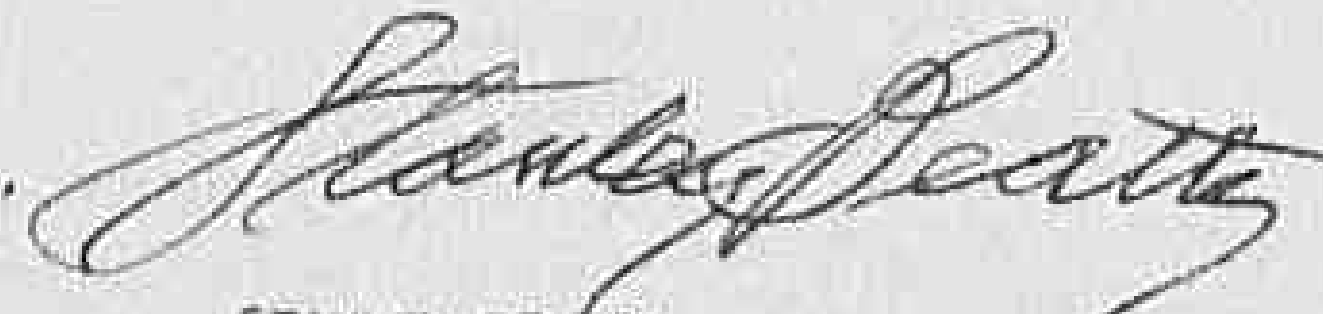

1. THE SECOND INSTANCE, WITHIN THE PAST FORTY EIGHT HOURS, HAS JUST COME TO LIGHT HERE IN WHICH THE MINISTER OF THE INTERIOR AT ROME HAS ORDERED THE TRANSFER OF A KEY COMMISSARIO FROM DUTY IN LEGHORN TO A POINT ELSEWHERE.

2. COMMISSARIO FRENZUELLI, FILIPPO, ASSIGNED TO DUTY IN THE OFFICE OF QUESTURA AT LIVORNO, HAS NOW BEEN ORDERED TRANSFERRED WITHOUT WARNING. AS SHOWN IN MY PAST SEVERAL REPORTS, A COMPLETE, AND SATISFACTORY REORGANIZATION IN THE QUESTURA'S OFFICE HAS BEEN EFFECTED, WITH EXCELLANT RESULTS. IT IS A SMOOTH WORKING TEAM AND COORDINATION IS PERFECT. MILITARY POLICE AND OTHER SECURITY UNITS HERE ARE DEEPLY IMPRESSED WITH THE GOOD WORK BEING DONE BY THE PUBLIC SECURITY SERVICE (QUESTURA), AND THIS OFFICER FEELS THAT FREQUENT CHANGES OF PERSONNEL IN KEY POSITIONS CAN ONLY HAMPER THE PRESENT EFFICIENT PERFORMANCE OF THE ORGANIZATION.

3. THIS OFFICER CERTAINLY HAS NO DESIRE TO BE AT ODDS WITH THE MINISTER OF THE INTERIOR AND IT IS MY AIM TO COOPERATE WITH HIS DEPARTMENT IN EVERY WAY POSSIBLE. I DO OBJECT, HOWEVER, TO SUDDEN CHANGES OF KEY PERSONNEL IN THE OFFICE AT LIVORNO, AS IT HAS A TENDENCY TO MATERIALLY EFFECT THE GENERAL EFFICIENCY OF THEIR PRESENT HIGH STANDARD.

On 25 January 1944, the P.S. Commissario AGE. BARBATO Mario has been discharged from duty by the Allied Military Authorities, as he was in the Fascist Party since 3rd June 1922 (antemarcia and squadrista)

The High Commissioner for the epuration of the Administration has now notified the opportunity of restoring to duty the a/m official, pointing out, that said, according to what certified by Capt. K.A.F. Montes of the Field Security Section, has organized the information service for the Allied Troops, bringing messages through the mountains of the High Appennino; he has organized and parthen in pioneer squads, damaging bridges, roads and German vehicles and actively propagated among soldiers of not German nationality, though enrolled in the German Army, so that some of those soldiers deserted said Army and joined the Partisan Bands; he helped escaped Allied prisoners with shelter, food and clothes. Besides, though searched by the Police of the so called Republican Government and under warrant of arrest, he refused to take service at the Frosinore questura, suffering consequently privations and hunger.

Ref. to verbal request, we are informing your Commission, that in January 1944, the vice questore Guglielmi Pasquale forwarded a petition in order to be transferred from Benevento and temporarily aggregated to the Naples Questura, as not having succeeded in finding lodgings, he was obliged to leave his large family in Naples.

The Prefect of Benevento, confirmed the enterprise of Guglielmi, and in April 1944 communicated, that this Commissioner had expressed a favorable opinion on said matter to the General Control Commissariato in Naples, but said Commissariato should have verbally made known his opinion contrary to the assignment of Guglielmi to Naples. Therefore said Prefect turned to the Ministry, so that said official could be assigned to another office, in order to enable him to bring his family with him.

Guglielmi in the meanwhile was granted leave. In June 1944, Guglielmi forwarded a petition in order to obtain the direction of a questura in the newly liberated Provinces, and in consequence this Ministry not having any personal files of the officials, because carried to the North by Pseudo Republican Govnt., asked the Prefect of Naples to give informations on the activity of said official.

Said Prefect, with letter dated 4 July 1944, on communicating, that Guglielmi had performed there duties from 1925 to 1942 and successively in Pisa and Benevento, expressed himself as follows:

"During said period he distinguished himself for his particular professional ability and has been also entrusted with delicate services, which required particular technical competence, which he carried out in a praiseworthy manner.

He has shown satisfactory directive attitudes, therefore I consider him capable to assume the direction of one of the questure of the newly liberated Provinces."

As a result of what stated about, said official was proposed for the direction of the Leghorn Questura.

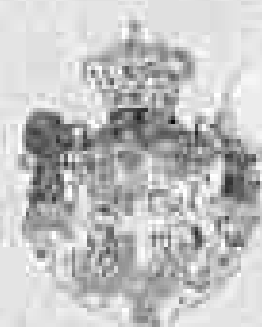

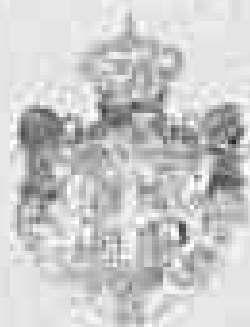
