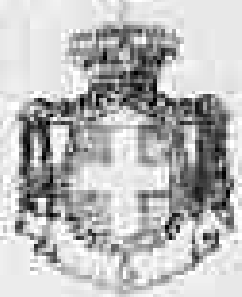

1. Reference this office R-VIII/PS/3 dated 31 January 1945 respecting the above mentioned.

2. I have received information from Lucca and Pisa Provinces that the appointment of Dott. MONARCA as Inspecting Questore for Toscana is an extremely unpopular one.

3. Further that if he goes to Pisa where he was once Questore the authorities there will not be responsible for his life.

4. It appears that his extraordinary unpopularity is due to the fact that he was for some time the body guard and close friend of the big fascist chief Guido RUFFINI.

5. In view of the passage of time since the original application was made for an official of this type; the difficulty in regard to transport; the fact that we have managed successfully so far without an Inspector -- and I certainly don't want a dead one on my hands, -- I withdraw my request and suggest that MONARCA be transferred to some Southern Province.

6. I have nothing to say about him further than he strikes me as being an efficient officer.

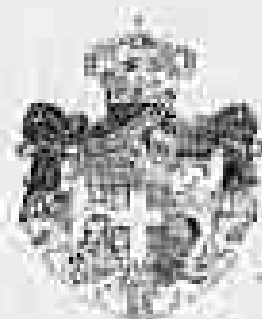

1. Reference is made to your letter 25/9.1, dated 29th September, 1944.

2. The authorized strength of Public Safety Officers in Toscana has been fixed at 10 officers, to be distributed within the Region as you think fit.

3. With regard to the special points raised in your letter:

a) Fire Officer. Captain Forster was ordered to report to your HQ on 24th September, 1944, for duty in the Region. In view of this you may not wish to press for an Italian official.

b) Prison Officer. As no specialist officer is available the work must be undertaken by Public Safety Officers.

c) Port of Livorno. No additional officers can be assigned. It is a matter of making the best use of the available strength in the Region.

d) Questore. This HQ is opposed to the creation of a Regional Directorate of Public Security the establishment of which in Sicily has caused endless complication with the Ministry of the Interior. Nevertheless it is thought that the difficulty of being kept advised of Questura conditions can be met by the appointment of a Questura Liaison Officer. The Ministry of ^{the} Interior has been asked to nominate a suitable official (see letter "A" attached). — 2B

e) Prisons. Again experience in Sicily and Southern Region shows the inadvisability of setting up Regional Prison Officers to supersede the normal Italian Prison system. The Minister of Grace and Justice has been

asked to nominate a suitable official as Inspector of Prisons.

SUBJECT : Italian Regional Officers.

TO : Administration Section - thru -
Public Safety Sub-Commission,
HQ. A.C.C., C.M.F.

1. In view of the impending heavy reduction of officers' personnel in this Region, which in fact has actually commenced, I wish to call attention to the serious administrative difficulties which will arise, when this is accomplished.

2. This reduction, which includes both my Prison Officer and my Fire Officer, will leave Public Safety officer personnel at the figure of 10, viz myself alone in Headquarters and 1 in each Province.

3. What is to be will be, but I call attention to the fact that as Livorno opens up as our main port in Italy, it will be an impossible task for the single American police officer in this new P.B.S. area to deal with the many problems which will arise.

There should at least be one officer in charge of the town, and another of the Province of Livorno if any degree of efficiency is to be expected.

4. With regards to the various Specialist Sections of Public Safety, CC.RR., Questura, Prisons and Fire, etc, I have the following recommendations to make.

Carabinieri. Regional Control is already established through the medium of 2 Legion Commanders.

Questura. There are 9 Provincial Questori, together with several smaller offices. For this HQ to have any effective control and supervision of the work of these various Questori, I recommend the establishment of a Principal Questore for the whole Region as obtained in Sicily. This is important if I am to be kept properly advised of what is happening criminally or politically.

Prisons. In this Region there are 19 Judiciary prisons comprising the following:-

- 3 Penal Colonies
- 3 Penitentiaries
- 2 Penal Houses
- 1 Womens Judiciary Prison
- 1 Manicomio
- 9 Provincial Judiciary Prisons

For similar reasons to those under 'Questura', I ask for the appointment of an Italian Regional Prison Officer as obtained in Region 1 and in the recent Region 3. Many of these prisons are in need of repairs and reorganisation, and as the administration under Italian law has - as is well known - been much neglected, it is essential that an official be appointed to properly supervise the whole Regional Prison Service.

Fire Service. This is a big job, particularly in view of the fact that many Fire Stations have been destroyed or damaged and a considerable amount of the equipment removed by the Germans.

If there is to be any serious co-ordination of the Fire Service in this Region, it is essential that a Regional Fire Official be appointed. *(Italian)*

5. I suggest therefore that urgent consideration be given to this matter and that only energetic officers be appointed to these very important posts.
