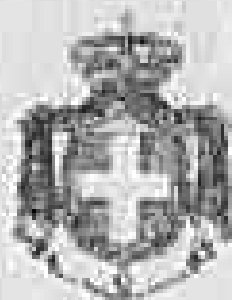

For service reasons this Ministry would like to
assign to Pisa the Head Commissioner of P.S., IPPOLITO Umberto,
who was at the La Spezia Questura, which office he left to
avoid being carried off by the Germans, taking himself and
his family, some time ago, to Pietrasanta (Lucca).

In this regard it is pointed out that although no
information is available as to the activities of the above-
mentioned official after September 1943 and up to the date

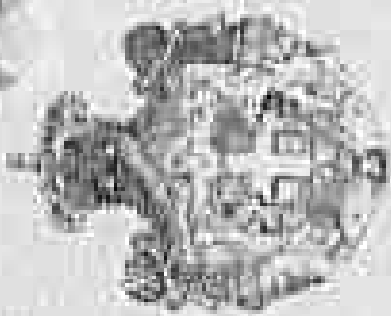
