I. GENERAL.

1. Authority. This report is based on AFHQ instructions AG 091.711 G(SI)-0 dated 2 Nov 45 entitled "Handover of the ITALIAN Army to the ITALIAN Government". It is intended for information and record purposes only. Future reports will be issued as and when the situation demands.

II. HANDOVER.

2. ITALIAN Army. In accordance with the above instructions, responsibility for the organization, training and administration of the ITALIAN Interim Army, including the OMA, was handed over to the ITALIAN Government at 2400 hrs on 14 Nov 45 (vide MILA Directive No 1 of 8 Nov 45). Operational command of troops stationed in territory not handed back to the ITALIAN Government (which included the five combat Divisions and of 826 C.S. Bn), remained in the hands of Allied Force Headquarters. The Order of Battle on that date is shown in ITALIAN Army Strength State No 3/45.

3. Military Mission.

- (a) The Land Forces Sub Commission of the Allied Commission (MIL), together with the five British Liaison Units formally attached to the five combat divisions, were from the same date reorganized or regrouped as outlined in new War Establishment to provide:

(i) The Headquarters of an Allied Military Mission within the Land Forces Sub Commission, A.C.

(ii) A British Liaison Unit (either Type A or B) with each of the eleven ITALIAN Territorial Commands.

- (b) The duties of the sub Commission and of the Military Mission as laid down in AFHQ Directive AG 091.711 G(SI)-0 dated 3 Dec 45 have been made known to officers concerned and relevant information from this Directive has been passed in appropriate form to the ITALIAN Ministry of War, vide MILA Directive No 2 of 7 Dec 45.

5. As a result of further detailed examination of requirements, permission was requested in MIA C/3/4 dated 1 Dec 45 to decrease (a) (ii) above by 2,500 and to increase (e) by the same figures, leaving the grand total of 205,000 unaltered.

6. Detailed requirements (within framework)

Discussion is in progress with the Ministry of War on the whole range of the reorganization project, including, inter alia :-

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8. CC.RR.

The responsibility for organization and try of CC.RR passed to MIA on 1 Nov 45 (AFHQ AG 014.12 082-0 dated 14 Oct 45 refers).

A CC.RR Sec of 12 Officers will be added to the WE of MIA.

Pending the arrival of these Officers, certain exploratory discussions have taken place between this HQ on the one hand and the Ministry of War and GHQ CC.RR on the other.

Rough Staff Tables have been prepared based entirely on existing Italian figures and WEs.

It is apparent that very considerable reorganization is necessary.

9. Equipment Tables.

Provisional equipment tables for the Interim Italian Army incl CC.RR were submitted to AFHQ with MIA letter SD/109 of 6 Dec 45. These were based on such agreement as has so far been reached with Ministry of War, and are liable to modification when firm decisions have been given on the WEs concerned and the source and types of equipment to be provided.

10. The Ministry of War.

It is apparent that the organization of the War Ministry and SMTE is cumbersome and not entirely suitable to the needs of the future Italian Army.

It would not be advisable to effect any major reorganization immediately, while the Army itself is in a state of flux, but certain essential readjustments are being recommended with a view to preparing the way for a complete overhaul at the proper time.

Up to date the only reorganization recommended is the formation of a Training Directorate; the separation, within the GENIO branch, of Engineers and Signals for all operational purposes; and the removal from the Artillery branch of all the RHE and Tpt functions which the Artillery now combines, a separate Directorate to be formed to deal with these functions.

It is not considered opportune to hurry the bigger reorganization of the Ministry of War and SMTE until the formations, units and Training Establishments of the Army have themselves been reorganized and given time to settle down. This inversion of the normal process of reorganization is unavoidable in present circumstances.

On the other hand, the reorganization of the Ministry of War and SMTE presents a considerable problem, requiring much exploration and study. It is proposed to commence a full examination now with the War Ministry officials, so that an agreed out and dried plan can be evolved in detail for implementation when the time is ripe. The eventual outcome will require Italian legislative sanction.

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IV. TRAINING.

11. Territorial Training Centres.

- (a) A WT has been produced by the Ministry of War which will raise the figure for the Military Staff to take advantage of the additional 2,500 granted from the IS Best ceiling. This is now being implemented.
- (b) The training of instructors proceeds entirely according to plan and will probably produce a surplus which could be posted to weak units (Independent Bns etc) to raise the standard there.
- (c) Programmes are being worked out. British I.T.C. programmes are being forwarded from UK for comparison.

(a) Opening of T.T.Os in February is dependent solely on provision of accn and of British Ltrs and Documents (see paras 20 and 23).

(a) Lists of basic training requirements for filled courses have been prepared and sent to CMC as Staff Tables.

(b) Ministry of War states that no great difficulties need be anticipated with regard to stores from ITALIAN sources.

14. Military Academy.

Ministry of War want to re-establish this Academy at LONDON. The suitability of this arrangement is questioned as it is far from other centres near ROE, with consequent loss of facilities for inspections and demonstrations. Ministry of War may agree to STERNO, but even this is a bit distant. The present course at LONDON

14. Military Academy.

Ministry of War want to re-establish this Academy at ROMA. The suitability of this arrangement is questioned as it is far from other centres near ROSE, with consequent loss of facilities for inspections and demonstrations. Ministry of War may agree to SPONSOR, but even this is a bit distant. The present course at LEGGE continues.

V. ADMINISTRATION

15. Manpower.

Up to the present date the 1919 and 1920 classes have been demobilized. The ITALIAN authorities are anxious to demobilize the 1921, 22 and 23 classes as soon as possible, and but for our advice in the matter would probably do so allowing the strength of the Army to fall to some 10,000. Further demobilization will not, however, take place until after the next call-up.

The annual intake system will be based on a four monthly call-up of 40,000; the first will take place in the middle of February 1945 and will be composed of the men of the 1925 class the 2nd and 3rd four months of the 1926 class, from those parts of ITALY not yet called up (i.e. all except SPEDERA, LUCLIA and IUGLIA who are now serving).

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There are no registers in existence for the 1925, 1927 and 1928 classes, but these are being prepared and will be ready by the end of 1945.

16. Conditions of Service

The Italians are of the opinion that out of the Army of 140,000, at least 50,000 must be long service permanent cadre, they would like to have up to 50% on a long service basis and 50% on a one year's conscript basis. At present only about 20% are permanent cadre.

It is unlikely that they will find sufficient volunteers for long service under existing conditions of service. Various suggestions have been put to the Ministry of War for improving conditions of service, covering both the period of actual service and the facilities that can be given to a man on discharge from the Army. The whole question is now under consideration by the Ministry of War, who are making a detailed study of the minimum number of personnel (Leaders, Instructors, Specialists etc) required to form the long service permanent cadre. The eventual proposals will of course be subject to Italian Treasury approval and therefore the amount of increased cost of a Regular over a conscript is being examined also.

17. Morale

The recent demobilisation of the 1919 and 1920 classes has had a favourable effect on morale. The Italian Press generally speaking ignores its Army and even tends to lower morale by working on the public and making them hostile to the Army. This is countered to some extent by the Radio and by articles in a weekly paper sponsored by the Italian Government.

In all Italian Morale Reports, pay and allowances figure largely, and an examination of some of the pay anomalies makes the fact that the Italian Army has got some morale all the more surprising. A sweeper of the Commune of GENOVA gets Lire 6,297 a month, a manual labourer over 18 years of age Lire 6,000, a 2/Lt married without children Lire 5,984 and a Regular Army Colonel Lire 9,383. The importance of this aspect has been stressed to the Ministry of War. The matter is under active consideration.

18. Personal Services

The Italian Army Penal System has been revised and reformed under our guidance and Military Detention Barracks, a Military "Correction" Company and three Military Gaoles have now been set up

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The Administration of Justice in the Italian Army has up to the present been almost non-existent. There are in round figures 175,000 military offenders awaiting trial. A solution to this problem is being sought in three ways. The strength of Military Tribunals has been increased. Our recommendations for the setting up of Courts Martial are likely to come into effect shortly. The term of an Act of Grace (Amnesty) have been drawn up which will apply both to those awaiting trial and some of those convicted.

19. Officers

Methods by which the standard of Officer in the Italian Army can be improved have been the subject of much correspondence and many conferences between MIL and the Ministry of War.

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It has been pointed out to the Ministry of War that it is essential that useless and inefficient officers be compulsorily retired, and some form of accelerated promotion introduced. Both steps require the passing of a legislative decree.

The decree covering compulsory retirement has been drawn up and submitted to the Council of Ministers. The terms under which it is proposed to retire Officers are so generous however that the decree is meeting with opposition from the Treasury Minister.

The decree covering accelerated promotion has not yet been drawn up, and the Ministry of War are opposed to drawing it up until evacuation is completed.

20. Accommodation.

The limiting factor in regard to the organization and training of the Interim Army is likely to be the provision of suitable buildings for Barracks, Training Centres and Schools. This is due to :-

- (a) Continued occupation by Allied Troops.
- (b) Improper occupation by Allied Civil Authorities.
- (c) Bomb damage.

AMHQ are aware of this difficulty which was represented at a Conference at CASERTA on 11 Dec 45. A decision reconciling the AMHQ Training and Administrative points of view is awaited.

- (b) The control of the issue of vehicles and of No. 1 Special Transport Coy is now in the hands of SURE but it is found necessary to keep close touch with their agencies in this matter and our advice is much appreciated.

(c) Bids for F.O.I. and methods of distribution will be a War Ministry responsibility from 1 Jan 46. It is anticipated that a certain amount of Allied assistance will be needed for some time especially during the winter as the War Ministry will be living from hand to mouth with no reserves.

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22. Supplies.

(a) Maintenance of US-ITI categories ex US depots commenced w.e.f. 1 Nov 45.

(b) On 10 Nov 45 Food Sub-Commission AC notified that it would be possible to obtain from civil imports or indigenous resources all Interim Army requirements of supplies previously of Allied origin excepting Flour (including Macaroni requirements), P/Meat and Fish and Tinned. It was stated however, that these last named items could be repaid from civil imports in the New Year.

(c) By 23 Nov 45 releases had been made of Flour, P/Meat and Fish ex US AM Depots NAPLES and LEGHORN and ex British Base Supply Depots MESSE, BAII and SICMA to cover Interim Army requirements for month of December 45. Only Tinned was not available.

(d) The Ministry of War has been experiencing considerable difficulty in obtaining release of the items from civil depots as only a portion of December requirements had been delivered by 30 Nov 45. Every effort is being made by WIA through AC and AUG channels to expedite these deliveries.

(e) Maintenance of ER-ITI Service Troops ex British Depots commenced w.e.f. 15 Nov 45.

The provision of clothing for the Interim Army is the responsibility of the War Ministry for stocks already available or being released from C.E.M. and for stocks of cloth now becoming available.

24. Medical.

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exporting from the United States. It was stated however, that these last named items could be repayed from civil imports in the New Year.

(c) By 23 Nov 45 releases had been made of Flour, P/Meat and Fish ex US QJ Depots NAPLES and LECORNO and ex British Base Supply Depots JEWELL, BARI and ANGIJA to cover Interim Army requirements for month of December 45. Only liquor was not available.

(d) The Ministry of War has been experiencing considerable difficulty in obtaining release of the items from civil depots as only a portion of December requirements had been delivered by 30 Nov 45. Every effort is being made by MITA through AG and NIG channels to expedite these deliveries.

(e) Maintenance of EM-III Service Troops ex British Depots commenced w.c.f. 15 Nov 45.

25. Clothing and Equipment.

The provision of Arms and Ammunition is still subject to high level discussion.

The provision of clothing for the Interim Army is the responsibility of the War Ministry for stocks already available or being released from C.B.M. and for stocks of cloth now becoming available.

Clothing and boot making and repairing establishments are being maintained and expanded.

The Carabinieri have been placed on the highest priority for the issue of boots, clothing and blankets, and an improvement has taken place.

26. Medical.

(a) Essential medical stores and supplies for the IMI-IMI Navy, Army and Air Force, which have not been available from Italian indigenous resources, have previously been supplied from British stocks. With the hand over of the Army to the Government, the War Ministry became responsible for provision of these stores from either surplus disposal agencies or the civil import programme.

In this manner, penicillin, which has not been available from British stocks for supply to the Armed Forces will be procured. In the meanwhile, arrangements have been made for the training of three Italian military surgeons in the use of this new drug.

(b) In formation has been received that the German Pharmaceutical Institute and Stores Depot at TRIANO will be turned over to the Italian Government when no longer required by the Allies. It is hoped, ultimately, that the Italian War Ministry will be able to resume production of medical stores in the Istituto Chimico Farmaceutico Militare TRIANO with equipment and stores from TRIANO.

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(c) The Medical Services ceiling for the administration of the Interim Army has been reviewed and agreed with the War Ministry.

During the past month three BR-ITI Evacuation Hospitals not required for the Interim Army have been put up for disbandment.

DIRECTIVE No. 2INSTRUCTIONS TO BRITISH LIAISON UNITS
ATTACHED TO
ITALIAN TERRITORIAL COMMANDSINTRODUCTION

1. It is the wish of the United States and British Governments that an Italian Army, of such a size as can reasonably be maintained by the Italian Government shall be brought, in the shortest possible time, to a high state of efficiency. The task which will be required of the Italian Army is:-

- (a) to maintain the authority of the Italian Government,
- (b) to be available to go to the assistance of the civil authority for the maintenance of law and order,
- (c) to act as a deterrent to foreign aggression across the frontiers of ITALY.

Until the terms of the Peace Treaty are made known, this Italian Army, for the purpose of these instructions, is to be organized, trained and administered in accordance with MMIA Directive No. 1 of 8 Nov 45, entitled "Handover of the Italian Army to the Italian Government".

- 2. (a) The Land Forces Sub-Commission, Allied Commission is the channel of communication between Allied authorities and the Italian War Ministry; it also functions as the Military Mission to the Italian Army (AMIA).
- (b) As MMIA (directly subordinate to AMHQ) its responsibility is confined to matters in connection with the organization, training and administration of the Italian Army within the approved ceiling.
- (c) In other respects, including alterations to the approved ceiling, economic, political and civil affairs, questions connected with demobilization, demilitarization, civil security and ex-army material and personnel (including ex-prisoners of war), its responsibility lies as the Land Forces Sub-Commission, directly subordinate to Allied Commission.

ORGANIZATION OF MMIA

- 3. (a) HQ MMIA is composed of British and US personnel and is organized in accordance with the attached chart (Appx. 'A').

ORGANISATION OF MILIA

3. (a) HQ MILIA is composed of British and US personnel and is organised in accordance with the attached chart (Appx. 'A').

- (b) British Liaison Units (BLUs) are organised in accordance with the approved War Establishments (see Appx. 'B'), as Type 'A' or 'B', one of either type being attached to each Italian Territorial Region HQ depending on the size and responsibility of the region. Type 'A' BLUs, which include officers of services, will, from time to time, be required to assist Type 'B' BLUs in administrative matters for which purpose an affiliation plan will be made by HQ MILIA (see Appx. 'C'). Staff lists and British vehicle returns of BLUs will be sent to MILIA monthly as detailed in Appx 'D'.

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- (c) A special BLU (known as 'P' BLU) is attached to the Training Centre at CEMANO for duty with the training group of units which are controlled directly by the War Ministry.
- (d) All BLUs will come directly under HQ MIA for all matters except such local administrative questions as must necessarily be handled by local administrative headquarters. MS matters will be referred direct to HQ MIA and are handled there by an officer specially appointed for the purpose.
- (e) Disciplinary, financial and administrative powers of a Divisional Commander are vested in Commander MIA. Similarly, powers of a Detachment Commander are vested in Lt-Colonels in charge of 'A' Type BLUs and 'P' BLU. These powers extend over any 'B' Type BLU affiliated to them.

OBJECTS

- 4. (a) The object of MIA is to advise and assist the Italian Ministry of War and subordinate headquarters on the organization, training and administration of the Italian Army within the approved ceiling. Responsibility in this respect are limited to advice and assistance only; all necessary executive work must be the responsibility of the Italian authorities concerned.
- (b) The particular object of BLUs will be to give similar advice and assistance to the Italian HQ to which they are attached. The Italian Commander will normally be expected to accept this advice; if he should feel unable to do so, the OC BLU will refer the matter to HQ MIA. BLUs are therefore in effect miniature missions to their respective Territorial Headquarters, taking their policy and direction from HQ MIA.
- (c) The senior officer of each BLU will make it clear to all personnel under his command that they are to take no part in Italian political activities of any kind. Lack of impartiality may gravely impair Allied - Italian understanding, and will, in any case, render the individual or individuals concerned incapable of carrying out properly the duties entrusted to them.

SCOPES OF BRITISH LIAISON UNITS

5. POLICY

Allied policy on all questions coming within the scope of these instructions will be made known to BLUs by HQ MIA; it will be the duty of BLUs concerned to pass this to Italian Headquarters concerned in appropriate form, supplementing it with such details as are considered requisite. Principal matters with which BLUs will have to deal are classified under the following headings:-

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OBJECTS

4. (a) The object of MIA is to advise and assist the Italian Ministry of War and subordinate headquarters on the organisation, training and administration of the Italian Army within the approved ceiling. Responsibilities in this respect are limited to advice and assistance only; all necessary executive work must be the responsibility of the Italian authorities concerned.
- (b) The particular object of BLUs will be to give similar advice and assistance to the Italian HQ to which they are attached. The Italian Commander will normally be expected to accept this advice; if he should feel unable to do so, the OC BLU will refer the matter to HQ MIA. 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DUTIES OF BRITISH LIAISON UNITS5. POLICY

Allied policy on all questions coming within the scope of these instructions will be made known to BLUs by HQ MIA; it will be the duty of BLUs concerned to pass this to Italian Headquarters concerned in appropriate form, supplementing it with such details as are considered requisite. Principal matters with which BLUs will have to deal are classified under the following headings:-

(a) ORGANISATION

Responsibility of OC BLUs, as regards organisation of HQs, formations and units within the Territorial Command to which they are attached is as follows:-

- (i) As far as possible the Italian Army is being organised and commanded on lines generally similar to those employed in the British Army. This policy is subject to such modification as may be dictated by:

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- the nature of the tasks which the Italian Army are intended to carry out,
- the nature and amount of the equipment which the British and US Governments have undertaken to provide,
- the national characteristics of the Italian military system.

(ii) OSC BLUs will see that all units in their area of responsibility are in fact organized in accordance with the official WE issued by the Italian Ministry of War after agreement with this HQ. They will bring to the notice of the Territorial Command any cases in which official WE are modified or disregarded. They will use their discretion as to whether such modifications are within the spirit of the WE, and they will advise the Territorial Command accordingly. If their advice is not accepted, they will inform this HQ.

(iii) Bearing in mind the characteristics of the Italian Military system, OSC BLUs will at all times offer to the Territorial Command advice on the organization and efficient running of HQs and establishments.

(iv) OSC BLUs will submit to HQ MIL for consideration with the Ministry of War, any recommendations they may have to make on the subject of Staff Duties with particular reference to the smooth and speedy disposal of business by means of decentralising responsibility to junior officers, eliminating redundant links in the chain of command or of supply, logical distribution of Staff Duties, and simple office procedure.

(v) OSC BLUs will render location statements as at Appx. 'D'.

(b) INTELLIGENCE

The responsibilities of OSC BLUs as regards Intelligence are as follows:-

(i) The Italian authorities are required to furnish information regarding the strength, organization, training, movements, administration, real estate, and stocks of material and equipment held by the Italian Army.

(ii) OSC BLUs will collate, for transmission to this HQ when requested, such information of this nature as originates in the Territorial Command to which they are attached.

(iii) In order that this information may be presented in the form best serving both Allied and Italian interests, and may be studied in the proper context of local conditions, the pulse of local

- (iv) OGC BLUs will submit to HQ M&I for consideration with the Ministry of War, any recommendations they may have to make on the subject of Staff Duties with particular reference to the smooth and speedy disposal of business by means of decentralising responsibility to junior officers, eliminating redundant links in the chain of command and of supply, logical distribution of Staff Duties, and simple office procedure.
- (v) OGC BLUs will render location statements as at Appx. 'D'.

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The responsibilities of OGC BLUs as regards Intelligence are as follows:-

- (i) The Italian authorities are required to furnish information regarding the strength, organisation, training, movements, administration, real estate, and stocks of material and equipment held by the Italian Army.
- (ii) OGC BLUs will collate, for transmission to this HQ when requested, such information of this nature as originates in the Territorial Command to which they are attached.
- (iii) In order that this information may be presented in the form best serving both Allied and Italian interests, and may be studied in the proper context of local conditions, OGC BLUs will keep their fingers upon the pulse of local feeling, both civilian and military, and will submit to this HQ a monthly Intelligence Report (see Appx. 'D'). This monthly Intelligence Report will be prepared with the collaboration of the Italian Territorial Command staff, and may be submitted in draft for the views of the Italian Territorial Command.
- (iv) In the Report, OGC BLUs will stress appreciated future trends rather than past events, details of which are only required if of outstanding importance or as factors in their appreciation.

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- (v) Insofar as it concerns military efficiency and relations with the civilian population, BLUs will study the morale of all ranks with whom they come into contact. They will include this as a heading in their monthly Intelligence Report. They will, as far as possible, detail the factors affecting morale and will include the Italian reaction at all levels to those factors.

(c) TRAINING

- (i) The training policy for the Italian Army is being laid down by the Ministry of War, and will be carried out under Allied advice and supervision.
- (ii) In the case of establishments such as the CESANO Training Centre, the Ministry of War deals direct with the establishment concerned.
- (iii) For formations under Territorial Commands the commander is responsible that Ministry of War policy is implemented in the form of Training Directives and exercises arranged and carried out locally and general executive control.
- (iv) Territorial Training Centres will receive the syllabus and programme laid down by the Ministry of War. OAC BLUs will ensure that this programme is followed.
- (v) British arms and equipment at present constitute a large proportion of the armament of the Italian Army. OAC BLUs will ensure generally that British methods and standards are adopted as far as is practicable.
- (vi) OAC BLUs will offer advice and assistance to Italian Commanders on all forms of training and will, after the training methods have been decided, supervise as far as they are able the implementation of them on the ground.
- (vii) OAC BLUs will be prepared to report on current Italian training practice with a view to enabling this HQ adequately to advise the Ministry of War with regard to training policy.

(d) ADMINISTRATION

(i) Personnel

Administration of all personnel forming part of the Italian Army of 140,000, and of the CC RR of 65,000 is the responsibility of the Italian Government. The necessary Administrative Units are being formed within the authorised ceiling. Instructions for intakes and demobilisation are issued by the Ministry of War on the advice of MMIA. The authorised ceiling will not be exceeded nor will the strength of approved units be allowed to fall seriously short of their VE. BLUs will examine Italian Unit Strength Returns from time to time, reporting to MMIA any serious fluctuations.

- (iii) For formations under Territorial Commands the commander is responsible that Ministry of War policy is implemented in the form of Training Directives and exercises arranged and carried out locally and general executive control.
- (iv) Territorial Training Centres will receive the syllabus and programme laid down by the Ministry of War. Csc BLUs will ensure that this programme is followed.
- (v) British arms and equipment at present constitute a large proportion of the armament of the Italian Army. Csc BLUs will ensure generally that British methods and standards are adopted as far as is practicable.
- (vi) Csc BLUs will offer advice and assistance to Italian Commanders on all forms of training and will, after the training methods have been decided, supervise as far as they are able the implementation of them on the ground.
- (vii) Csc BLUs will be prepared to report on current Italian training practice with a view to enabling this HQ adequately to advise the Ministry of War with regard to training policy.

(a) ADMINISTRATION

(i) Personnel

Administration of all personnel forming part of the Interim Army of 140,000, and of the CC RR of 65,000 is the responsibility of the Italian Government. The necessary Administrative Units are being formed within the authorized ceiling. Instructions for intake and demobilisation are issued by the Ministry of War on the advice of MIA. The authorized ceiling will not be exceeded nor will the strength of approved units be allowed to fall seriously short of their PE. BLUs will examine Italian Unit Strength Returns from time to time, reporting to MIA any serious fluctuations in strength or shortage of specialist personnel.

(ii) Personal Services

Terms of service, pay, allowances, promotion, postings, discharge and leave are all matters for decision by the Ministry of War. MIA is being kept informed by the War Ministry of all decrees and changes of procedure in respect of these matters. Such information as becomes available

will be made known from time to time to BLUs who will be responsible for bringing to the notice of Italian HQs concerned, any serious breaches of regulations and for informing HQ MIA if such matters are not reasonably adjusted.

Italian Army personnel will be subject to Italian Military Law which will be administered by Italian officers in accordance with the Italian Code. Any undue delay in the administration of justice will be reported by BLUs to HQ MIA.

A welfare establishment will be included in the establishment of each Territorial Command. Advice of BLUs will be given freely on matters of welfare to Territorial and unit commanders.

(iii) Officers

The selection, appointment, posting, promotion and dismissal of officers are functions of the Italian Ministry of War. Regulations in these matters are being revised by the Ministry of War and will be made known to BLUs as soon as available. Meanwhile, OSC BLUs will watch these matters closely and discuss frankly and openly with Italian Commanders concerned any changes of appointment of senior officers, disciplinary action or preferment which, in their opinion, appear to be on the one hand necessary or on the other detrimental to the interests of the Service, and if necessary, advise them on the Allied view of their proposals. Any difficulties or failure to reach reasonable agreement will be reported by OSC BLUs to HQ MIA for direction.

OSC BLUs will keep in their offices, up-to-date Staff Lists of Italian officers of the rank of Lt-Colonel and above with Territorial HQs, Divisions, Inf Regiments, and Training Centres, and will forward copies of current staff lists to MIA as detailed in App 'D'.

(iv) Advice on Administrative Matters

Should MIA at any time advise the Ministry of War on any important administrative matters, the fact that such advice has been given will be notified to BLUs. Similarly, any unforeseen or extraordinary ruling, interpretation or advice given by a BLU Commander will be made known to HQ MIA.

(v) Accommodation

OSC BLUs will give active advice and assistance to Italian Headquarters on accommodation questions generally and particularly in the matter of the return to the Italian

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(iii) Officers

The selection, appointment, posting, promotion and dismissal of officers are functions of the Italian Ministry of War. Regulations in these matters are being revised by the Ministry of War and will be made known to BLUs as soon as available. Meanwhile, OSC BLUs will watch these matters closely and discuss frankly and openly with Italian Commanders concerned any changes of appointment of senior officers, disciplinary action or preferment which, in their opinion, appear to be on the one hand necessary or on the other detrimental to the interests of the Service, and if necessary, advise them on the Allied view of their proposals. Any difficulties or failure to reach reasonable agreement will be reported by OSC BLUs to HQ MMA for direction.

OSC BLUs will keep in their offices, up-to-date Staff Lists of Italian officers of the rank of Lt-Colonel and above with Territorial HQs, Divisions, Inf Regiments, and Training Centres, and will forward copies of current staff lists to MMA as detailed in App 'D'.

(iv) Advice on Administrative Matters

Should MMA at any time advise the Ministry of War on any important administrative matters, the fact that such advice has been given will be notified to BLUs. Similarly, any unforeseen or extraordinary ruling, interpretation or advice given by a BLU Commander will be made known to HQ MMA.

(v) Accommodation

OSC BLUs will give active advice and assistance to Italian headquarters on accommodation questions generally and particularly in the matter of the return to the Italian Army of War Ministry property occupied by the Allies, in accordance with current Allied instructions (at present AFHQ Administrative Memorandum No. 48 of 2 Nov 45). For this purpose, direct contact will be made with local Allied Headquarters concerned; only in case of difficulty or in cases involving authorities under the Allied Commission will the matter be referred to HQ MMA. The general allocation of accommodation within the Territorial Command is a matter for Territorial Commanders; the advice of BLUs will be valuable in concerning the probability of the Italian needs clashing with those of the Allies.

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(vi) Transport

Vehicles in use by the Italian Army are partly of Allied origin and partly of Italian. BLUs will exercise supervisory control over the use of the former. BLUs will continually impress on Italian authorities the need for good organization and of economy in the use of MT and POL. A Director of Repairs is at Territorial Headquarters and responsible for the supervision of the Repair Unit. Spare parts are obtained from stores controlled by War Ministry. In the case of Allied vehicles, resort will frequently have to be made to cannibalization.

Local tpt needs are provided by the Adm Tpt Coy which should be given first priority in maint, as on it depends the daily housekeeping of the Army.

A Light Wagon has been provided for each Adm Tpt Coy. The Vch Parks for efficient vchs and non-runners awaiting repair are an important link in the system and will require constant attention and supervision. Release of vchs from efficient Vch Parks is controlled by the War Ministry NOT by Terr. HQ.

(vii) Transportation

The Italian Government is now responsible for arranging rail movement of Italian Army troops and stores direct with the Italian State Railways. A directive on methods and priority is being issued by HQ RAIL.

(viii) Supplies

System of supply is as laid down in MILA Directive No. 1. The Italian Army must take its share of the Nation's food resources. Local purchases by the Commissariats Directorate at each Territorial Command will play an important part in the procurement of foodstuffs. The ration scale will probably vary and that in local use will be ascertained by the BLUs for the information of MILA. Advice and assistance on matters of distribution and cookery should be freely given to Territorial Commanders. Further particulars as to the maintenance of BR-III and US-III Service troops are given at Appx. 'E'.

Old BLUs will be responsible through their own or affiliated supply officers for:-

- (a) Technical advice on the receipt, storage and issues of all foodstuffs in Italian depots and Divisions.
- (b) Liaison between Allied (military and/or civilian organizations) Supply Depots for transfer of stocks to the Italian Army (including advice re Rail movement of supplies).

(c) Advice concerning maintenance of stocks within their

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housekeeping of the Army.

A Light Map has been provided for each Admin Coy. The Vch Parks for efficient vch and man-runners emitting repair are an important link in the system and will require constant attention and supervision. Release of vch from efficient Vch Parks is controlled by the War Ministry NOT by Terr. HQ.

(vii) Transportation

The Italian Government is now responsible for arranging rail movement of Italian Army troops and stores direct with the Italian State Railways. A directive on methods and priority is being issued by HQ MLL.

(viii) Supplies

System of supply is as laid down in MLL Directive No. 1. The Italian Army must take its share of the Nation's food resources. Local purchase by the Commissariato Directorato at each Territorial Command will play an important part in the procurement of foodstuffs. The ration scale will probably vary and that in local use will be ascertained by the BLUs for the information of MLL. Advice and assistance on matters of distribution and cooking should be freely given to Territorial Commanders. Further particulars as to the maintenance of ER-III and US-III Service troops are given at Appx. 'E'.

One BLU will be responsible through their own or affiliated supply officers for:-

- (a) Technical advice on the receipt, storage and issue of all foodstuffs in Italian depots and Divisions.
- (b) Liaison between Allied (military and/or civilian organisations) Supply Depots for transfer of stocks to the Italian Army (including advice re Rail movement of supplies).
- (c) Advice concerning maintenance of stocks within their areas.
- (d) Ensuring that any alteration to the ration scale is brought to the attention of all concerned and that alterations are implemented as instructed.
- (e) Supervisory control over all supplies found from Allied military sources.

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(ix) Clothing and Equipment

During the interim period before the National Economy permits a uniform standard of clothing and equipment, it will not be possible to attain homogeneity in all units of the Army. Economy is, therefore, essential. OGC BLUs will be provided with copies of equipment tables issued by the Ministry of War and will advise local authorities and assist them to introduce and maintain a system of unit accounting and individual responsibility for stores, similar to that in the British Army. Further particulars as to the maintenance of BR-IMI and US-IMI Service troops are given at Appx. 'F'.

(x) Veterinary and Remount

The utmost use of animal transport in station duties will be rendered essential by the shortage of petrol. OGC BLUs will advise and assist wherever possible in the reorganization of animal transport.

(xi) Accounting

Transfer of stores from Allied to Italian depots has hitherto been recorded on shipping tickets in accordance with established procedure. Separate instructions will be issued regarding the impending transfer of warlike equipment with the Gruppi, and any other accounting with which BLUs may be concerned.

COMBINIERI

6. The Combinieri (OC BR) within the authorized ceiling of 65,000 are included in the term "Italian Army" and will be the responsibility of MMIL except for operational functions and training in purely civil police duties. Such matters are the responsibility of the Ministry of the Interior and of the Public Safety Sub-Commission of the Allied Commission. OGC BLUs will maintain close touch with OC BR Divisional or Brigade Headquarters concerned.

RELATIONS WITH ALLIED AUTHORITIES

7. (a) As long as any Italian troops are under Allied operational command, at the request of Allied Commanders, OGC BLUs will provide full liaison between the Italian Territorial Command to which BLUs are attached and the Allied HQ concerned.
- (b) OGC BLUs will volunteer to Allied Districts or Areas any information of outstanding importance or urgency on any subjects within their knowledge, even to MMIL.
- (c) (i) OGC BLUs will NOT be expected to provide for Allied Districts and Areas detailed returns or states of Italian troops within their territory.

The utmost use of animal transport in station duties will be rendered essential by the shortage of petrol. OSC BLUs will advise and assist wherever possible in the reorganization of animal transport.

(xi) Accounting

Transfer of stores from Allied to Italian depots has hitherto been recorded on shipping tickets in accordance with established procedure. Separate instructions will be issued regarding the impending transfer of warlike equipment with the Gruppi, and any other accounting with which BLUs may be concerned.

CARABINIERI

6. The Carabinieri (CC RR) within the authorized ceiling of 55,000 are included in the term "Italian Army" and will be the responsibility of MMIL except for operational functions and training in purely civil police duties. Such matters are the responsibility of the Ministry of the Interior and of the Public Safety Sub-Commission of the Allied Commission. OSC BLUs will maintain close touch with CC RR Divisional or Brigade Headquarters concerned.

RELATIONS WITH ALLIED AUTHORITIES

7. (a) As long as any Italian troops are under Allied operational command, at the request of Allied Commanders, OSC BLUs will provide full liaison between the Italian Territorial Command to which BLUs are attached and the Allied HQ concerned.
- (b) OSC BLUs will volunteer to Allied Districts or Areas any information of outstanding importance or urgency on any subjects within their knowledge, copy to MMIL.
- (c) (i) OSC BLUs will NOT be expected to provide for Allied Districts and Areas detailed returns or states of Italian troops within their territory.
- (ii) As long as Italian troops are under operational command of Allied Commanders Italian Territorial Commands must themselves provide, with the assistance of OSC BLUs, such returns or states of all troops, including Inf Divs, within their command, as are required by Allied Commanders.
- (iii) When Allied Commanders cease to have operational command of Italian troops OSC BLUs may continue to keep touch with Allied HQs on all necessary matters of mutual interest to Allied and Italian Commands, but will be required to provide detailed information only to MMIL.

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ALLIED SERVICE TROOPS

8. BR-IT and US-III Service units do NOT form part of the Italian Army at disposal of the Italian Government. Particulars regarding their maintenance, which is an Anglo-American commitment, are given at Appx. 'B'.

INTERCOMMUNICATION9. (a) Correspondence

Written correspondence will be kept to a minimum.

(b) Channels of Communication

Osc BLUs will correspond direct with MMIA on all matters, copies where relevant to interested Allied HQs. On all subjects other than BLU administration and discipline, for which matters 'B' Type BLUs are affiliated to 'A' Type BLUs, Osc 'B' Type BLUs will correspond direct with MMIA on a par with Osc 'A' Type BLUs.

Copies of any necessary direct correspondence with Allied HQs will be sent to MMIA as applicable.

(c) Periodical Returns - see Appx. 'D'(d) Conferences

Conferences will be held at frequent intervals, probably monthly, and alternately in Rome and a suitable rendezvous in North Italy.

(e) Postal and Signal Addresses

Final designation of new BLUs is awaited from the War Office and will be notified as soon as received.

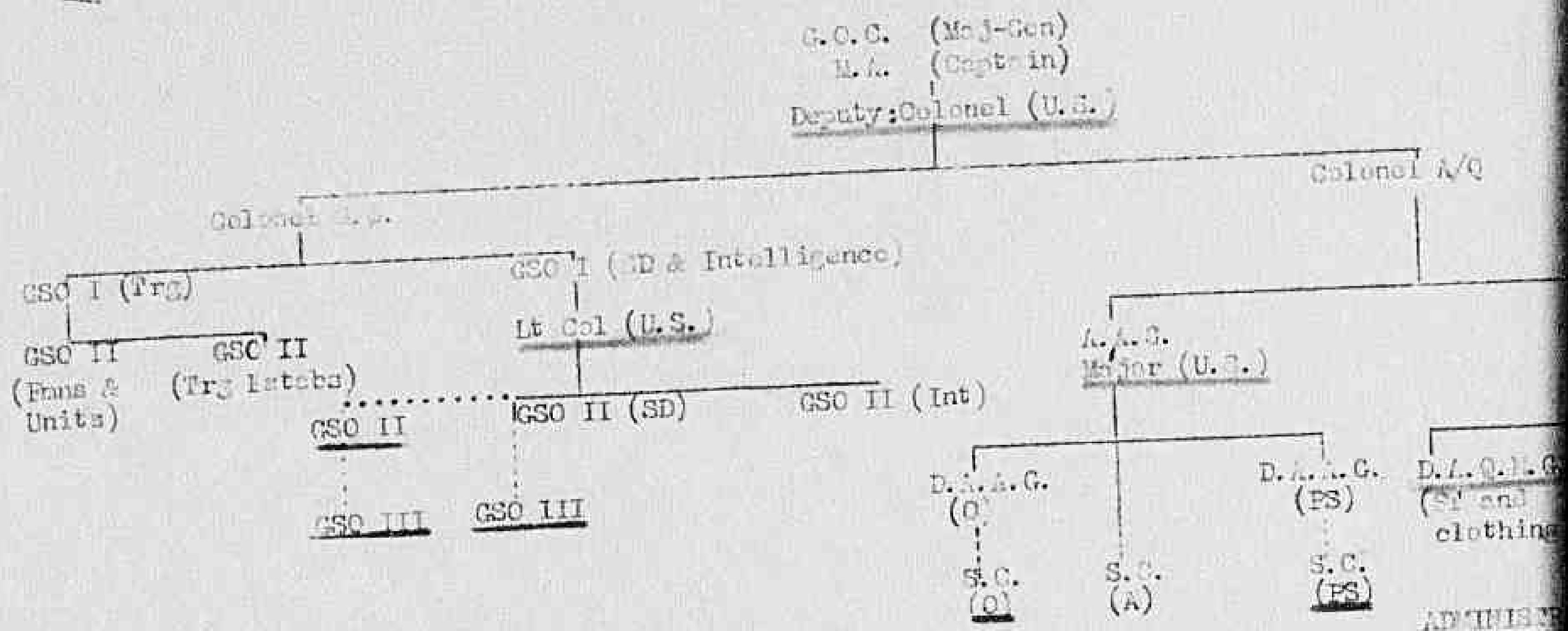

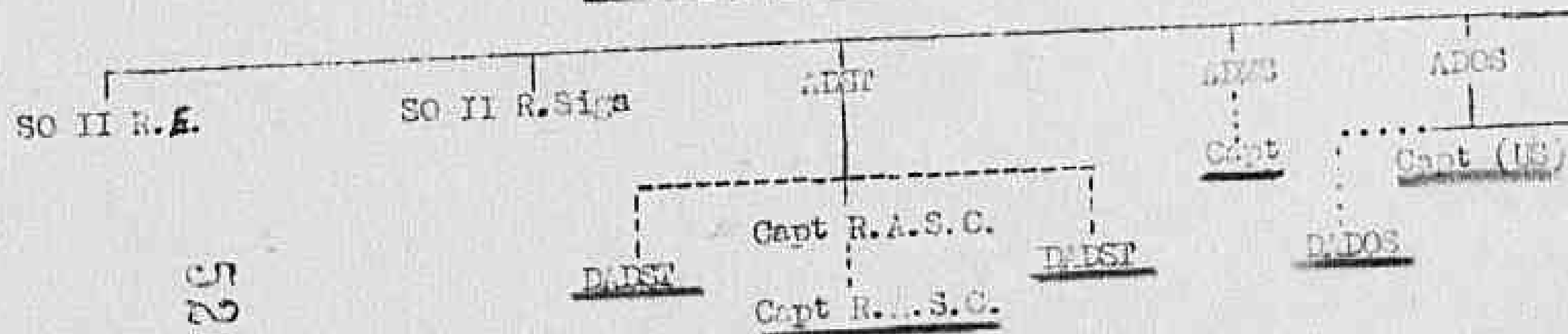
MILITARY MISSION TO THE ISRAELI ARMY

DIRECTIVE No. 1HANDOVER OF THE ITALIAN ARMY TO THE ITALIAN GOVERNMENT

I.

GENERAL

1. Approval has now been given by the Combined Chiefs of Staff to the interim policy to be adopted towards the Italian Armed Forces pending a final settlement by peace treaty. The Supreme Allied Commander therefore directs that the following arrangements be made for the handover of the Italian Army to the control of the Italian Government and for its future organization, training and administration.

II.

HANDOVER OF ITALIAN ARMY TO ITALIAN GOVERNMENT CONTROL.

2. Transfer of Units. With effect from 2400 hours, 14 November 1945, units of the Italian Army that are now in the ITI-ITI category together with the five BR-ITI combat groups and their support units and 10,000 Carabinieri now held in BR-ITI category will be transferred to the control of the Italian Government. Allied commanders will have no powers of command over such units except as stated in paragraph 5, below.

3. Future of US-ITI and BR-ITI Units.

(a) US-ITI and BR-ITI units less the five BR-ITI combat groups referred to above will continue to be employed in accordance with existing arrangements as long as they are needed by the Allied military authorities. Such units will remain under the operational control of Allied Force Headquarters. The numbers employed will gradually be reduced to NIL. It is estimated that in the case of US-ITI personnel, this will be reached in approximately February 1946 and in the case of BR-ITI personnel in approximately June, 1946. When no longer needed by the Allied military authorities, US-ITI and BR-ITI personnel of units will be offered to the Italian Government.

(b) Administration and maintenance of US-ITI and BR-ITI Service units, and the Italian Army and Air Force will be in accordance with paragraph 10, below.

4. Future of the Carabinieri. Control of the Carabinieri will be the responsibility of the Italian Government subject to the supervision and overriding authority of MAC in those areas which remain outside the jurisdiction of the Italian Government. Strength will not exceed 15,000 which will be additional to any ceiling figure agreed for the Italian Army. The Carabinieri will not be responsible

I. GENERAL

1. Approval has now been given by the Combined Chiefs of Staff to the interim policy to be adopted towards the Italian Armed Forces pending a final settlement by peace treaty. The Supreme Allied Commander therefore directs that the following arrangements be made for the handover of the Italian Army to the control of the Italian Government and for its future organization, training and administration.

II. HANDOVER OF ITALIAN ARMY TO ITALIAN GOVERNMENT CONTROL.

2. Transfer of Units. With effect from 2400 hours, 14 November 1945, units of the Italian Army that are now in the ITI-ITI category together with the five BR-ITI combat groups and their support units and 10,000 Carabinieri now held in BR-ITI category will be transferred to the control of the Italian Government. 4. Future of the Carabinieri. Control of the Carabinieri will be the responsibility of the Italian Government subject to the revision and overriding authority of AAG to those or as which remain outside the jurisdiction of the Italian Government. Strength will not exceed 25,000 which will be allocated to any ceiling figure agreed for the Italian Army. The Carabinieri will be used for civilian security purposes only and will not be responsible for military security.

5. Reservations.

(a) The Supreme Allied Commander, Mediterranean Theatre reserves the right to assume command at any time of the whole or any part of the Italian Army located in the theatre, and to delegate his authority to command formations and units of the Italian Army to any Allied commander whom he may direct.

(b) The Italian Government will furnish to the Supreme Allied Commander such information regarding the strength, organization, training, movements, administration, real estate, stocks of material and equipment, and other matters concerning the Italian Army as may be required from time to time.

(c) Italian troops in territory not handed back to the Italian Government, and 808 CS Battalion although included in the ceiling set out in paragraph 7 below, will remain under operational command of Allied Force Headquarters for the time being.

6. Military Mission.

(a) An Allied Military Mission will be provided to advise and assist the Italian Government in the organization, training and administration of the Italian Army and Carabinieri and to obtain and transmit to superior authority such information as is required. The Italian Government will normally accept the advice of this Mission. If it should find itself unable to do so, the matter will be referred to Allied Force Headquarters by the Allied Military Mission. The Mission will also be responsible for screening those demands for supplies and equipment which continue to be met from Allied military sources, and will exercise supervisory control over the use of such materials.

(b) The Allied Military Mission will for the present be the Land Forces Sub-Commission of the Allied Commission (MIL).

III. FUTURE ORGANISATION, TRAINING AND ADMINISTRATION.

7. Organisation. During the interim period until the peace treaty becomes operative the Italian Army under control of the Italian Government will consist of not more than 140,000 personnel and will be organized on the following lines:

(a) Local Reserves.

6. No alteration to the general lay-out shown above will be made by the Italian Government without the consent of Allied Force Headquarters. Detailed requisitions within the above framework will, however, be submitted to the matter of urgency by the Italian Government, as advised by the Italian Forces Headquarters of the Allied Commission (AMIA) and reported to Allied Force Headquarters.

9. Training. The training of the Italian Army will be the responsibility of the Italian Government as advised by the Italian Forces Sub-Commission of the Allied Commission (AMIA).

10. Administration.

(a) With effect from 2400 hours, 14 November 1945, the Italian Government will assume responsibility for the administration of the Italian Army. It is authorized to do so within the authorized ceiling so that the Italian Army is self-administering and no longer dependent on Allied base and lines of communication.

(b) Italian Navy and Italian Air Force personnel will continue to be administered and maintained as at present, through Italian service channels.

(c) BR-IT personnel in diluted British units will continue to be administered and maintained as at present. BR-IT Army Service units will continue to be administered and maintained through Italian service channels, except in respect of the provision of rations. With effect from 2400 hours, 14 November 1945, responsibility for provision and issue of rations will be as follows:

- (1) The British portion of the ration only will be issued to such units through British service channels.
- (2) The Italian portion of the ration will be issued direct to units through Italian administrative channels.

(a) US-IT personnel will be administered through US service channels.

11. Maintenance and Provisioning.

(a) With effect from 2400 hours, 14 November 1945, the Italian Government will assume responsibility for the maintenance of the Italian Army outlined in paragraph 7 above, and of the Carabinieri.

(b) Procurement in respect of food, clothing, medical stores, warlike and non-warlike equipment will be effected from the following sources and in the following priorities subject to any subsequent instructions which may be issued regarding the standardization of equipment of the Italian Army and of the Carabinieri.

(1) From indigenous Italian resources including captured and such local resources as may be available.

(1) S requirements may be loaned from US and British military stocks as a temporary expedient up to 1 January 1946. In addition, certain food may be sold or loaned to the Italian Government in accordance with paragraph 13(c) below.

(2) Thereafter, these items will be returnable to the US and British on demand or they may be transferred to the Italian Government through US and British disposals organizations in accordance with established procedure.

(d) With effect from 2400 hours, 14 November 1945, the Italian Government will continue to be responsible for meeting the POL and coal requirements of the Italian Army and Carabinieri from civil stocks and by means of the Italian Government import programme.

12. Warlike Equipment and Spares. All arms, vehicles and other warlike equipment of US and British origin (including lend-lease) in possession of those units being used to make up the Italian Army of 140,000 and in possession of the Carabinieri as may be surplus to US and British requirements together with up to one years maintenance and spare parts for arms, vehicles and other equipment so provided as may be surplus to US and British requirements will be disposed of to the Italian Government. Appropriate scales of ammunition of various natures will also be transferred and authorized expenditure replenished from Allied sources. In the case of vehicles and warlike equipment available to US and British disposal organizations, disposal to the Italian Government will be effected through the respective US and British disposals organizations in accordance with established procedures, but with priorities requested for its sale to the Italian Government. In the case of lethal British warlike equipment, transfer will be made direct by the military.

13. Food Supply.

(a) Subsistence will continue to be furnished by the US and British Army based on actual strengths of the Italian Army outlined in paragraph 7, above, and of the Carabinieri until 30 November 1945. US responsibility will not exceed 124,000 and British responsibility will not exceed 81,000.

(b) Subsistence for the Italian Army, including the Carabinieri, will be the responsibility of the Italian Government with effect from 1 December 1945. Its sources for provisioning are as set out in paragraph 11, above.

(c) The US and British surplus disposal agencies will be requested to give the Italian Government priority in providing subsistence for the Italian Army from such supplies as may be declared surplus by the US and British military authorities. This priority is limited to items now being furnished in the ITI ration or equivalent British scale and in quantities not in excess of that required for the actual strength and in no event in excess of 205,000, beginning with the date of the request and ending 1 May 1946.

14. Clothing and Individual/Personal Equipment.

(a) All previous directives pertaining to transfer of clothing, individual/personal equipment and salvage to the Italian Army through MLI are rescinded.

(b) Purchase of any surpluses of non-warlike stores is as

those units being used to make up the Italian Army of 140,000 and in possession of the Carabinieri as may be surplus to US and British requirements together with up to one years maintenance and spare parts for arms, vehicles and other equipment so provided as may be surplus to US and British requirements will be disposed of to the Italian Government. (c) The US and British surplus disposal agencies will be requested to give the Italian Government priority in providing subsistence for the Italian Army from such supplies as may be declared surplus by the US and British military authorities. This priority is limited to items now being furnished in the ITI-ITI ration or equivalent British scale and in quantities not in excess of that required for the actual strength and in no event in excess of 205,000, beginning with the date of the request and ending 1 May 1946.

14. Clothing and Individual/Personal Equipment.

(a) All previous directives pertaining to transfer of clothing, individual/personal equipment and salvage to the Italian Army through MMLA are rescinded.

(b) Purchase of any surpluses of non-warlike stores is as authorized in paragraph 11(b)(2) above.

15. Medical Stores. Medical Stores of Allied origin which are held in Italian depots or by Italian units at the date of this letter will remain in Italian possession.

(c) Accounting for and US depots direct to BR-III and US-III units will follow established procedures of the British and US Forces. Issues from US military stocks, other than disposals through AMLO, will be through MILA (US Contingent) who will maintain adequate records.

Reference TWO DISTRICT cable 301/2374 of 20 November and confirming verbal instructions already issued.

Para 1. Relief of Italian Gruppi from guard duties in TWO DISTRICT is being impeded by fact that sufficient accommodation for relieving troops does not exist unless on relief a proportion of Gruppi are moved out of TWO DISTRICT.

Para 2. It is approved policy that Italian Army which we are in process of returning to Italian Govt Control shall be raised to high state of efficiency as rapidly as possible. It will be appreciated that this can not be done as long as it remains largely employed on guard and other static duties not can it be considered as available for internal security duties while so employed. Plans have therefore been made to relieve all Italian troops from guard duties.

Para 3. When returned to Italian Govt Control the five Italian Gruppi will form the Government's Strategic Reserve for Internal Security duties and should therefore be located accordingly.

Para 4. Bearing in mind the areas in which Internal Security operations are possible after the Northern Provinces have been returned to Italian Govt Control it is considered that the Gruppi should be located generally as follows.

- (A) Three Gruppi North of the Apennines.
- (B) Two Gruppi South of the Apennines.

Para 5. You are requested as a matter of urgency to obtain the agreement of the Italian Ministry of War to the general distribution of Gruppi shown in Para 4 above on receipt of which detailed move orders will be issued by this HQ. In the event the Italian Ministry of War does not agree you should forward their reasons and alternative proposals.
