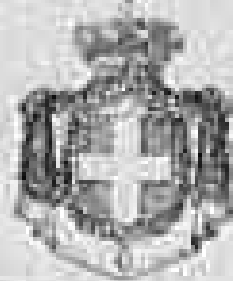

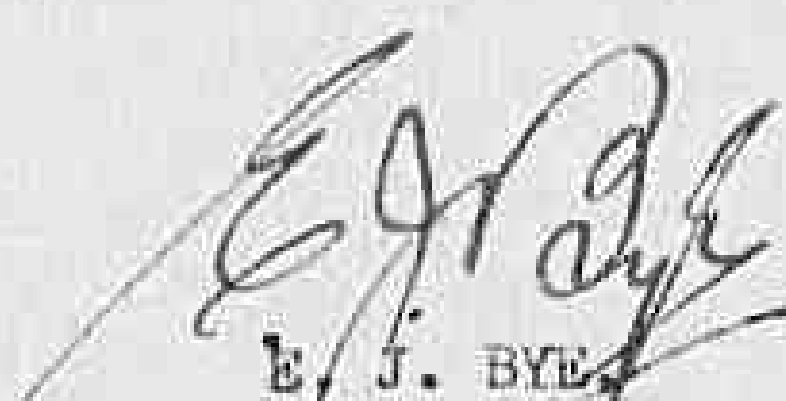

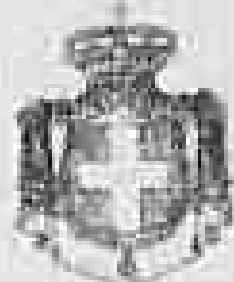

Subject: Pistoia Questura.

To: A.C. Public Safety Sub-Commission - Rome.

In January, 1945, in order to provide for the re-organisation of the Pistoia Questura, the Vice Questore Comm. La Rosa, a very expert and capable official, was sent to that Chief-Town. This Official devoted his full energy in order to comply with the difficult task.

He noticed that the conditions of the Questura were rather serious and critical. The causes of which were due: to the destructions and pillages carried out by the Germans and by the local delinquency, to the unavoidable morale and material conditions, in which was especially the personnel of the P.S. Agents as a result of the well-known events of 8th September and to the chaotic political situation, which has subsequently arisen.

Many of those inconveniences are still lasting and have already brought about some regrettable incident, as that complained, to the damage of the Questore Dr. Piccarda and the actually acting Vice Questore La Rosa, who, in a demonstration organised by disturbers of the spot, would-be partisans, who broke into the Offices of the Questura, have been obliged to suffer abuses, without the agents on duty making any effort of protecting their superiors.

A great number of agents are natives of the place and therefore tied by numerous economic and family interests, little reliance can therefore be placed in them. The few agents, who are not of the place, are in the same situation, as they are living there for many years and have therefore many friends.

Besides which in consequence of the German Military occupation of the provinces of northern Italy, many agents (natives of the Pistoia Province) roughly 90) left the units and presented themselves at the a/m Questura where they have been employed. These men are almost all disarmed and in rather critical morale and economical conditions, as they possess nothing else but their personal clothing. In such conditions their employment, especially in the delicate services, is inopportune and frequently impossible.

Other agents called back to duty, due to their age or because they are of the place, cannot carry out their services with the necessary independence and equity.

Some young auxiliary agents, always of the place and in addition to this members of local political parties, show themselves incapable, and faithful to their parties and ~~as~~ therefore enjoy neither the confidence of the Office nor that of the population.

What makes the situation still worse is the lack of barracks, reason for which the agents are obliged to live in private homes and cannot be sufficiently watched by their superiors, thus making frequently friends, the reputation of whom damages the prestige and that of the Office.

Many agents live in far away fractions as a result of the deficiency of lodgings in the town and must consequently cover, by night and by day, long distances, from the Questura to the localities where they live, a fact which gives rise to discontent and discomfort.

Finally the lack of a mess constitutes a noticeable expense for the single agents, who are obliged to take their meals in restaurants or boarding houses. Measures are being taken for the establishment of at least one small barracks, with annexed mess, but almost insurmountable difficulties are met for the supply of the necessary barracks material.

In view of the above considerations, it is obvious, that until the a/m inconveniences will not be removed, the Questura and its services could hardly function in at least a satisfactory manner.

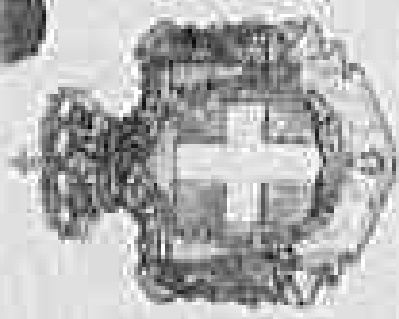
Therefore I have come to the decision gradually to change the whole personnel actually on duty at the Pistoia Questura and the Sub-Commission's intervention is requested, both for the ^{to the Questura} authorization of the transfers under discussion and the supply of the necessary means for the transport of the agents to other offices.

Besides which I would appreciate the Sub-Commission's intervention with the Authorities of the Military Police of the Pistoia Province, to the effect that they assist the Prefect and the Questore in order to be able to make arrangements for an adequate armament and billeting of the Agents of that unit.

Subject : Re-organisation of the Police in the Pistoia Prov.
To : H.E. the Prefect of Pistoia.

In view of the responsibilities which lay on this R. Questura, it is my duty to report to your Excellency, as I have already done verbally, on the situation and especially on the state of mind of the personnel of the R. Questura and this for the repercussions which this undoubtedly produces on the various Police services.

On the whole, the personnel seems to have troubles, which distract them from their services and explain their reluctance to carry out certain services.

The causes of such a state of mind have been repeatedly reported to Your Excellency, but I feel it my duty to repeat them, as I have done personally to the Police General HQ.

1. The agents, for the greater part, are still disarmed, in spite of the fact that the Ministry has been informed by writing and verbally by your Excellency. In the exciting conditions of political ideas, in which the tendency to violence is easily to be noted, the fright of those, who safeguard order and security of persons and goods, is comprehensible. An Agents Corps, although numerous, if not conveniently armed, is a useless Corps.

2. The backwardness and the tendency to avoid certain services is to be explained with the disastrous economical conditions of all agents. Many are full of debts, as since months they did not receive their salaries and this up to the day of the re-organisation of the Corps in this Province, because leaving their respective Questure they took shelter with their relations in the Pistoia Province.

3) Many of them do not reside in this Chief-Town, where never existed barracks, in spite of many attempts made by me before; it is not possible to let them take residence here for two almost insurmountable difficulties: the deficiency of homes, especially after the destruction of many buildings due to air-shelling and damages and the impossibility to meet the rents, if it is thought, that for a room, if available, 500 and more lire are requested, whilst an agent receives less than 1000 lire monthly. The residence of many agents out of the Chief-Town has as consequence disorganisation, indiscipline, waste of energy, frequent diseases followed by repose, absence of esprit de Corps etc.

4) The low salaries in relation to the cost of living and the undervaluation of the money influence badly on the esprit of the agents, who openly complain above conditions and frequently are inclined to leave the service for a more profitable activity.

Another reason for the enfeeblement of the sentiment of duty is the fact, that many agents, disbanded after the known war events, are natives of the city and

- Province of Pistoia, where they have personal, family and above all political ties, which limit and obstruct their Police activity.

The other Agents, who are not of the Province and who have performed duties in this R. Questura in these last years, have troubles of another kind, thus, although having always performed the proper duties, they meet open hostility in the environment, which influences them in the performance of their duties, after the liberation.

It clearly appears from what above stated, that in order to return prestige and authority to the Questura, serenity and esprit of sacrifice to the agents, it would be unavoidably necessary to almost completely renew the Force.

I am of the opinion that these agents sent to another seat, where they have any ties whatsoever, armed and duly paid, would be able to perform their duties and would give better profit.

As far as the rest of the personnel is concerned, there are to be pointed out many troubles in connection with the economical situation, on the whole, and especially ~~and~~ the impossibility to meet the domestic and personal needs always increasing with striking rapidity.

It is obvious, that the question, especially from the psychologic point of view of my staff, is quite complexe and could not be solved in a short time, but I feel it my duty to point it out to Your Excellency, both for the taking in consideration of the contribution which my offices could give at present and for the assistance which Your Exc. would and could give for the solution of above question.

Gli altri agenti che non sono della provincia e che hanno prestato servizio in questa R. Questura, in questi ultimi anni hanno preoccupazioni di altro genere, perchè, pure avendo sempre fatto il proprio dovere, trovano nell'ambiente latenti ed aperte ostilità che non li lasciano tranquilli nel

loro servizio, dopo la liberazione.

Da quanto sopra ho riferito emerge chiaramente per dare prestigio ed autorità alla Questura, serietà e spirito di sacrificio agli agenti, da cui si possa attendere proficui risultati in ogni ramo di servizio, è imprescindibile necessità rinnofo l'ambiente quasi radicalmente.

Sono convinto che questi agenti portati in altre sedi ove non abbiano legami di alcun genere, armati e pagati adeguatamente, sapranno compiere il loro dovere di buoni agenti, da cui si potrà pretendere un migliore rendimento.

Per quanto riguarda il resto del personale vanno rilevate anche molte preoccupazioni inerenti alla situazione economica in generale e in specie alle impossibilità di far fronte ai bisogni domestici e personali sempre crescenti con vertiginosità impressionante.

E' ovvio che il problema, specie dal punto di vista psicologico del mio personale, è assai complesso e non potrà essere risolto in breve tempo, me ho sentito il dovere di prospetterlo a V.E., sia perchè voglia tenerne conto nell'apporto che i miei uffici possano dare in questo momento, sia per quell'ausilio che V.E. voglia e possa dare per l'evviamento di detto problema ad una possibile e pratica risoluzione.

3. It is deemed prudent at this stage to ask for the immediate appointment of a younger and energetic man.
4. The lack of action by Piccareto has infected the agents and it is hoped that a new man will be able to weed out the bad element in the Agenti.
5. The attached translation of a report by the CC.RR. Group Commander, Col. Bottacci, is forwarded as an indication of the shortcomings of the Questore on whom it is believed the Prefect has, or will, submit an adverse report direct to Rome.

The opposition against the local Questore, Comm. Francesco Piccareta, on the part of several fastidious elements and of parties of the "left" wing, all of which has previously been communicated and also informed through personal memorandum, has been climaxed in an action of intimidation on the part of a group of partisans. Three members of the group ~~were~~ visited Comm. Piccareta at his office on the afternoon of 12 December and let him know it was the wish of the ex-partisans that he leave office the soonest possible as he had had too much to do with the ex-Fascist party.

A decision followed, that, as said by the aforesaid functionary, it would have been contended with if the request had been made in more measured and respectful terms, but since it was so demanding Comm. Piccareta referred the matter to the Prefect identifying two of them, PROBBI Attilio, florist, and Doc. DE LUCA Oreste, dismissed P.S. commissioner of Pistoia, both of the actionist party, and asked the Prefect to receive them so as to clear things up with them present.

The Prefect naturally refused to receive the three partisans and immediately informed the Provincial Commissioner, Major Mc Bratney, of the occurrence, and taking this opportunity of weakness shown on the part of Comm. Piccareta, he proposed to have him removed from office as soon as possible.

Although the P.C. was in total accord with the Prefect, he added that it would not be proper to release Comm. Piccareta in the time of one day to the other.

In the mean time the Prefect will make a similar proposal to the Minister of the Interior and will make a report through Commissioner De Luca.

Through investigations made by the Army because of the occurrence, it was found that the O.L.N. was not ignorant of the action carried out by the three ex-partisans, and ~~it~~ specifically that it is the great honor of the Questore to have been distinguished some time ago by the once-upon-a-time head of the Government, Benito Mussolini, for work in repressing anti-Fascist activities.

The delicate situation created in regard to the Questore's personality, has caused discredit to the Questura itself, and it makes it impracticable and unreliable for the Questura to give any assistance in helping to keep order and doing P.S. work in the city, and also it is of no service to the competent Allied authorities which depend upon the Questura for aid.

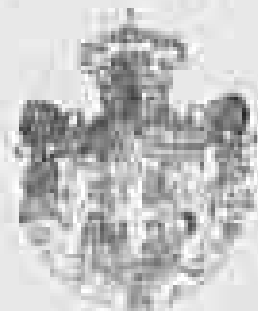
