SUBJECT: External Civilian Communications with Italy.

TO : Headquarters, Allied Control Commission
Headquarters, Allied Military Government
Headquarters, Regional Allied Commissioner (Gardinia)

1. Commercial correspondence will not be permitted between Italy and any country overseas in the early stages.

2. It will be necessary that the following addition be made to the Postal Regulations under "Censorship of Italian Civil Communications in all but Forward Areas", forwarded with our letter, MGS 000.73-2, of 8 November 1943.

"6. The only external facilities permitted will be surface private letters and correspondence. Commercial correspondence and the enclosure of commercial papers in private external correspondence are prohibited."
