SUBJECT: Travel Restriction

TO : All Concerned

1. Reference is made to Supreme Headquarters, AEF, Administrative Memoranda Number 17, (Third Revision - 21 February 1945) and Number 47, dated 22 February 1945.

2. It is of the greatest importance that the Allied Expeditionary Force should not be burdened with requests for travel into, out of and within its zone of responsibility on behalf of persons whose presence is not essential to the prosecution of the war.

3. All separate national sponsoring authorities are requested, therefore, to carefully screen applications for travel before forwarding.

4. Sponsoring authorities within the Allied Expeditionary Force and all authorizing agencies will take positive and similar action on all applications before requesting clearance or giving approval.

5. The guiding policy will be that clearance should only be requested in the case of military personnel if their travel is operationally necessary, and in the case of civilians if their movements are directly required to further the interests or operations of the Allied Expeditionary Force.

6. The provisions of this instruction apply equally to movement to and from the Continent and into and out of all countries thereon including Germany, both before and after the conclusion of hostilities.
