Reference paragraph "1" of letter dated 20 March 1944 from Rear Headquarters, Allied Control Commission, to Regional Public Safety Officer, Region III, on 15 December 1943 it was recommended by Chief, Military Government Section, Headquarters Fifth Army, to Commanding General Fifth Army, that Carlo Guggenheim be released from confinement to a mild form of house arrest and that the internment of Renato Guggenheim be continued. This recommendation was approved and action pursuant thereto was taken. This was based on reasons of military security.

1. Reference to letter dated 20 March 1944,
ACC/14065/PS.

2. In reply to para. 2 of the abovementioned,
enquiry has been made with result as under:-
a. Carlo Guggenheim has been released from
internment, but is required to report to C.I.C. once a
week.

b. Renato Guggenheim was removed from the
civil prison at Poggioreale on 21 December 1943 by C.I.C.
for internment at the concentration camp at Padula, where
he is at present.

c. No charges have been preferred against
either, action being taken upon grounds of military
security only. No other offence committed.

British Foreign office have asked for particulars charges
preferred against Renato and Carlo Guggenheim. Also what
decision has been taken by 5 Army on Recommendation of
Chief AMG 5 Army in this case. Request reply earliest."

2. Understand that the present position is as follows:-

- (a) Carlo Guggenheim has been released from internment
- (b) Renato Guggenheim is still in custody.
- (c) The charges have been preferred since they were interned
upon grounds of military security only - no offence
having been committed by them.

SUBJECT: Arrest of Renato and Carlo Guggenheim.

TO : Chief, Public Safety Sub-Commission, HQ ACC.

Renato and Carlo Guggenheim were arrested for internment on security grounds by CIG 5th Army on 15 October 1943. Major Stephen J. Spingarn, Commanding 305th CIG Section made or directed the investigation leading up to their apprehension and internment and is, therefore, in a position to supply details of the information given and evidence acquired. Full details are not available in this Section.

It is known that an independent investigation was made by Captain Julius Byles, pursuant to direction of General Clark, who recommended that Carlo Guggenheim be released from confinement to a form of house arrest under surveillance, and that Renato Guggenheim remain in confinement until the Allied lines are North of the City of Rome, when his case should be reconsidered. This report, with a covering letter by Colonel Hume, Chief of Military Government Section, 5th Army, concurring in the recommendation made by Captain Byles, was forwarded to Lt. Col. Arthur E. Sunderland, Jr., ADC, Headquarters 5th Army, on 15 December 1943. To date no reply has been received.

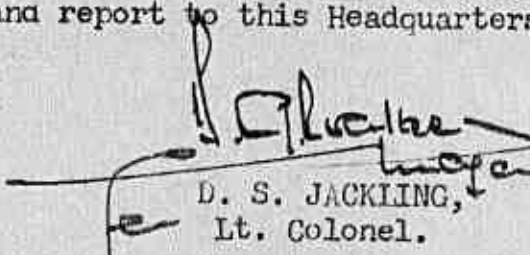

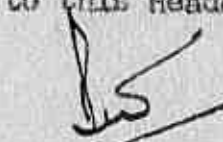
