1. It is desired to maintain as far as possible the good reputation of certain classes of individual in the country. These classes are as follows:-

- (a) Members of the Clergy.
- (b) State Officials, such as Podesta, Sindaco, Commissario Prefettorio, Vice Prefetto, Prefetto and all higher ranks.
- (c) Officers of the Italian Armed Forces.
- (d) All ranks of the Carabinieri Reali.

2. Should it be necessary for security reasons to arrest any individual of the above classes, an F.S.O. or C.I.C. Officer should be present at the arrest and should ensure that it is carried out with discretion, and as little publicity as possible.
