Control of Civil Movement

AFHQ is responsible for defining the Restricted line (between Restricted Zone and Free Zone) and also, in consultation with H.Q. 15 Army Group, for defining the Rear Army Security Control Line as the future dictates. No change in the existing boundary between the Restricted Zone and Free Zone is at present contemplated, but when such a change is found necessary AG will make recommendations to AFHQ for consideration of the question from a security standpoint.

1. Reference is made to paragraph 1. a of your letter AC/14080/7/PS dated 31st December 1944 in which the Province of Apuania is shown as being administered by this Headquarters. This statement appears to cause some confusion among the branches of the Allied Commission, since applications have on more than one occasion been received from Sub-Commissions for permission for civilians to travel into Apuania. Documents have been received here for onward transmission to the Prefect and other officials of the province.

2. In fact no part whatsoever of the Province is in Allied hands or has ever been so.

3. It is therefore suggested that your letter referred to be amended so as to exclude Apuania from the list of provinces administered by this Headquarters; in this way a repetition of the confusion described in paragraph 1 above may be avoided.
