1. Reference is made to your G-5:300-4, dated 19 May, 1945.

2. It is noted that the American Red Cross is not authorized to issue travel orders and that all requests for orders covering American Red Cross travel should be referred to HQ. MTCUSA, or appropriate base section HQ.

3. It would appear that all American Red Cross Delegates are not aware of the provisions of the MTCUSA circular, AG 230.42/284 P-O, dated 18 November, 1944, and it is suggested that this matter be referred to HQ. MTCUSA with a view to the provisions of the circular referred to being brought to the attention of all concerned.

SUBJECT: Travel of American Red Cross Personnel.

TO : All Concerned.

1. Letter, this headquarters, file AG 230.42/284 A-0, subject as above, dated 1 September 1944, is rescinded.

2. Travel orders for American Red Cross personnel being rotated to the United States will be issued by base section commanders concerned, upon request of American Red Cross officials, as prescribed in cable, this headquarters, reference number FX-79029, dated 4 August 1944.

3. Travel of American Red Cross personnel on other than rotation basis between this theater and the United States and all inter-theater travel will be referred by the Delegate, American Red Cross, to this headquarters. Base section commanders concerned will issue necessary orders upon direction of this headquarters.

4. Upon the request of the Delegate, American Red Cross, or an authorized representative, final action on requests for travel of American Red Cross personnel within the Mediterranean Theater of Operations may be taken by the base section Commanders concerned, without reference to higher headquarters. In cases involving unusual circumstances, requests may be forwarded to this headquarters for final action.

SUBJECT : Control Of Movement, American Red Cross.

TO : AFHQ, G-5 Section.

1. Transmitted herewith for such action you consider appropriate is a copy of a travel order, issued by the American Red Cross, Area No.3, authorising Miriam Bruce, to proceed (from Naples) to Florence.

2. It has been ascertained that travel orders similar to attached are issued by, the American Red Cross, to American Red Cross personnel in connection with:

- (a) Change of station.
- (b) Business trips.
- (c) Annual leave.

These orders are issued to persons other than American Citizens, and may be issued without reference to any military authority.

3. The American Red Cross only apply for military travel orders when transport by air is required, or in special cases if the person travelling was recruited in this theatre.

It is said that there is MTOUSA authority for this procedure.

4. It appears to this Headquarters that there are strong security objections to the American Red Cross (or similar organizations) issuing travel orders that permit

persons to travel into Army Zone for business or recreational purposes, unless such travel is authorized by the military authorities concerned, and a reference to the authority is given in the orders.

5. This Headquarters would be glad to know of any action that may be taken by you in this matter.
