SUBJECT : Issue of improper passes
TO : AFHQ, G-5 Section.

1. Transmitted herewith is a letter issued by the Deputy Ministry of War Transport Representative, Naples, which purports to authorise a Mr. Ortona Leonello to travel from Genoa to Bari, and to return from Bari to Genoa with his wife and two children. The letter also purports to authorise the use of civilian motor vehicle GE 25215 for this purpose.

2. The letter referred to in paragraph 1 was written at a time when civilian movement between Genoa and Bari was forbidden unless the civilians concerned were in possession of movement passes approved for issue by S.C.A.O., AMG Fifth Army.

3. The issue of civilian movement passes and motor vehicle circulating permits is a matter entirely for AMG/AC, and the letter in question cuts right across all existing regulations relating to the Control of Civilian Movement and the Circulation of Motor Vehicles.

4. The issue of improper passes and permits is a danger to security and tends to weaken the Allied war effort.

5. It is considered desirable that the Deputy Ministry of War Transport representative should be requested to take appropriate steps to ensure that the personnel of his Ministry do not issue improper passes in the future.

SUBJECT : Issue of improper passes.

1. Transmitted herewith is a letter issued by the Deputy Ministry of War Transport Representative, Naples, which purports to authorise a Mr. Ortone Leonello to travel from Genoa to Bari, and to return from Bari to Genoa with his wife and two children. The letter also purports to authorise the use of civilian motor vehicle GE 25715 for this purpose.

2. The letter referred to in paragraph 1 was written at a time when civilian movement between Genoa and Bari was forbidden unless the civilians concerned were in possession of movement passes approved for issue by S.C.A.O., AMG Fifth Army.

3. The issue of civilian movement passes and motor vehicle circulating permits is a matter entirely for AMG/AC, and the letter in question cuts right across all existing regulations relating to the control of civilian movement and the circulation of motor vehicles.

4. The issue of improper passes and permits is a danger to security and tends to weaken the allied war effort.

5. It is considered desirable that the Deputy Ministry of War Transport Representative should be requested to take appropriate steps to ensure that the personnel of his Ministry do not issue improper passes in the future.
