

From trustworthy sources we have been informed that Dr. Monicelli Giorgio who was appointed Questore of Varese, during the clandestine period by the National Liberation Committee, has been dismissed by competent Allied Authority on consideration that he does not possess the necessary efficiency and energy demanded of him. Commissioner Florita Dr. Giorgio replaces him.

This arrangement has not been received well by a/m Committee. Dr. Florita has been obliged, therefore, owing to this awkward position, to hand in his resignation. But in communicate, enclosed herein, published in "Corriere Prealpino" the 4th inst., Allied Authority re-confirmed his appointment & appointment.

We also inform you, that "Questore Gianmuccaro Felice, is appointed to the Varese Office and is expected in Rome within a few days.

Copy We have received orders from the Allied Military Governor to communicate the following: —

To-day Questore Dr. Giorgio Fiorini handed in his resignation to the Allied Military Governor, owing to menacing letters addressed to him notwithstanding, the A. M. Governor re-conferred his appointment, thus avoiding any change in our Questura.


We inform the Varese-citizens that the new Questore of their city was the only one of his rank who for the first abandoned his Office in Sept. 1943. Thus in direct opposition to the Nazi-fascist Republic, and collaborated with all his powers, in spite of danger and personal sacrifice, with the partisans, rendering service to the movement of Liberation.

Finally Mr. Fiorini re-took his post, and started his activity as official in Liberated Italy on the 25th of April 1945.

This represents the new Questore whom the Governor of the Province insisted in keeping in Office.

2. According to your list of nominees, Giannorcaro Felice, Questore of Trapani, is the nominee for this Province but I know nothing of this gentleman or his capabilities. Perhaps your Security Division could supply some informations concerning him.

3. I feel that a really first class man should be sent to take over as Questore. It is obvious that his problems are going to be many and difficult. It would be a great advantage if the selected man was from the North or had northern connections.

4. Would you be so good as to select, screen and send to Varese at the earliest moment possible a strong, reliable and capable official.

The functioning of the local Questura at Varese and Province is the cause of great preoccupations as it has become the true Hqs. of the communist party.

The questore , appointed by the Committee of National Liberation , one Giorgio MONICELLI , is a great communist. To tell the truth he looks to be a distinct and correct person but a little for weakness and a littler in order to be considered a Jacobite by his comrades , he allows that his men commit all sort of abuses.

This has been caused by the fact that the questore has made many promotions and appointment , which are of competence of the Ministry of Interiors , in order to raise some communist elements.

Thus he has promoted vice-commissario the archivist GIOVANNAZZONI whom then he appointed as his particular secretary ; the W.O.s SEARAGLIA and ROTA were also promoted vice-commissarios , the agent DI MARCO was promoted W.O. and the agents PAPALEO , PAPA , MILONE , GIORESTI , STASI , MARULLI & Nardi were promoted brigadieri (sgts.) None of them naturally has the legal requirements for said promotions. In addition we have to point out that they all served in the republican police and the first five mentioned above were proposed for a promotion , months ago , for their recognized zest.

As head of the delicate political office the questore appointed one lawyer LAPORNO , whose provenience is unknown. Furthermore a second political office is still kept functioning. This second, office was created during the insurrection days within the Justice commission of the Committee of National Liberation. When said commission ceased working the political office , under the management of one reg. DURAZZINI , a serious and equilibrated person , should have ceased too.

On the contrary the Questore not only conserved a duplication of the political office , but appointed as head , permitting him to therank of commissario , one BARLOTTI Riccardo , a wine dealer , an ignorant , rough , violent and cruel person who is a true communist believer.

By this irregular conditions following grave inconveniences were caused :

1. While non-political or non-extremist partisan corps are being dissolved and disarmament is proceeding as to higher orders , the social-communist ones continue to run around armed , making arrests , searches and violences.
2. Allied order prohibiting arrests without previous appro-

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By this irregular conditions following grave inconveniences were caused :

1. While non-political or non-extremist partisan corps are being dissolved and disarmament is proceeding as to higher orders , the social-communist ones continue to run around armed , making arrests , searches and violences .
2. Allied order prohibiting arrests without previous approval are being eluded because the police agents have orders to proceed to ~~to stop~~ people only while the consequences are the same .
3. Hundreds of people are kept in the improvised jails or concentration camps and nobody knows by whom or why said arrest were made .
4. A few days ago 6 prisoners were suddenly taken from the prisons at Mornago and were killed after the murderers had compelled the victims to dig their own graves . It has been impossible to learn the names of the victims and of those who did the serious crime .
5. At Travedona one Costantini got 2 men killed who , it is said , were once his partners in a theft . Among the Costantini's victims there should be one Castelli whom he first tortured with his dagger .
6. At Castronno a partisan group has formed , on his own , a prison in a building of the Idrofilla plants .
7. recrudescence of serious crimes by armed gangs against

the private property (yarns and cloths for about 20 million stolen from the firm DE ANGELI FRUA = five million of various goods stolen fr^eLta. etc.)

8. Carabinieri are kept by the questura in a position of secondary importance , so they are being deprived of authority.

9. Enrolment in the public safety ranks is reserved to the communists , while partisans coming from other unit with other political ideals are not accepted.

The prefect and the Committee of National Liberation , though deploreding the situation , are not trying to put it to an end, so that the citizens are invoking the Allied to take severe steps because they are fearing a communist dictatorship which is proving to be able to use such means to make regret the loss of the fascist dictatorship.

The most urgent matter is to appoint a new questore at Varese , a career official , fully backed by the A.M.G. in order that he might be able to eliminate those communist elements who are at present considering themselves as the masters of the province and the police and carabinieri could grant again , to the citizens , an objective application of the laws.

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
