SUBJECT : Civilian Travel - Rome/Cagliari.

TO : Regional Commissioner, Sardegna Region.

1. Reference HQ/2109 of 14 March 1945.

2. With regard to the checking of civilian air passengers on the Rome-Cagliari line, it is felt that this check can be operated much more efficiently at Elmas.

3. If effected here, there would be two delays, first in the transmission of the information from the airport to this HQ., and second from this HQ. to your HQ., by which time the information might be valueless.

4. Further, the advantage of a check at Elmas is that the Maresciallo CC.RR. at Elmas would be in a position to detain a suspect and communicate direct with Centro C.C. at Cagliari.
