Reference your AC/10041/32/PS dated 19th November, 1944. =

1. Enquiries have been made concerning a/m but little information can be obtained regarding the reason for his arrest and internment by the Allied Military Authorities. It appears that this action was taken on the directions of the then S.C.A.P.O. of Agrigento, Major Ashworth, owing to subject's political tendencies. He is alleged to have removed his personal records prior to his arrest.

2. Present information concerning Dalogli is conflicting. On the one hand he is spoken of as being a man of very good reputation but on the other hand he is said to have been an ardent fascist who worked in close liaison with Fascist "Federali" and remains a fascist at heart.

3. In these circumstances it would appear that Dalogli should be subjected to the prescribed epuration proceedings before being considered for re-appointment in the Police Service and that if after such proceedings are taken the Italian Authorities desire to reinstate him, the Allied Commission should be further consulted.

Reference previous correspondence, we have the honour to appoint for the direction of the Cosenza questura, the 2nd class questore DALOGLIO Antonio, actually at the disposal of the Ministry.

On 20 July 1943, Daloglio, already questore of Agrigento was arrested by the local Allied Military Command and interned in North Africa and later transferred to the Padula concentration camp. He was released on 11/8/44.

The Ministry with letter, even number, dated 30/8/44, was asking your Commission to kindly make know the reasons, which had caused his internment and this to have data for an eventual re-appointment of Daloglio.

As your Commission with letter ACC/14041/32/PS, dated 24 Sep. 44, has communicated, not to be in a position to give further informations, this Ministry is proposing the a/m appointment.

We attach a brief biography, adding that the scheda personale was certainly submitted in due time by Daloglio to the Allied Military Authorities of Agrigento.

It would be appreciated to know that Commission's opinion on said matter.

Nato il 30 luglio 1885 - a.f.3 - Entrato nell'Amministrazione della P.S. il 13.4.1912 ha percorso tutta la sua carriera a Brescia. Nominato Vice Questore ha esercitato le sue funzioni ad Alessandria e Pisa. Nel gennaio 1942 venne incaricato della reggenza della questura di Agrigento e nell'aprile dello stesso anno venne promosso questore.

Il 20 luglio 1943 dal locale Comando Militare Alleato venne internato nell'Africa del Nord e poi trasferito nel Campo di concentramento di Padula. L'11 agosto 1944 venne rilasciato.

Born on 30 July 1885 - married - three children - Entered the P.S. Administration on 13/4/1912 - has always been at Brescia - Appointed Vice Questore he performed his duties at Alessandria and Pisa. In January 1942 he was appointed director of the Agrigento Questura and in April of the same year he was promoted Questore.

On 20 July 1943, he was interned in North Africa by the Allied Military Command and then transferred to the Padula concentration camp. On 11 August 1944 he was released.
