She has not been convicted as a Prostitute but enquiries show that she is strongly suspected of practising clandestine prostitution and there would appear to be reasonable grounds to object to the proposed marriage.

1. Posabella, Dora, born at VISONE, (Alessandria) on 11 June 1925, single, lives with her mother and a younger brother, aged 7, in a six-room apartment at 52 Piazza RONDANINI, 4th Floor.
(Her mother has been separated from her husband for the past ten years).

2. Both women have very bad moral characters in the neighbourhood and for the past two years Allied soldiers have constantly frequented their apartment. These visits, particularly at night-time, have caused the other tenants of the building to complain repeatedly to the local Police Station.

3. Questura records show that Posabella, Dora has been arrested twice, namely:-

- (i) On 25 March 1945 at 2000 hours she was picked up by the Morality Squad during a round-up of prostitutes in Via del Tritone. On this occasion she was accompanied by Cpl. John Phillips, U.S. Army.
- (ii) On 15 September 1945 at 2100 hours she was arrested again for insulting behaviour towards a Police Officer. This arrest was carried out by Agents of the S. Eustachio Police Station who had gone to her apartment to investigate one of the a/n complaints. The charge was not pressed, however, and she was released in the morning after a reprimand.
