1. With reference to Memorandum ACC/42/INT, dated 19th April, 1944, and the Schedule which accompanied it, I have to point out that according to the Proclamation it was understood that all Organisations and appointments made under AMG would be accepted, and this has been subsequently confirmed by A.C.C. Headquarters.

2. In the field of Public Safety Orders were made involving the following organisations and appointments thereunder:

Carabinieri Reali.
Guardia di Finanza.
Regional Directorate of Public Security.
— Questori - Public Security
Regional Director Prison Service.
Regional Commander of Fire and Civil Defence Services.
Commissioner of the Corps of Railway Police.
Commander Forestry Corps.
Chief Director of R.A.C.I., Sicily.

3. It would seem advisable therefore and indeed necessary that Allied Control Commission should be consulted before variations are made in senior appointments of any of the Organisations mentioned above.

4. I submit that if this is not done then much of the work of reconstruction and reorganisation which has already been undertaken will be rendered futile.
