on each piece, with name and serial number of owner and "AMO-HQ". (b) Each officer must personally advise Headquarters Commandant Office his correct billet address. There are no EM/OM's available for performance of messenger duties to summon officers who do not have correct addresses on file. Before 0900 hours 10 December 1943 all officers on Land Convey will place their baggage, packed and marked for shipment, near the main door of their billet, to be picked up, with the exception of bedding rolls, shelter halves and mess kits. Bedrolls will be rolled, packed and ready for shipment at the main door of the Officers' Billets not later than 0600, 11 December 1943. Prescribed uniform:

1. It is planned to move this Headquarters to the Naples area in the near future as follows:

a. Advance Party - one officer of each Sub-Commission, Directorate and Section staff and an Executive Officer, and a small housekeeping group from Headquarters Commandant, including provisions for the Officers' Mess.

b. Main Body - remainder of Headquarters except one responsible staff officer from each: the Communications Section, the Economic Directorate and the Administrative Directorate and an Executive Officer and a small housekeeping detail.

c. Rear Party - all remaining personnel.

2. Each Section, Directorate, Sub-Commission and Branch will list by name the officers to be included in the Advance Party and Rear Party and the number of officers in the Main Body. Lists will be completed on the attached forms and turned in to the Executive Officers by Section, Directorate and Branch Staff at the earliest and not later than Monday, 29 November 1943.

3. Each Section, Directorate, Sub-Commission and Branch will promptly eliminate non-essential materials and equipment. A committee, under direction of G-4 branch, will visit all offices to estimate quantities and weights of equipment and supplies to be moved.
