SUBJECT: Fatal Accident.

TO : HQ. ACC. Public Safety Sub-Commission.

1. Herewith translation of letter N° 655/3-3rd Div. from Royal Carabinieri, Tenenza di Sessa Aurunca reporting a very serious accident on 31st July, 1944, whereby an American lorry carrying refugees fell from a bridge resulting in the death of 12 persons and injury to 10 others.

SUBJECT: Automobile accident.

TO : Regional Public Safety Officer, Naples.

On the 31st inst. at about 2300 hours, on "Ponte Gabellotti" locality, Nazionale Casilina 6, Roccamonfina Commune (Naples) an American truck, licence plate n.427420 A.M.G. carrying 22 refugees going to Cassino, in turning on the bridge fell on the left side from a height of about 18 meters on the lower railway. 10 unidentified persons were killed, their bodies were transported by the British Police to Vairano Commune. Other 12 injured persons were transported to the Teano Civil Hospital, where later CIONI Iolanda 24 years old and SCALA Lidia 22 years, died.
