1. Would appreciate facts in the case of Subject who was believed to have been arrested and tried for "arranging a political meeting" in Cortona. Our information indicates Subject was arrested on the order of a Colonel COUSINS and sentenced to three months in jail. He was tried by Allied Military Government Court.

2. We have been asked by higher HQ for information and hope that it may be obtained from records available to the Legal Division.

SUBJECT : Count MORRA Umberto.

TO : Political Sec.

1. In answer to your memo at Folio 61, Count MORRA was charged with attending a meeting in Allied Military Government Territory for which the requisite permit had not been obtained. In fact, Count MORRA was the speaker at the meeting which was extremely small.

2. Count MORRA was found guilty and sentenced to imprisonment for three months and to a fine of 5,000 lire. This fine was promptly paid.

3. On the instructions of the Acting President, instructions were issued on 12 Jan 1945 that MORRA should be released forthwith. It has subsequently come to light that the local Allied Military Government authorities had very properly allowed MORRA and his co-accused to remain at liberty pending re-view of the case.

4. The case has now been reviewed by the Legal Sub-Commission who state that Count MORRA clearly failed to comply with the provisions of Proc.

3, Art. IV and that he was properly convicted. The sentence of the court has been reduced from 3 months imprisonment and a fine of 5,000 lire to a fine of 5,000 lire only.

5. The sentences on Count MORRA's co-accused have also been reduced to fines only.

TO : Headquarters, Allied Commission, APO 394.

1. This section has received a note in the following terms from the British Resident Minister:

" According to press reports Count MORA DI LAVRIANO has been sentenced by an Allied Court in Cortona to three months imprisonment for having addressed a public meeting in that town.

The Count has, we understand, been working for P.W.B. since the Armistice and in view of his anti-fascist and pro-British reputation such a sentence will it is considered produce the worst possible effect and greatly discourage friends of the Allied cause.

We should be grateful if you would kindly look into this matter and let us know the position."

Count Carrandini called to see me to-day. He informs me that a friend of his, Conte Umberto Morra di Lavriano, has been arrested at Cortona by A.M.G. authorities for a breach of the regulations. He went to Cortona, which is his home, to make a speech at a meeting of the Action Party. This being in Military Government territory is of course contrary to the rules. He has been arrested and is now on trial.

Count Carrandini says that he is an excellent fellow of very good will towards us. He helped our prisoners during the German occupation. He thinks he broke the rule without realizing that it was a serious offence.

Please have this looked into and let me have a report.
