Corporal Kiddier joined the army in November 1942 and was posted in December 1943 to North Africa as a driver. On arrival he was employed in the British Administration office of the A.M.C. Holding Centre at Tisi-Ouson.

In February 1944 he was posted to Italy and was employed in the office of Industry & Commerce Sub-Commission of the Allied Commission and was regraded as Clerk R.A.S.C. (private) and on the 1st May 1944 was promoted Lance Corporal.

With transfer of Allied Commission to Rome L/Cpl Kiddier continued to work with the Commerce Sub-Commission and took over the work of Chief Clerk in October 1945 being promoted Corporal in February 1946.

Owing to decline of the amount of work in Commerce Sub-Commission Corporal Kiddier was transferred as Chief Clerk to the Public Safety Division in October 1946.

In this latter post he has worked quietly and efficiently. He is by nature of a quiet disposition and in his contacts with civilian staff and military sub-ordinates has an unassuming and yet confident manner which demands and receives co-operation. 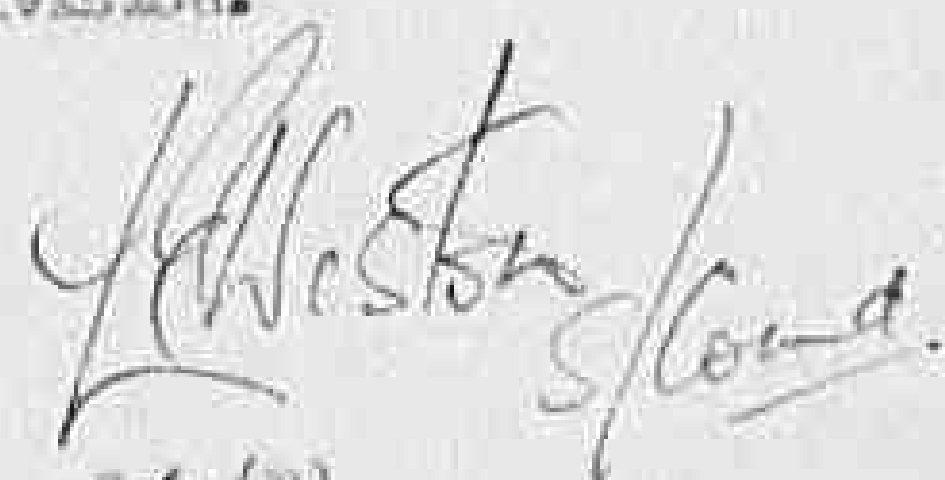

1. The position with regard to clerical staff is that within the next month the effective strength of Br. clerks in A.C. will be approximately 160, less than one third W.E.

In addition the rapid reduction on the American H.M. side is increasing the British commitments.

2. Under these circumstances there is little hope of providing replacements for Sub Commissions which are already comparatively well staffed.

3. Chief Clerk Local Govt. Sub Commission.

7. It is thought that Cpl. ROBINSON will have returned to duty by the time S/Sgt. GILBERTSON is due for release.

L/Cpl. LISBERG has applied for extension of leave on compassionate grounds, but there is, as yet, no official sanction for this.

8. It is regretted that your requests for additional staff cannot be met, but the shortage of clerical staff, not merely in A.C. but throughout the Theatre, renders this impossible.

1. On the morning of Saturday 22nd September 1945 urgent arrangements were being made to reinforce the Police strength in Naples in view of the Public Safety position, which had deteriorated following the employment of German P.C.'s at the docks.

2. At 12.40 pm it became known that 150 Carabinieri were available in Rome for transfer to Naples if Allied transport could be arranged.

3. The Police Division of this Sub-Commission telephoned to your Rails Division, and Sergt M. ROTHWELL was spoken to in the absence of officer personnel who were at lunch. He offered to explore the possibility of arranging a special train and at 1 pm confirmed that the matter was being discussed with the Railway authorities.

4. At 1.30 pm Sergt. Rothwell communicated to the Police Division the firm arrangement that sufficient railway trucks were waiting at Rome Termini and would leave for Naples as soon as the Carabinieri could arrive at the Station.

5. The arrangements made at such short notice proved entirely satisfactory, and I desire to place on record my great appreciation of the assistance rendered by Sergeant Rothwell. He received the original 591.

1. Public Safety Sub-Commission requests that the ceiling for IM/OR now allotted be increased to six. The present ceiling is four.

2. This request is based upon the fact that during the past two months the work of this Sub-Commission has almost doubled and is still increasing. Some of the reasons for the increase in volume of work are :-

a. Increase in territory released to AM/AC.

b. Due to more rigid enforcement of administrative policies, particularly in connection with security, more work and responsibility has been placed on the IM/OR staff.

c. Italian Ministries are submitting for transmittal into AMG and Army territory an even increasing volume of correspondence which, under present directive, requires registering in and out, translating and vetting. This must be done under the immediate supervision of an IM or OR.

d. There is a constant increase of War Graves and Welfare enquiries.

e. Through recent agreement with G-2, AFHQ, Military Travel Authorization applications are now channeled through this Sub-Commission.

f. Under present condition it is imperative to maintain a Summary of Riots and Disturbances as well as a Summary on Disasters of Allied Troops.

7. On 7 Sep 44 DIAZ was given his weekly rest day. On 8 Sep 44 he failed to report for duty. It was then found that he was working in Transportation Liaison Section and had actually commenced duty on 7 Sep 44 (when he should have taken his rest day).

8. DIAZ has clearly disobeyed the verbal order given to him by Capt. Powell on 5 Sep 44.

9. On 9 Sep 44 I saw Col. Adams, Director of the Transportation Sub-Commission and explained to him what had taken place. He said that all the arrangements regarding DIAZ and MARINELLI had been made by Col. MEAHEY (formerly in Public Safety Sub-Commission) and that he would speak to Col. MEAHEY as soon as possible. In the meanwhile he was not prepared to take any action to return DIAZ to Public Safety Sub-Commission.

10. I feel most strongly that the manner in which this matter has been dealt with behind my back and to the detriment of the work of this Sub-Commission demands investigation.
