WEEKLY NOTES (Registration and Licensing)

1. Circulation of Motor Vehicles.

Issue of Permits. Came to notice that the Ministry of Communications issued an instruction to the effect that circulating permits for trucks would be issued without any formality. As this is contrary to all previous instructions agreed to between this Headquarters and the Italian Government, the question has been taken up with the Ministry concerned.

Reale Automobile Club d'Italia

Reported that a new Provincial Director of RACI has been appointed at Lucca without reference to this Headquarters. The Central Seat is not in agreement with the appointment and the matter has been taken up with S.C.A.C. AMO Fifth Army.

Military Railway Services (MRS)

In the early days of the occupation of Rome, motor vehicles used by the MRS carried certificates issued by them to ensure their freedom of movement. It came to notice that vehicles without standard permits continue to circulate with these certificates, the MRS having advised that arrangements now exist for the issue of permits, instructions have been issued to eliminate from service those vehicles that circulate without them.

Control of Movement

Applications have been received from French Industrialists to enter Italy Economic and Political Section consulted and AFHQ advised not to permit their entry for the time being.

Issue and Use of Military Tyres.

Transportation Sub-Commission have further discussed the matter with this Sub-Commission who advised that the matter should be closely tied up with the issue of circulating permits to ensure that the best use is made of the tyres.

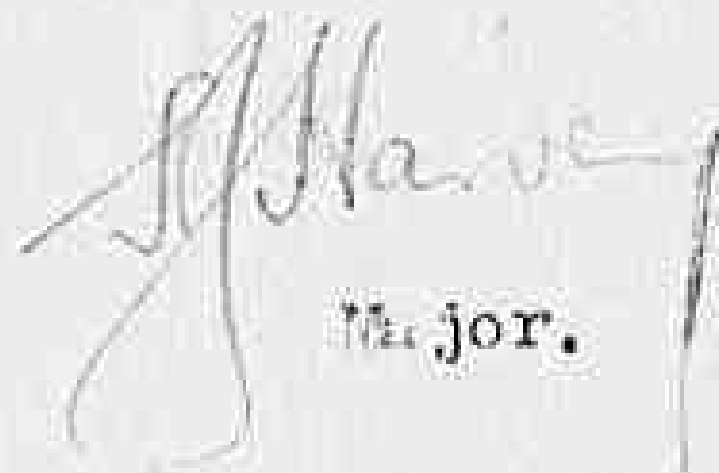

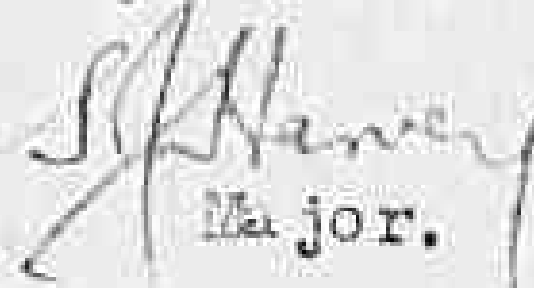
