SUBJECT : Authority for Travel by Civilians on Freight Trains.

TO : Regional Commissioner I, II, III, IV, V, VI, VII,
AMG Fifth, Eight Armies.

1. Attention has been called to the issue of permits signed by ACC Officers for civilian travel on freight trains. This is directly contrary to instructions issued by Div. Gen. Mil. Rail Services to the Italian State Rlys.
2. All such permits will be immediately cancelled and withdrawn.
3. Under no circumstances whatever will any rail permits be issued without authority from Director, Transportation Sub-Commission, HQ. ACC.
