SUBJECT: Civil Prisons Administration.

TO : HQ AMG Fifth Army (Field),
APO 464 U. S. Army.

1. Reference your 203/7 dated 31 May 44.
2. The new Prison Director appointed for the Littorio area is Dott. DENTE Vittorio of MISIDA Prison: Dott. SOMMA, who was originally appointed is about 50 years of age, and it was thought that his health was not equal to the task of forward work under Army conditions. DENTE was SOMMA's deputy at Misida. He is capable, about 30 years of age, and very keen to take on the work. He leaves for 5th Army Area on 6 June 44.
3. Dente is relatively young, and the claims of seniority in the Italian Prison Service must be considered. Accordingly, whilst DENTE has been given a free hand by the Ministry to organise the Prisons in the forward area; he will not be the final choice for the whole of Region 4.
4. The question of Frosinone, Provincial Rome, and the other provinces in Region 4 has been raised with the Director of Prisons. It is hoped that as a result of reports to be received from DENTE, decisions can be made, and further information forwarded to you.
5. The appointment of a Comandante of the Vigili del Fuoco is being dealt with and a copy of the arrangements made will be forwarded to you within a few days.
6. The appointment of Questori is under discussion with the Minister of the Interior.

SUBJECT: Civil Prisons Administration.

TO : Public Safety Sub-Commission,
Rear H.Q., A.C.C.

1. With the advance of the Armies into former enemy held territory, the provision of Civil Public Safety Officials has to be considered so that civil government may operate as soon as it is compatible with the military situation to do so.

2. With your co-operation, a prison director has been found for Littoria Province. It would be appreciated if this H.Q. could be advised whether the new man, Dott. SOMMA, Angelo, from NISIDA Prison, will be responsible for the whole of Region 4, exclusive of Rome City, as, if not, directors will require to be found for Frosinone, Provincial Rome, and the other provinces of Region 4.

3. Likewise, there will require to be appointed Questori and Directors of Vigili Fuoco, the latter not being of such great urgency, but, nevertheless, important.

Could personnel be found by the Italian Government, for these posts?

SUBJECT: Rome City Administration.

TO : Vice President, Administration Section.

Reference your ACC/1/4/1/INT dated 22 May 44.

1. The arrangements which have been made by the Public Safety Sub-Commission regarding those officials who may be found in Rome and who are connected with the Public Safety Services, have been effected directly with the C.A.S. 5th Army.

Working in conjunction with OSI 1(b) HQ A.A.I., intelligence reports on Rome have been examined and lists prepared of the various categories of officials who are believed to be in office. Special attention has been paid to those who should be removed.

This has been done in conjunction with the heads of the various Italian Public Safety Services such as the Commanding General COMR and I have already arranged with HQ A.A.I. that through S.I.M. channels such information as is possessed by the present Italian Ministries will be also available to C.A.S.

2. I have personally discussed this matter with the Minister of the Interior who has very little knowledge of his officials at present in Rome and who has no adequate reserve of officials available for future employment.

4. The information supplied by you is intended for and will be forwarded to SCAG and 5th Army. If this has already been done, please send this ~~to~~ Section Commission a copy.
