SUBJECT : Questore - Vicenza

1. Several weeks ago the name of Dr. Ettore nominated for the position of Questore of Vicenza was submitted to AMI Vicenza for approval. At this time it was recommended that Mass Dr. Ettore not be appointed Questore of Vicenza because of his service with Fascist Republican Public Security Police in Venice from Sept. 45 until May 1945 and the fact that he had joined the Fascist Republican Party voluntarily.
2. This information was returned to S.C.E.C. Zone. Despite these recommendations of AMI Vicenza and R.P.S.C. Region XII the Italian Government nominated Mass Dr. Ettore for the position of Questore of Vicenza.
3. On January 11, 1946 at 1700 hrs over 2000 citizens representing all professions gathered in front of the Prefettura to demonstrate against the appointment of Mass Dr. Ettore as Questore of Vicenza. Attached is a copy of the newspaper article regarding the demonstration.
4. It is felt that the appointment of Mass Dr. Ettore as Questore is contrary to the wishes of the people of Vicenza and in the interests of public order it is better that his appointment be rescinded.
5. Mass Dr. Ettore has not yet arrived from Rome to take over the position of Questore.

2. In reference to the Ministry of Interior's proposal to nominate Questore 1st Class MAZZA ORESTE to the position of Questore of Vicenza the following objection is submitted.
3. The political situation makes it extremely unadvisable that Mazza Oreste be appointed Questore of Vicenza due to his sworn allegiance to the Republican Fascist Government and service in Venice as Questore during the Republican Fascist Administration.
4. Mazza Oreste is known in Vicenza and his appointment would be a most serious mistake in Vicenza Province, where over 10,000 Partisans are being re-habilitated to normal life.

SUBJECT: Biographical notes of the 1st class Questore Mazza dr. Oreste.

The first class Questore Mazza dr. Oreste, born 9/6/1883 married with no children, entered into the Public Safety Administration on 13/4/1912.

During the first years of his career was sent on mission abroad; has directed the P.S. Office at the House of S.A.R. the Prince of Piedmont, remaining there until Sept. 8/1943. At which date, while staying in the Capital, remained in service by order of the 1st aide-de camp of a/m Prince.

Ordered often to be transferred to the north by the so-called "governo rebubblicano", after refusing to comply with the order, on Dec. 18/1943 threatened with retaliations for himself and his kin, had to leave Rome for Venice.

Although sworn allegiance to the republic, his behaviour was clearly antifascist and antineazist during his stay in Venice with serious peril of his own personal safety.

Submitted to purging trial, the High Commissary for sanctions against fascism has communicated to have archived his file.

Official, serious, gentlemanly, cultivated and capable, classified always in a flattering manner and a very reliable man.

2. A further letter has now been received from AME Venezia Region, which shows that Questore SAVAGNO, Comm. Antonio, has now expressed his willingness to take up the appointment to the Questore at Vicenza. He did not refuse as shown in our letter quoted above, the misunderstanding arising in view of the fact that when first approached he hoped to be assigned to Padova or Venezia and wished to wait before giving a decision to go to Vicenza.
3. It is felt however, by that in view of his serving during the Republican Fascist Regime, any appointment in Venezia Region would be unpopular at the present time in AME territory.
4. It would be appreciated therefore if as asked for, a substitute could be nominated as early as possible to take over the direction of the Questura at Vicenza.

1. Reference your telephone message of 30th October, ZAVAGNO Antonio has been seen regarding his proposed appointment at Vicenza and his reply is attached hereto.

2. ZAVAGNO was the Questore in Belluno for many years and his reputation in this district is not good. He was not known as a politically active Fascist but he served the Fascist regime and he served the Germans when they were in occupation. He is completely without character and he told the C.I.F. at the time of his arrest that he would serve the Allies as he had served his former masters.

3. He was charged before the Ex.Court of Assize with assisting the enemy but the case was dismissed. He is alleged to have assisted them in the sense of implicitly obeying all their orders.

4. He does not appear to be the type of man to be a Questore anywhere in this Region.

SUBJECT: ZAVAGNO doct. Antonio, born at Treviso in 1881, - in service since 1909. Married without children. Very efficient.

He was firstly in force at Padua for many years, in 1917 was assigned to Royal Security Headquarters, where he stood till 1918, when he got transferred to Mantova. Later on, he was in force at Venice, Como, Padua, Aosta, Varese and Belluno. He directed the local questurs in this last Town, after his promotion to Questore in December 1940.

After the 8th Sept. 1943, he went on holding his position, but did not join the Fascist Republican Government.

Following the liberation of Northern Italy, the Provincial Commissione per l'Epurazione did not take any provisions against him, because of the fact that he had not collaborated in any way with the enemies.

He is a very efficient official, and always displays in his job seriousness, tact and firmness.

He is actually at disposal of the Ministry.

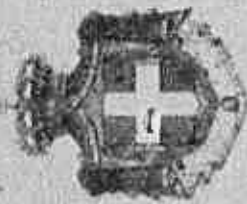
