SUBJECT: Broadcasting to Civil Population.

TO : P.W.D.

With reference to telephone conversation with one of your officers and Lt. Col. Martin of the sub-Commission. The following information is forwarded:-

1. Civilian travel in territory under A&C control is restricted as indicated below:-

(a) to a radius of 10 Km. from their homes when situated in "Army" boundaries.

(b) from entry into the province of Foggia unless in possession of a permit issued by the Provincial Commissioner of the Province. (Per. is Provincial Order No. 4.).

(c) from proceeding northwards across the army control line (i.e., a line from the south of the River Fortore in the province of Foggia along the line of the River Basilice to S. Marco and thence through Fragnole to Ponte, thence along the line of the River Salore to its junction with the River Volturano to its mouth) unless in possession of a permit issued by the Civil Affairs Officer of the place which the civilians intend to visit.

2. Illegal possession:-

It is an offence under Section 4C, Article 1 of Proclamation No. 2 for "any person who wrongfully receives or has in his possession property of the Allied Forces or any member thereof."
