SUBJECT: Transfer of the P.S. Commissario, Dr Della Feruta Gerardo

TO : AMG. EQ. Region 3, Public Safety Office

In answer to your letter dated 28 February 1944:

1. The ministerial order dated 10 January 1944 concerning the transfer of the Commissario Della Feruta Gerardo to the Ministry did not arrive to this office.

On February 22, 1944 I went to the Ministry of the Interior in Salerno, I was urged to send the said Functionary, with a copy of the letter you gave me which I return, and I immediately complied with the disposition.

I have no knowledge that the order was given with approval of the Allied Military Government. I add that with letter dated 25 February the Ministry communicated that Della Feruta is to be considered in continual mission in Salerno.

The Ministry, with letter dated 22 February 1944 N° 2091 P.S. 14. gave to the same orders, concerning the Vice-Commissario Aggiunto, Palma Gennaro, who have been sent on a long mission by the Questura of Salerno. Even for these, it is not sure, if the orders were given, with or without the AMG's approval.

2. In the case of Dr. Della Feruta the Questura has nothing to say.
