By means of the Lucca Prefecture I forwarded a request for
 a kind affirmation of the appointment also including a copy of
 said note, notwithstanding that, the Ministry has, probably by
 mistake, transferred me to ORVIETO P.S. Commissariat.

Such transfer not asked for damages me much:

- 1) economically as for the high cost of living in ORVIETO (superior to other cities) for which my limited wages cannot permit but a very scanty and miserable life. My situation here is very difficult indeed as I am even unable to satisfy my previous engagements since the period of the nazifascist domination when I left the office without taking any salary for not willing to collaborate with them.

My transfer to Florence, instead, would alleviate the expenses as I expect to get free lodgings by my relatives residing ^{there} in Via Boccaccio 104.

- 2) From the studying point of view, as I am since 6 years a volunteer assistant at the desk of administrative law at the University of Florence where it becomes necessary in the free hours after office work to be in constant touch with my University

In consideration of the a/m reasons, particularly for my patriotic activities explicated in the clandestine period during which I have lost everything, considering that in Orvieto my meagre salary compels me to such life as to injure my professional dignity as also that of P.S. Official, I beg the Ministry to kindly affirm the contents of a/m note.

Where it not possible for the moment to grant me the office in Florence I should subordinately ask to be assigned to Pistoia-Pisa-Catania-Bologna-Viareggio.

Lucca Province, mi venne partecipato che cotesto On.le Ministero aveva disposto il mio trasferimento dalla Questura di Lucca a quella di Firenze.

Nonostante avessi inviato, tramite la Prefettura di Lucca, per la cortese convalida, copia conforme di detto foglio, cotesto Ministero mi ha, credo erroneamente, trasferito al Commissariato P.S. di Orvieto.

Tale trasferimento da me non richiesto mi danneggia molto:

- 1) economicamente per il fatto che col solo modesto stipendio non riesco a fronteggiare l'elevato costo della vita (superiore a quello delle altre città) in Orvieto dove, per altro, non esistono decenti ed accoglienti mense a prezzi possibili. Con tale stipendio che non mi consente di vivere qui nemmeno miseramente sono venuto a trovarmi in una situazione assai difficile e tale da non potere soddisfare anche gli impegni presi al tempo della dominazione dei nazi-fascisti quando, per non offrire la mia collaborazione ai medesimi, mi allontanai d'ufficio senza percepire stipendio alcuno.

Il trasferimento in Firenze allevierebbe, invece, le mie spese avendo la possibilità di ottenere l'alloggio gratuito presso i miei parenti colà abitanti in Via Boccaccio 104.

- 2) dal punto di vista degli studi per il fatto che essendo da circa 6

anni assistente volontario alla cattedra di diritto amministrativo presso la R. Università di Firenze, ho bisogno di stare, nelle ore libere d'ufficio, a colloquio con i miei professori Universitari per avere da essi l'indirizzo del caso onde sostenere prossimamente gli esami per conseguimento della libera docenza.

In considerazione dei motivi di cui sopra, particolarmente della mia attività patriottica esplicata durante il periodo clandestino, durante la quale tutto ho perduto, considerato che in Orvieto il mio magro stipendio mi costringe a vivere una vita tale da ledere fortemente la mia dignità di professionista nonché quella di funzionario di P.S. prego cotesto On.le Ministero di volere cortesemente convalidare il contenuto del citato foglio.

Informo, altresì, che l'Ufficio P.S. di Orvieto, a cui in data 20 settembre sono stato trasferito, per la ridondanza dei locali, per la mancanza di personale (in tutto 2 Agenti ed un Saresciallo) e del più elementare oggetto di cancelleria non è affatto in grado di potere iniziare la propria attività. Ciò mi costringe anche a stare inoperoso mentre in altre questure avrei modo, come ho fatto in altri centri, di dar prova della mia capacità e del mio spirito di sacrificio.

Ove non fosse possibile concedermi per ora la sede di Firenze chiedo subordinatamente di essere assegnato a Pistoia - Pisa - Catania - Bologna - Viterbo.

Oltre al foglio anzidetto unisco un attestato del Capitano R.S. Martley attualmente Capo dell'Ufficio Polizia A.M.C. presso la Questura di Genova che mi ha avuto per quasi un anno suo attivo collaboratore.

Sperando in un benevole urgente accoglimento resto in attesa di un cortese riscontro ed invio sentite grazie.

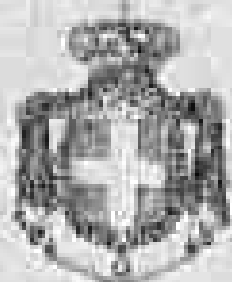

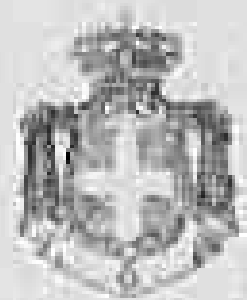

I feel it to be my duty to inform you of the situation of the Public Force in Florence as regards the Questura and the P.S. Garde Corps.

On the 15th February last about 60 P.S. Agents, from various offices, gathered in the courtyard of the barracks to protest against the economic treatment accorded to them. They had been invited to meet by means of a written circular, dated 14th February, of which copy is attached.

According to what has been told me by the Commander, Major Agostino Attini, Captain G. Battista Arista started during the meeting to pronounce words which were not in conformity with discipline and which were of an extremist political tone, but he was stopped by the intervention of the Commander, which served to put an end to the manifestation, because the Agents, having been assured that measures were being taken in their favour, returned to work.

This event, obviously serious, is to be considered in conjunction with the particular political situation in Tuscany and especially Florence, and above all should be considered the political attitude of Captain Arista. He is in fact notoriously tied to the Communist Party, to the exponents of the Tuscan Committee of Liberation and to the provincial Delegate for Education, Dott. Emilio Gabrielli, bodies and persons who politically dominate Florence in complete disagreement with the Prefect of the Province.

I feel it to be my duty to inform you of the situation of the Public Force in Florence as regards the Questura and the P.S. Guards Corps.

On the 15th February last about 50 P.S. Agents, from various offices, gathered in the courtyard of the barracks to protest against the economic treatment accorded to them. They had been invited to meet by means of a written circular, dated 13th February, of which copy is attached.

According to what has been told me by the Commander, Major Agostino Attina, Captain G. Battista Arista started during the meeting to pronounce words which were not in conformity with discipline and which were of an extremist political tone, but he was stopped by the intervention of the Commander, which served to put an end to the manifestation, because the Agents, having been assured that measures were being taken in their favour, returned to work.

This event, obviously serious, is to be considered in conjunction with the particular political situation in Tuscany and especially Florence, and above all should be considered the political attitude of Captain Arista. He is in fact notoriously tied to the Communist Party, to the exponents of the Tuscan Committee of Liberation and to the Provincial Delegate for Emigration, Dott. Emilio Gabriellini, bodies and persons who politically dominate Florence in complete disagreement with the Prefect of the Province, who for months has continued to hold his difficult and dangerous position only through the authoritative and benevolent support of the local Allied Command.

With the idea of re-establishing discipline, in the month of December last, I thought of sending to Florence a Superior Officer to assume Command of the Agents' Division.

The Tuscan Committee of National Liberation coming to know of my plans, had me requested, through the Under Secretary of State M.E. Cenerari, not to substitute Captain Arista in the Command of this Division. But I persisted in my decision and sent Major Attina to Florence.

He sent me a confidential report in which he told me of the difficult conditions in which he found himself on

account of his hostile reception and the inclined atmosphere, due to the fact that a great number of the Agents are "auxiliaristas" (287), enlisted without the usual guarantees, and because the greater part of these Agents belonged to the Communist Party or had leanings towards it.

All the same the noble efforts of this officer have succeeded up to now in maintaining a situation which is not exceptionally irregular, although always dangerous, so much so that the Prefect of the Province has again recently sent me an urgent report to the effect that the Agents' Division gives no guarantee of collaboration in the maintenance of public order should any political agitation break out.

The situation is just as abnormal in the Questura.

In fact the Questore, Dott. Virgilio Goldani Benzi, is a tool of the Tuscan National Liberation Committee and gives no collaboration at all to the Prefect, who is obviously in difficult conditions, in fact on the 17th January last he sent a severe letter to the Questore denouncing the inactivity of the Public Force in face of dangerous political manifestations, which in various forms were prevailing the city.

The heart and soul of this state of disorder into which the Public Force of Florence is thrown may be held to be Captain Inista, in whose regard it is reported to me that he was a fervent Fascist and volunteered for the Spanish war, and then passed to Communism availing himself of the credit of his patriotic activities during the period of resistance to the Nazis to acquire a preeminent position in political circles and therefore over the Questura on whose chief he should, for reasons of discipline, depend.

Thus I have felt it right to communicate for possible measures.

All the same the noble efforts of this officer have succeeded up to now in maintaining a situation which is not exceptionally irregular, although always dangerous, so much so that the Prefect of the Province has again recently sent me an urgent report to the effect that the Agents' Division gives no guarantee of collaboration in the maintenance of public order should any political agitation break out.

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This I have felt it right to communicate for possible measures.

On the 7th instant, the Prefect of Florence called at this Headquarters (Local Government S/C) and requested strong support of A.C.C., in regard to the Questura at Florence.

He stated that he was having trouble with the Committee of Liberation, which is making appointments to office, informing the Prefect afterwards. Also that they had sent him a letter warning him that if he did not change his attitude that they would ignore him completely.

The Prefect fears that the situation will worsen, and spread if strong action is not taken. He requested the immediate assignment of 5 Questura officials. The Director of Public Security, Ministry of Interior was consulted, and 5 Questura officials were nominated at once, and special transport arranged and they left for Florence this day.

Cables were sent on the 8th instant to A.M.G. informing that the officials had been requested by the Prefect and that in view of the urgency they were being sent forward anticipating approval of A.M.G. 5 Army.

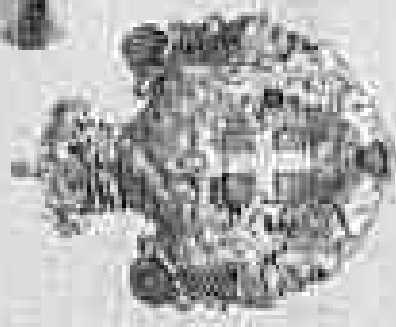

MORANTE Dr. Francesco. Commissario di P.S. - Informations.

Deprived of personal dignity, unbalanced and of unsound character he lacked political dignity and adapted easily himself to every circumstance.

With little moral sense, he was one of those functionary ready to sell their dignity for personal advantages. He directed for many years the S. Iacopino Office and was known by all to be easily corrupted and bribed. His responsibility, also in the period of Republican Fascism, is more of the moral than of the political order.

One fact which may put him in the right place is that occurred when he, taking advantage of his charge, helped ~~with~~ the population to loot the Military Stores of Porta al Prato after the air-raid; this fact is known by every person living in that neighbourhood.

He always was pro-Germans, and most faithfully obeyed the orders of his superiors. Substantially, he was discharged more for moral than political reasons.

BERTOIA Dr. Martino, Commissario Aggiunto di P.S. Informations.

A weak man and an incapable functionary, with a sad lack of culture. Lacking initiative, lacking tact towards everybody.

Without a political conscience, he belonged to those functionary who, even unwillingly, favoured every Fascist immorality.

From the political point of view there is nothing particularly incriminating.

He was for many years in charge at the Office of P.S. for the Railroads. Afterwards in the Questura he assumed the direction of the Automobile Park of the Police. During the Republican period he did nothing to prevent the Germans from taking away all vehicles, and prevented his dependents from hiding a few.

CECCHETTI Dr. Leonello. Volontario V. Commissario Aggiunto di P.S.

Absolutely insignificant and mediocre in every way, especially morally. Was the only one inscribed at the P.R.F. voluntarily, among the Prefettura functionaries. For that inscription had a raise of 600.- a month and was assigned to Manganiello's Office.

MINICUCCI Dr. Cesare. Commissario di P.S. Informations.

In Florence since 1940, from Cosenza. Has never shown any political tendency; attached to his own personal interest to

MINICUCCI Dr. Cesare. Commissario di P.S. Informations.

In Florence since 1940, from Cosenza. Has never shown any political tendency; attached to his own personal interest to an extreme degree. No facts are known as yet, but it is believed that he accepted bribes. A very mediocre man, lacking dignity.

CARBONETTO Dr. Benedetto. Commissario agg. di P.S. Informations.

Especially known for the cruelty with which he conducted the inquiries for political repressions. Was on a mission in LUDIANA (Croatia) in July and August 1941, torturing there men and women. Is in Florence since July 1943. Not being known in the Town, he

remained in charge during the Badoglio period. When Questore Manna came he kept his Office as Chief of Cabinet, and showed himself as a friend of Nazi-Fascists.

ROCCO Domenico. V. Commissario di P.S. Informations.

Professionally able, quiet and unsociable, he has never shown political opinions of any sort. Was chief of the Annonary Police and in that capacity took bribes.

It is difficult to gather concrete proofs of his culpability, although he is notorious in business circles for corruption.

During the period of Republican Fascism he is responsible, together with Prefect Manganiello of many irregularities in the Annonary Office.

Lastly there is against him the friendship shown towards Dr. ZANTI. It is also ascertained that Dr. ROCCO shared with Capt. CARDILLO of the Guardia di Finanza and his men bicycles, flour, oil, leather and shoes.

CAPUTO Dr. Ulderigo. Commissario di P.S. Informations.

Cultivated and intelligent, he took advantage of the favour shown him by Questore DADDUZZIO. Great admirer of Nazism, he tried to convince to his creed his dependents. Promoted a course in German language in Florence.

After the fall of Mussolini, he went to Rome with his German wife, and when after Sept. 8th German invasion was completed in North Italy, he was easily transferred to the Questura in Florence. There he tried to shift his allegiance, openly declaring himself against Fascism, and helping some American and English Citizens from Concentration Camp. Dr. CAPUTO only acted so in order to save his position in the future, but was very foolish to declare openly that such were his motives.

CHIRIACO Dr. Carlo. Commissario Capo di P.S. Informazioni

Very unbalanced, and a perfect coward, essentially a most despicable man. Not particularly cruel or corrupted, but never daring to mitigate orders from above which may have appeared unjust even to him. His responsibility is of the heaviest, as he became more and more the servant of Germans and Fascists.
