Known to have been a part in spreading propaganda during the German occupation against the Allies, feelings and tendencies are toward the Nazi and Fascist, is anti-allied.
- 3) - TADDEI RIVIO di Ferdinando, V.Brig. of P.S. A Fascist since 1922, was a member of the P.F.R. since Nov. 1943, was Antemarcia, and is believed to have been Marcia su Roma. Received his promotion to V.Brig. because of excellent service with the Fascist Republican Govt.
- 4) - ZANZANI CLAUDIO di Licurgo, Guardia. This man is an eighteen year old boy with very little experience as an Agent of P.S. He was used as a secret informer to the Fascist Republican Questore, VOLTARELLI.

There is another Non-commissioned Officer, Villarosa Enrico, Maresciallo who was O.V.P.A. He has already been suspended and a report submitted.

7. For the moment, the personnel needed to fill vacancies are -- A Questore, A Vice Questore and a Capo Gabinetto holding rank of Commissario. Ref. letter from AMG Eighth Army dated 14 Dec and another letter dated 26 Dec 1944 re. the transfer of Officials of the Questura to Forli. These people have not yet arrived.

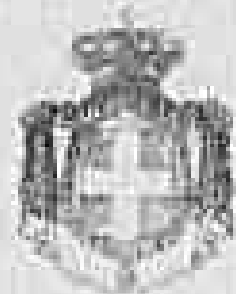

3. - The first three above named officials have been suspended and are ⁴⁶³ longer under house arrest. - Besides being members of C.V.R.A., Verardi and De Nozza are undesirable from resuming their duties, especially in this area, because of their past political activities and tendencies. - It is strongly recommended that these two officials, as well as Santoro, be moved away from this area as soon as possible since one of the new Questura Officials has recently arrived and commenced the work of regaining the Questura.

It is believed that the presence of Verardi, De Nozza and Santoro in Forlì may, because they are dismissed Questura Officials, cause difficulties on the part of the new Officials in their work.

4. - VILLAROSSA is not considered a security threat by my means. He is a weak little man, was not very active C.V.R.A. member. - No bad reports on his past conduct have been received. He has merely been suspended.
